

Disturbance 1 (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- · Located several hundred miles southwest of the coast of Mexico
- · Conditions appear marginally conducive for slow development
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (20%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- · Located few hundred miles south of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
- Moving W slowly at 5-10 mph
- Gradual development is possible
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (30%)





Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- · Area of Low pressure located over south-central Alabama

National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook







Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall


