Super Typhoon Mawar - Guam/CNMI




Situation: (SLB as of 7:30 a.m. ET)

Mission priorities remain focused on restoration of utilities to critical infrastructure including power within the impacted area. Federal teams, commodities, and equipment continue to move into the impacted areas to respond and stabilize community lifelines.

Lifelines:

- Food, Water, Shelter:
- o GU: 4 shelters open with 760 (-101) occupants
- GU: GWA 50% water systems operational; 20% of other water systems operational; boil water notice in effect; 4 (+2) of 9 waste water facilities operational
- GU: Requested 25k meals and 34k liters of water for 4 shelter sites;
 FEMA delivered food & water to all shelters
- Health and Medical:
- GU: All 3 hospitals fully operational
- CNMI: Power and water restored to Rota Health Center
- Fnergy
- GU: Power restored to 21% (+5%) of system load; damage assessments expected to be completed by May 30
- CNMI: Power restored to 79% of customers; full restoration expected by June 2
- Communication:
- GU: 43% (+7%) of cell sites operational
- CNMI: 60% of cell sites operational
- Transportation:
- o GU: Guam International Airport open for all commercial carriers
- o CNMI: All 3 airports operational
- Guam, Rota, Tinian and Saipan ports open



Territory/Local Response:

- GU EOC at Full Activation; Governor declared a State of Emergency
- CNMI EOC at Partial Activation






National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Long Range Outlooks – June 3-7

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


