## Hazard Monitoring

- Tropical Activity:
  - Atlantic:
    - Disturbance 1: Low (near 0%)
  - Eastern Pacific
    - Disturbance 1: Low (20%); Disturbance 2: Low (30%)
- Severe thunderstorms – Southern Plains
- Heavy rain and flash flooding– Southern/Central Plains; Southeast to Southern/Central Appalachians

- No significant events

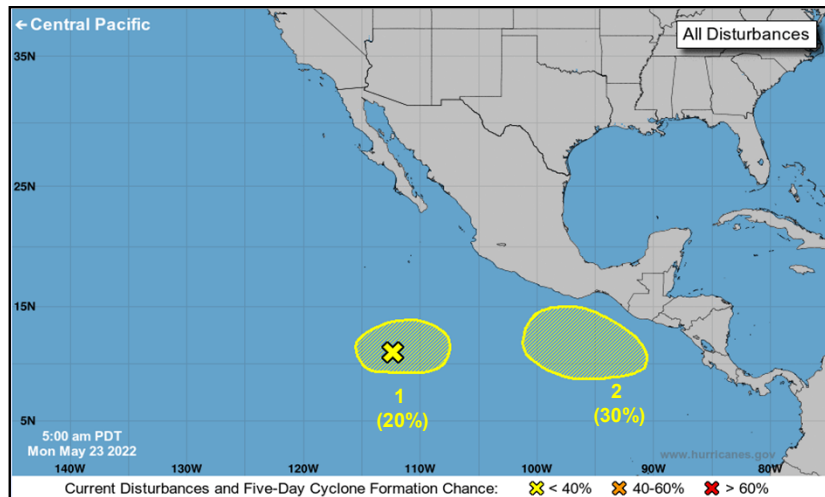


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# Tropical Outlook – Five Day

## Eastern Pacific



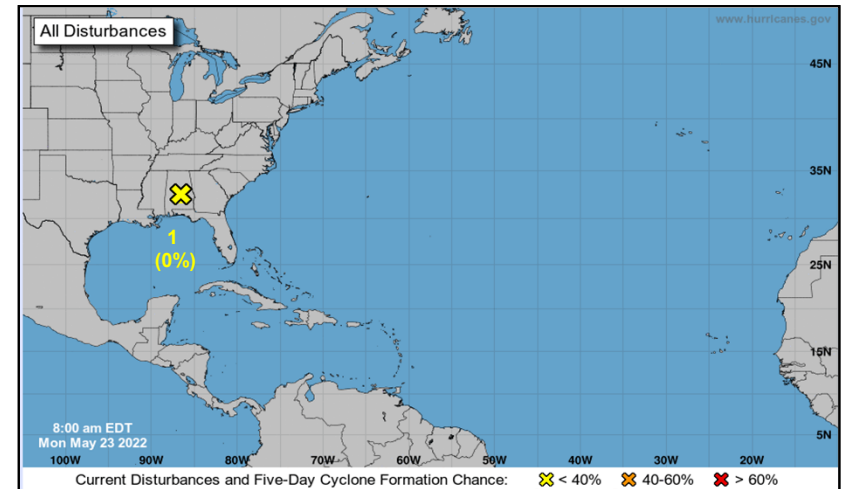
### Disturbance 1 (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles southwest of the coast of Mexico
- Conditions appear marginally conducive for slow development
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (20%)

### Disturbance 2 (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located few hundred miles south of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
- Moving W slowly at 5-10 mph
- Gradual development is possible
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (30%)

### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

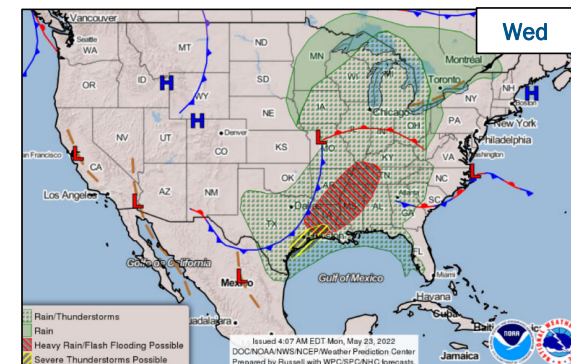
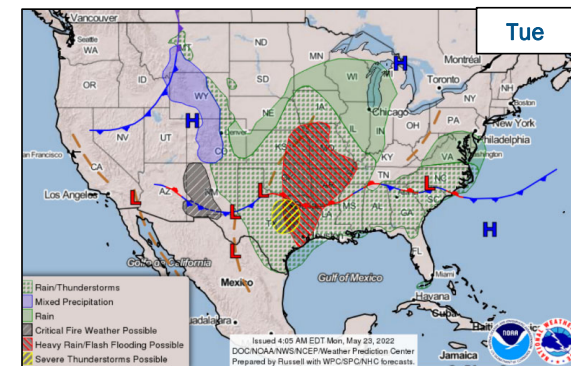
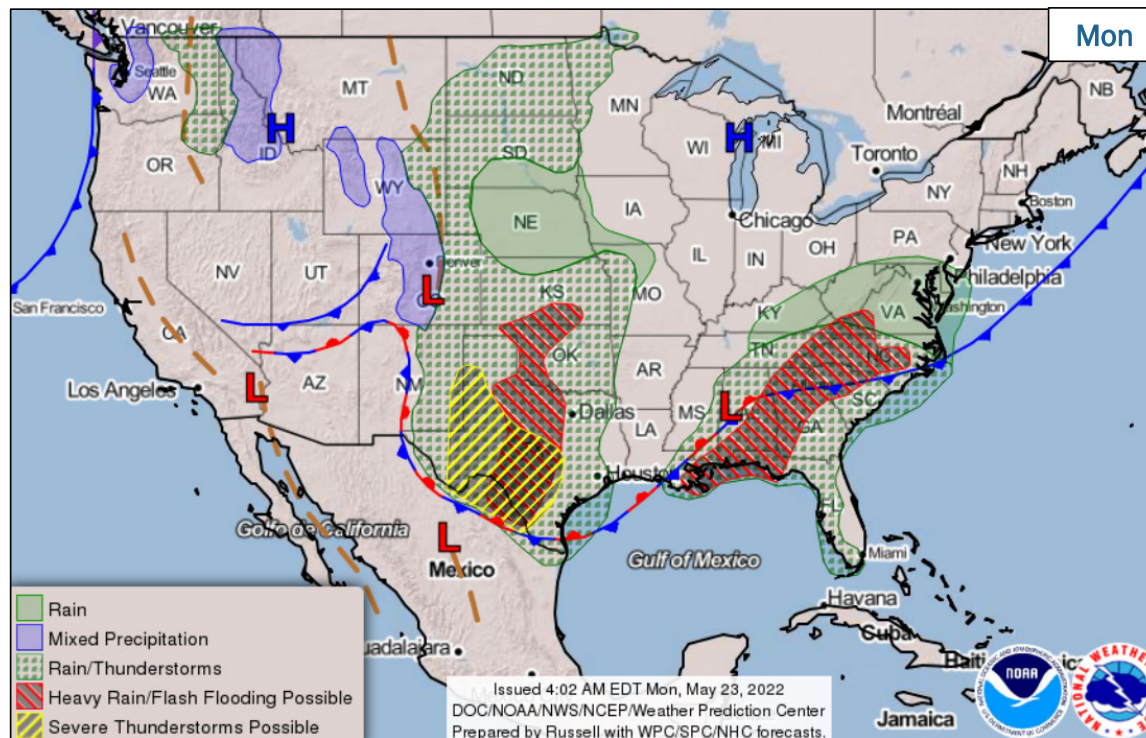
- Area of Low pressure located over south-central Alabama
- As it moves further inland, tropical cyclone development is not expected
- Locally heavy rain associated with this system
- Formation chance – 48-hour Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (near 0%)



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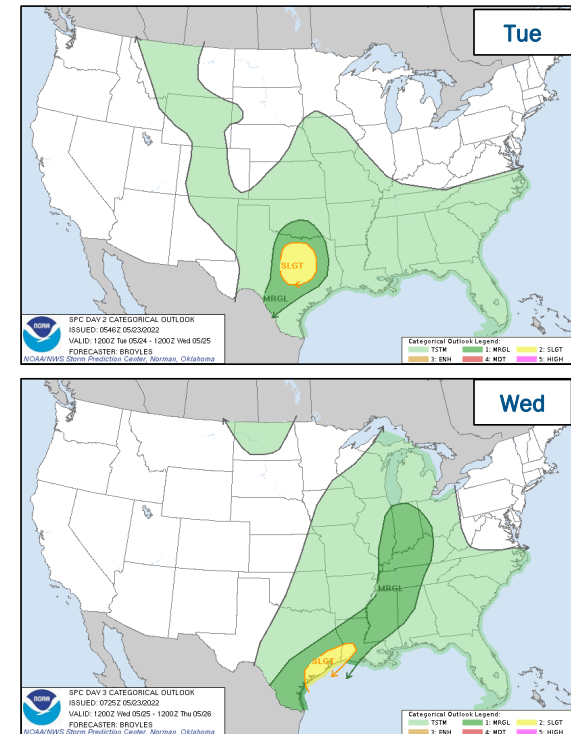
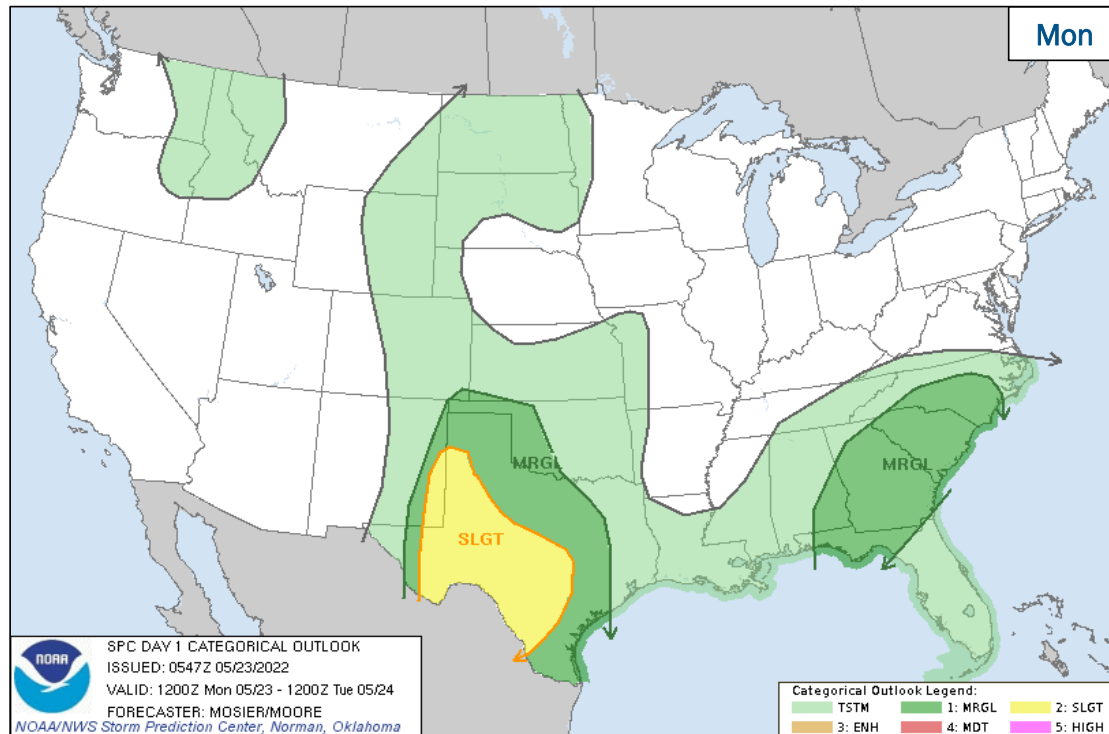

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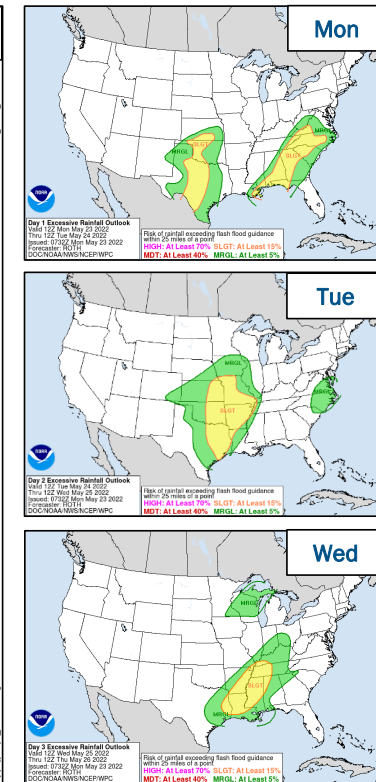
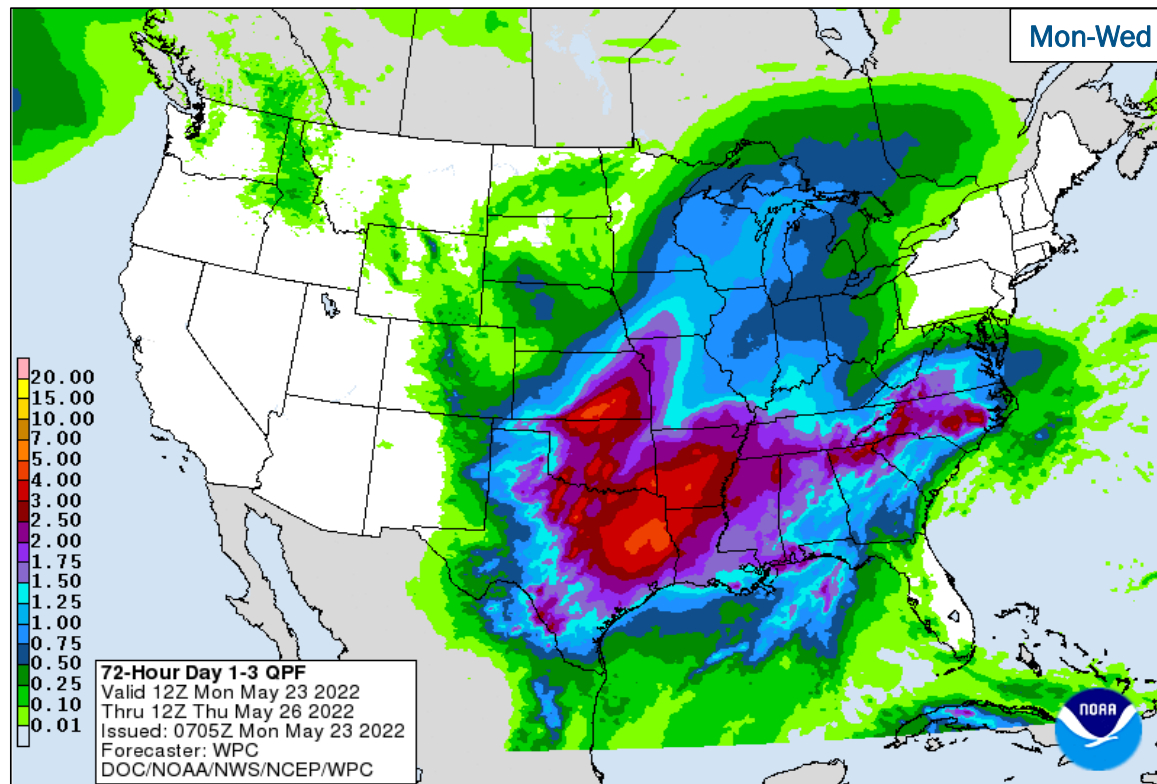
# Severe Weather Outlook



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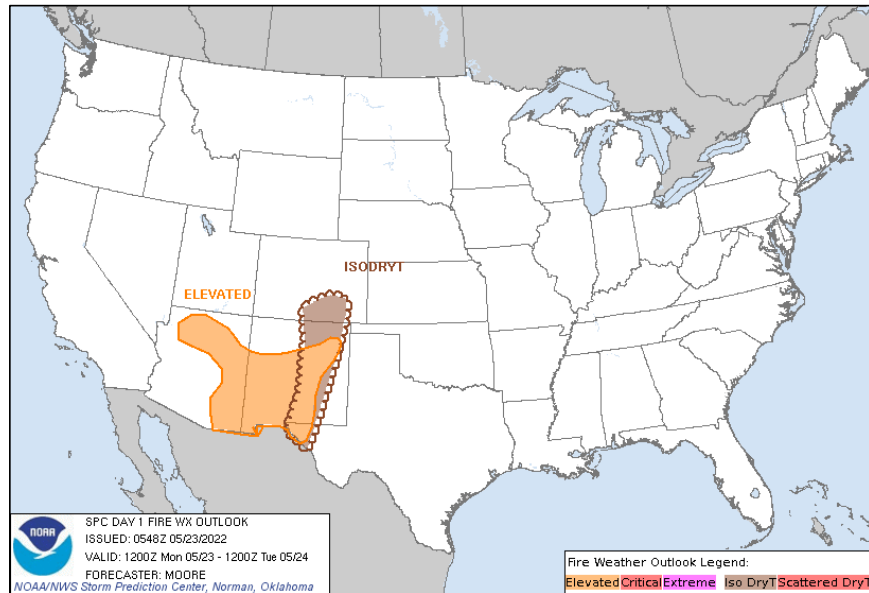
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



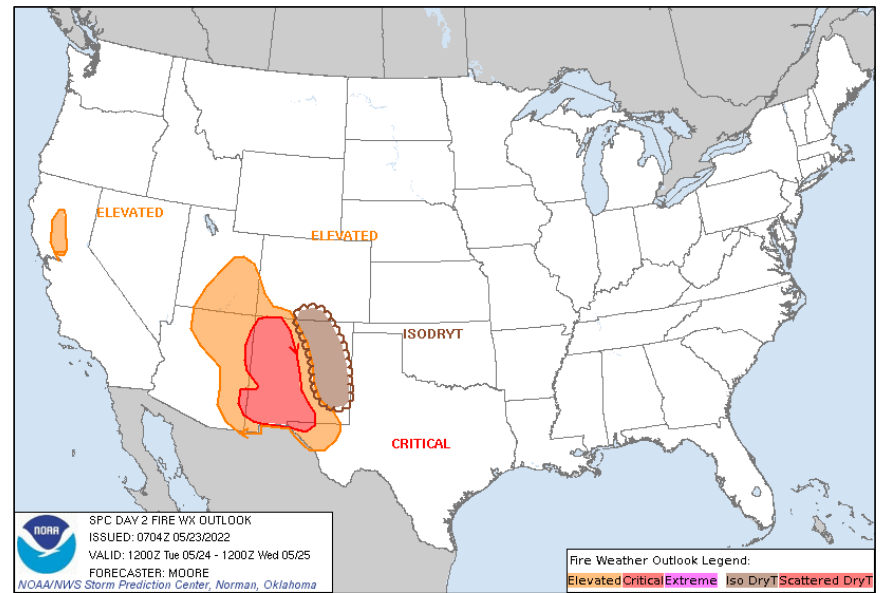

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# Declaration Amendments

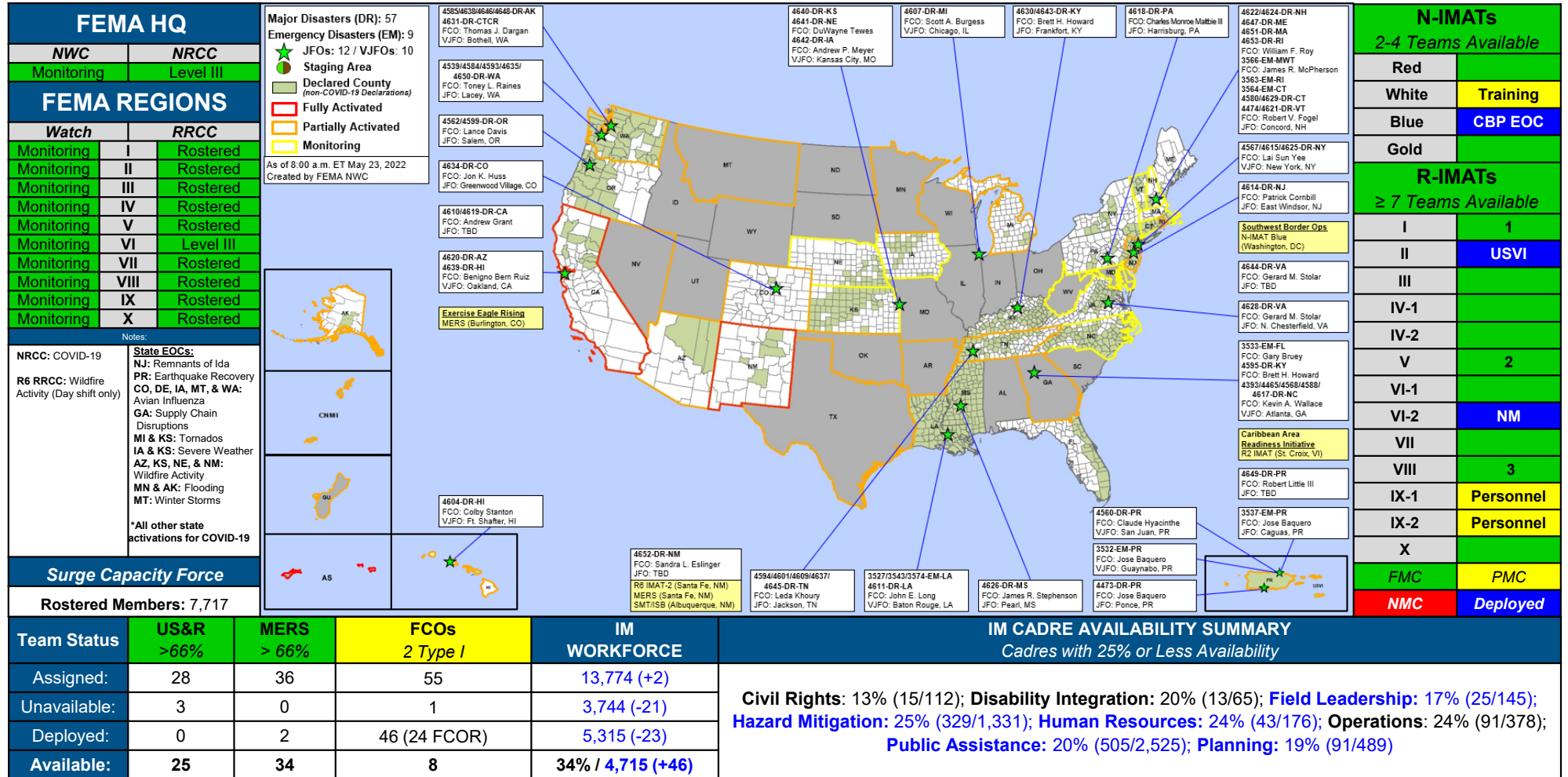
Declaration	Number	Issued	Action
