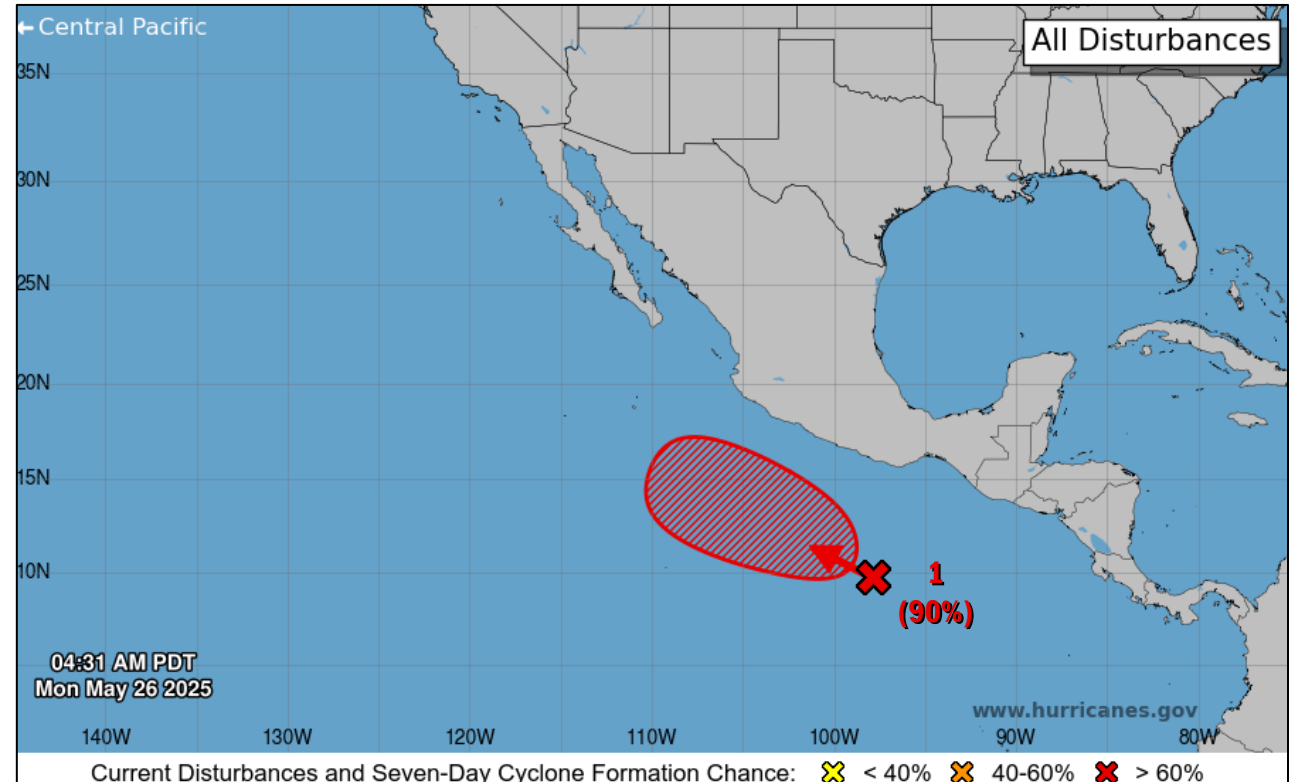


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# Disturbance 1 – Eastern Pacific

## Disturbance 1 (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)

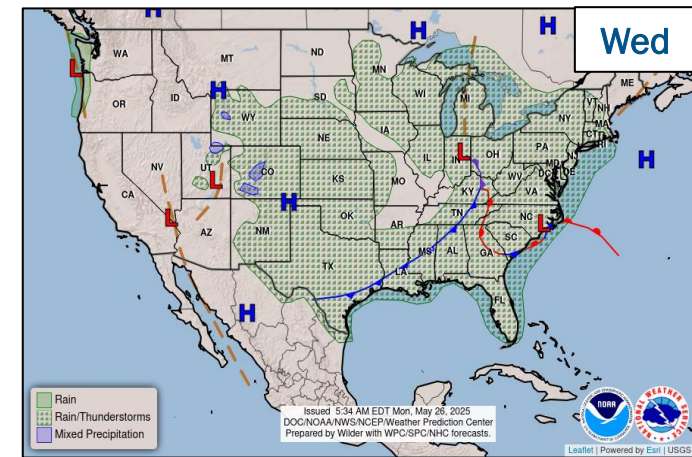
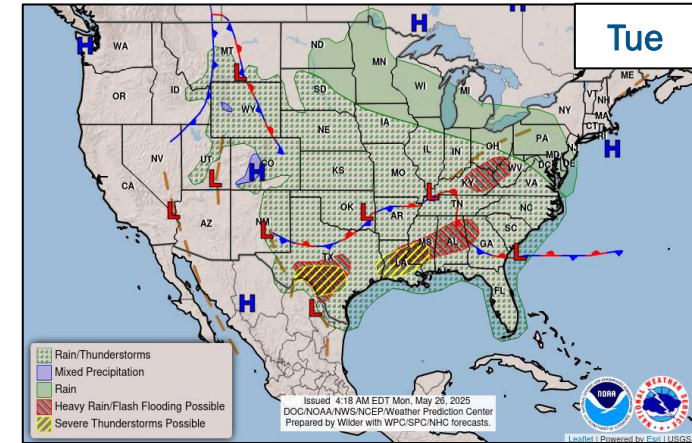
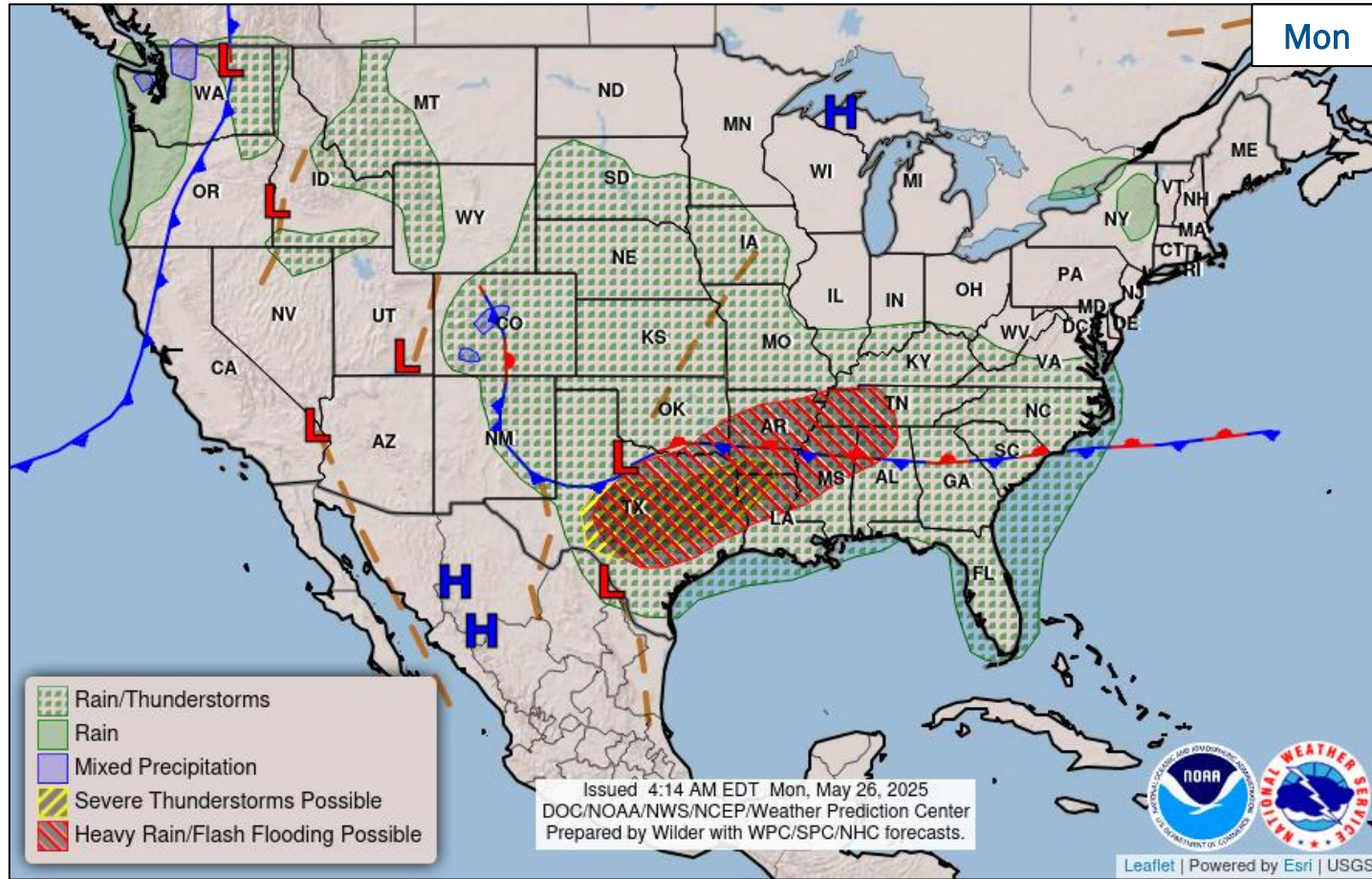
- Located several hundred miles S of the southern coast of Mexico

- Formation chance 48 hour: **Medium (50%)**; 7-day: High (80%)



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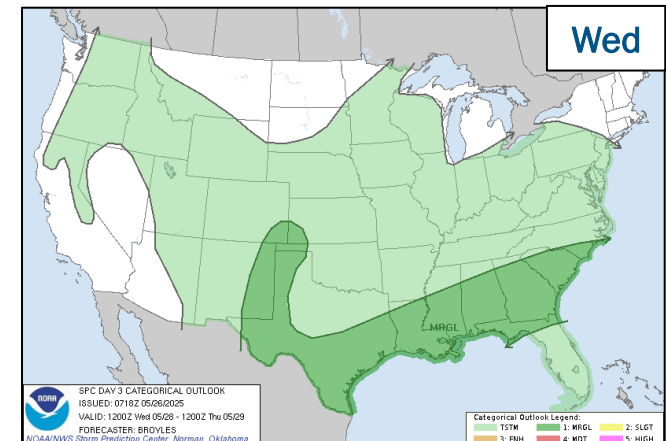
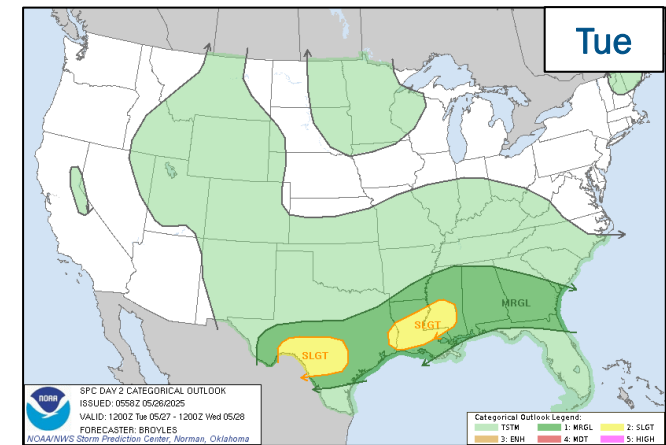
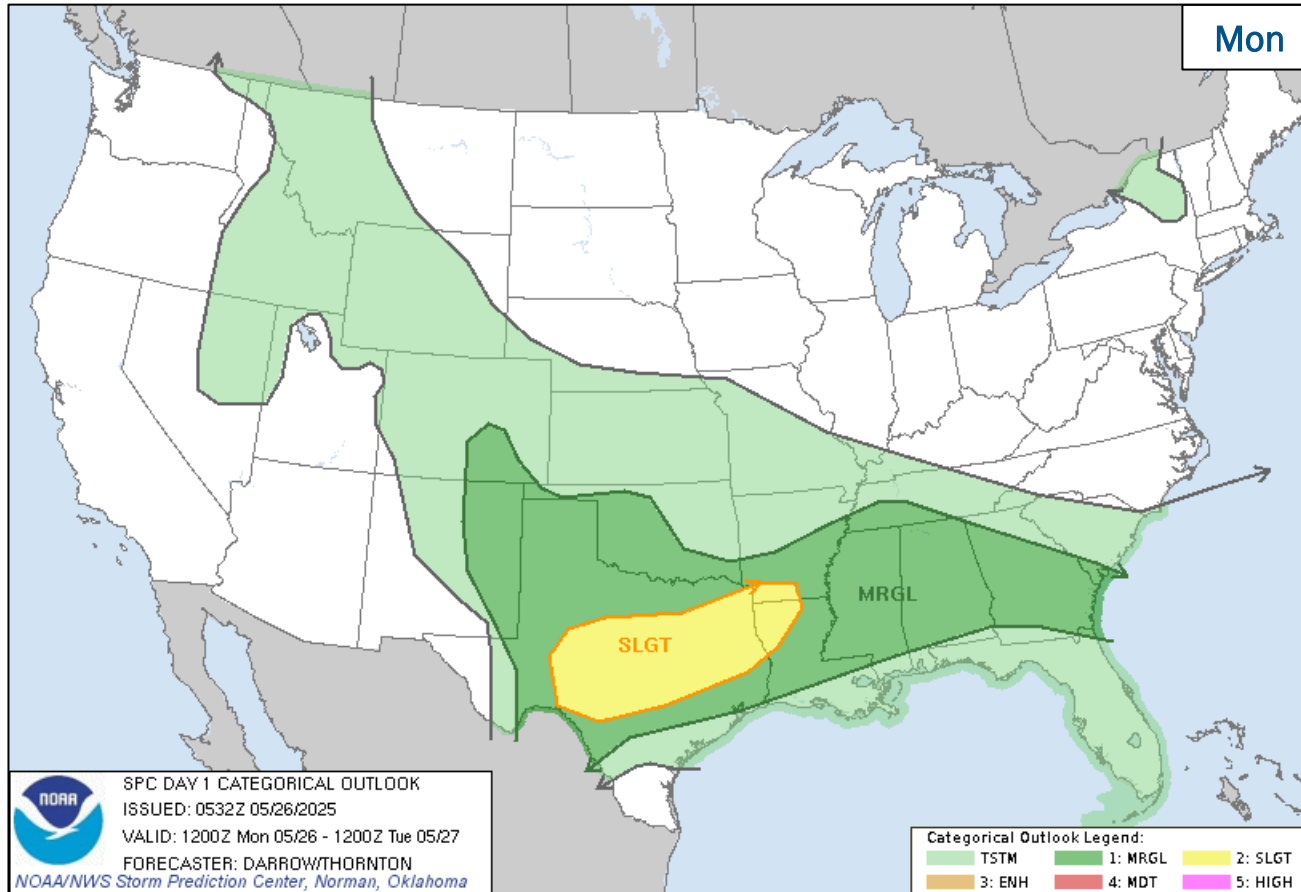

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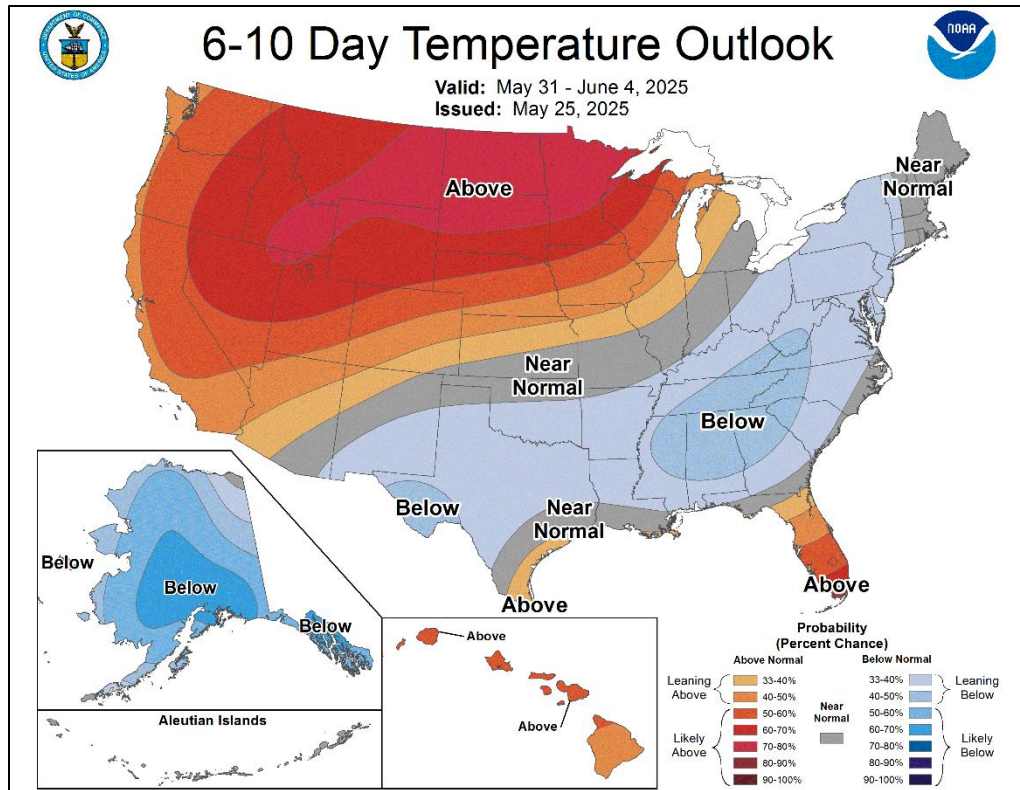
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# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

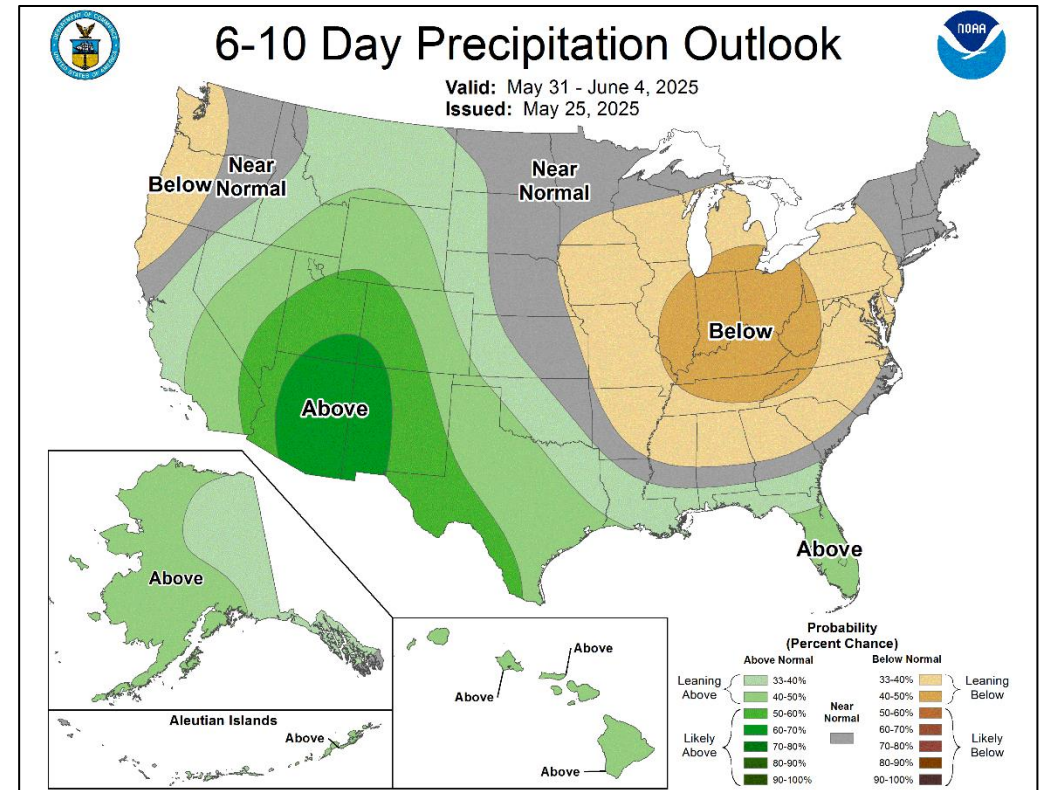


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# Long Range Outlooks – May 31 – June 4

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

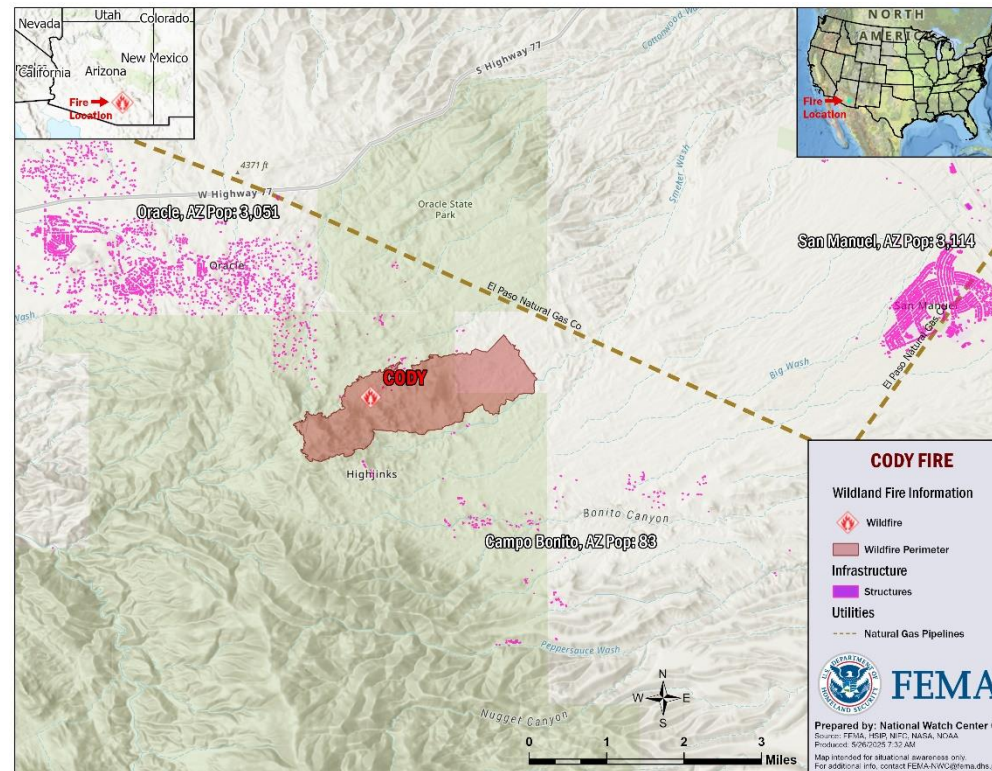
