Severe Weather - Central Plains/Midwest

<u>Situation:</u> Severe weather moved through portions of the Central Plains and the Midwest overnight with the NOAA SPC receiving over 330 total storm reports for high winds, tornadoes, and large hail. Preliminary reports indicate 23 potential tornado touch downs, primarily in lowa, resulting in 4 confirmed reports of fatalities, injuries, and property damage. Damage assessments are ongoing. Tornado Watches and Warnings have expired. There have been no requests for FEMA assistance.








National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





