 - Atlantic
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%)

 - Hurricane Agatha (CAT 2)
- Severe Thunderstorms, Heavy Rain/Flash Flooding – Central/Northern Plains to Middle/Upper Mississippi Valleys
- Critical Fire Weather – Southwest to Central/Southern Plains

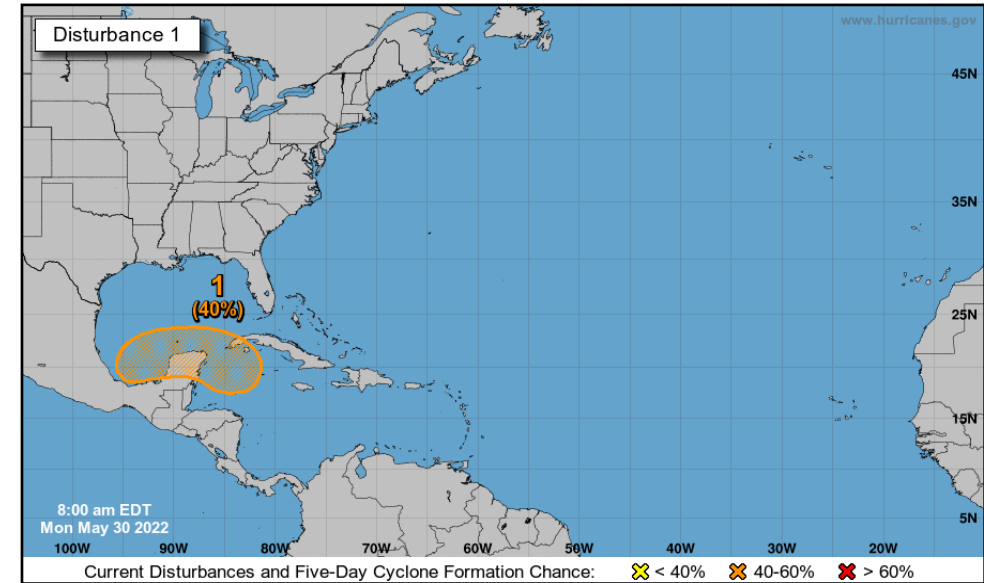
Eastern Pacific



Hurricane Agatha (CAT 2) (Advisory #10A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 65 miles SW of Puerto Angel, Mexico
- Moving NE at 6 mph
- On the forecast track, the center will make landfall in Oaxaca, Mexico this afternoon or evening
- Maximum sustained winds 110 mph
- Rapid weakening expected after landfall; forecast to dissipate over southeastern Mexico by late Tuesday
- Hurricane force winds extend outward 15 miles; tropical storm force winds extend 90 miles

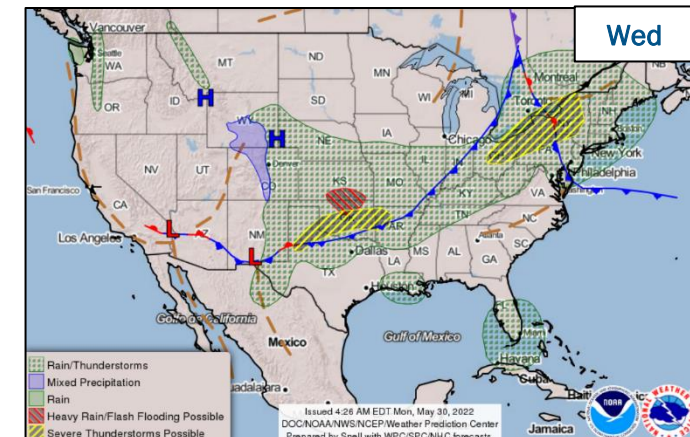
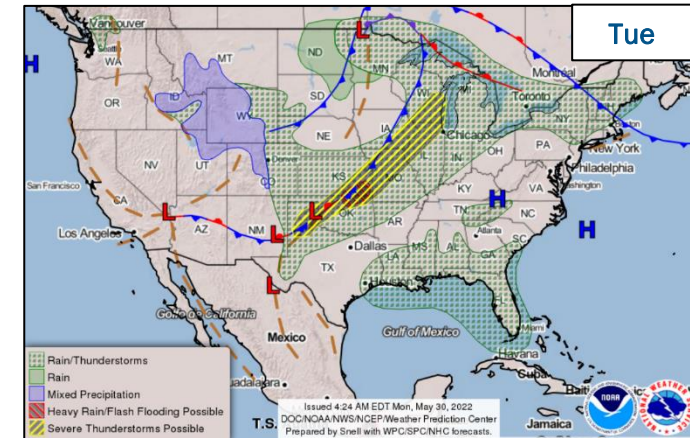
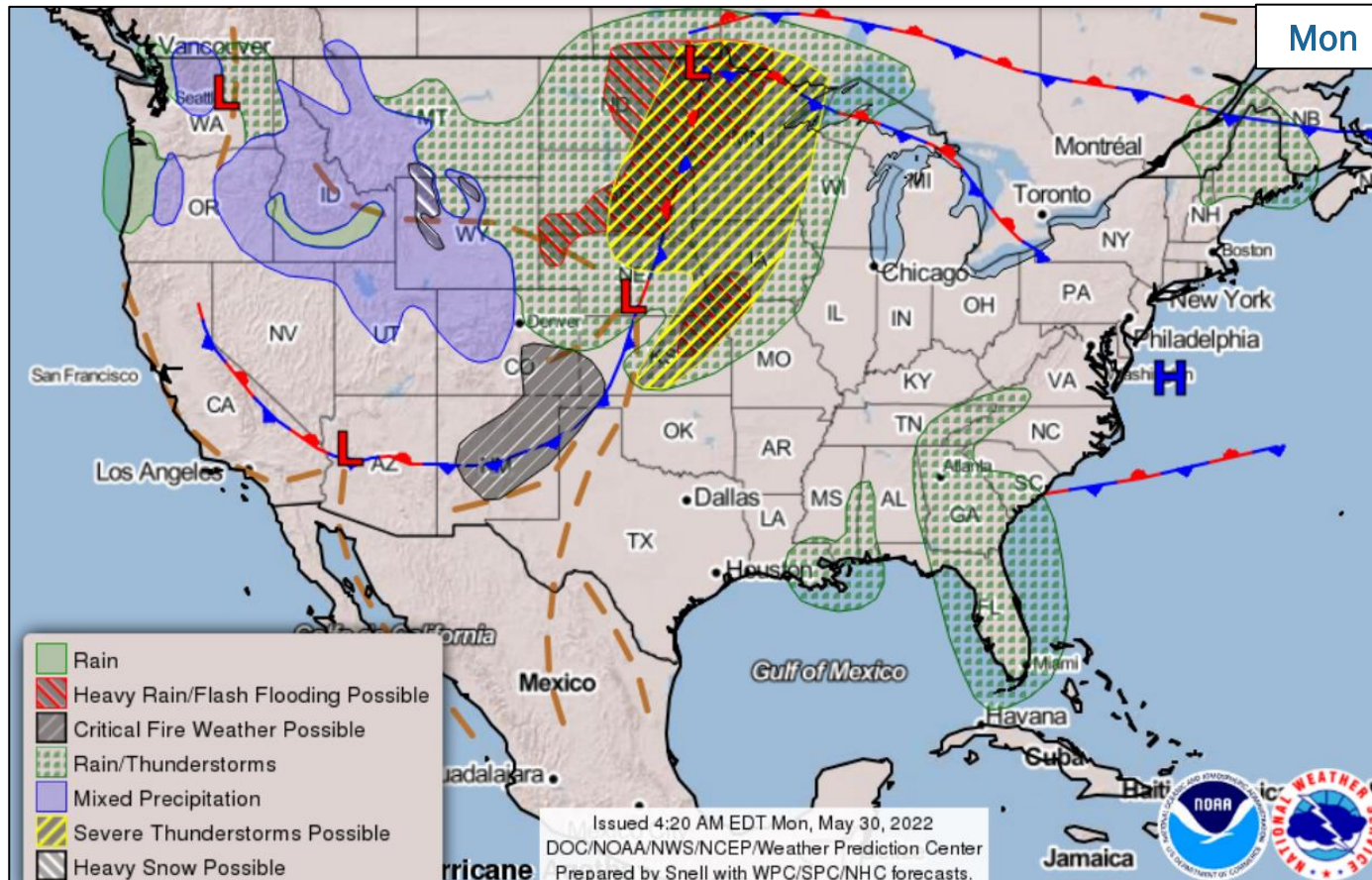
Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to develop across Central America, the Yucatan Peninsula, and the southwest Gulf of Mexico in a few days, partially related to the remnants of Hurricane Agatha from the Eastern Pacific
- Some gradual development is possible by mid-week in the far southwest Gulf of Mexico, or by the later part of this week in the northwest Caribbean
- Formation chance – 48-hour Low (near 0%); 5-day: Medium (40%)



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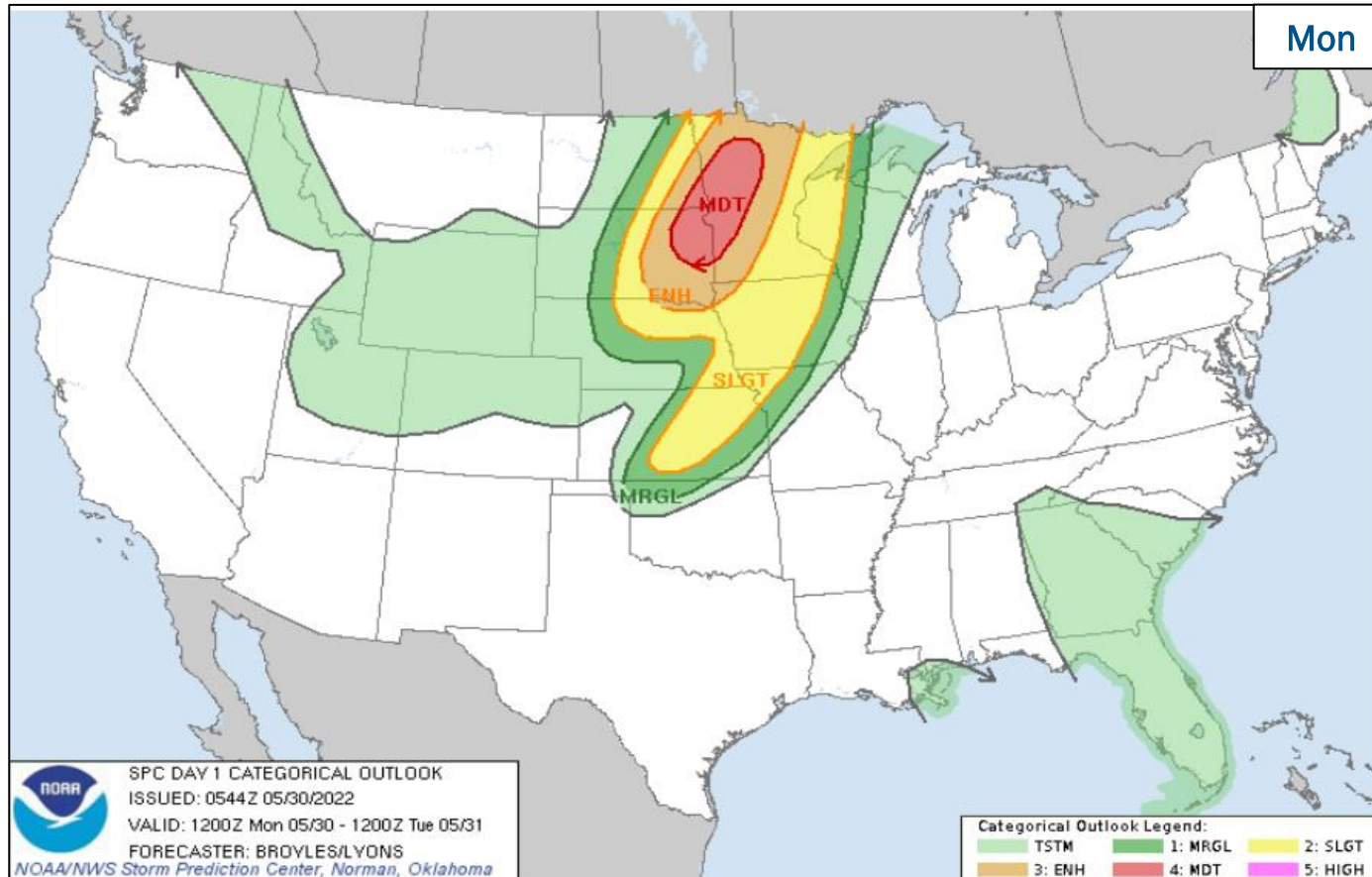
National Weather Forecast



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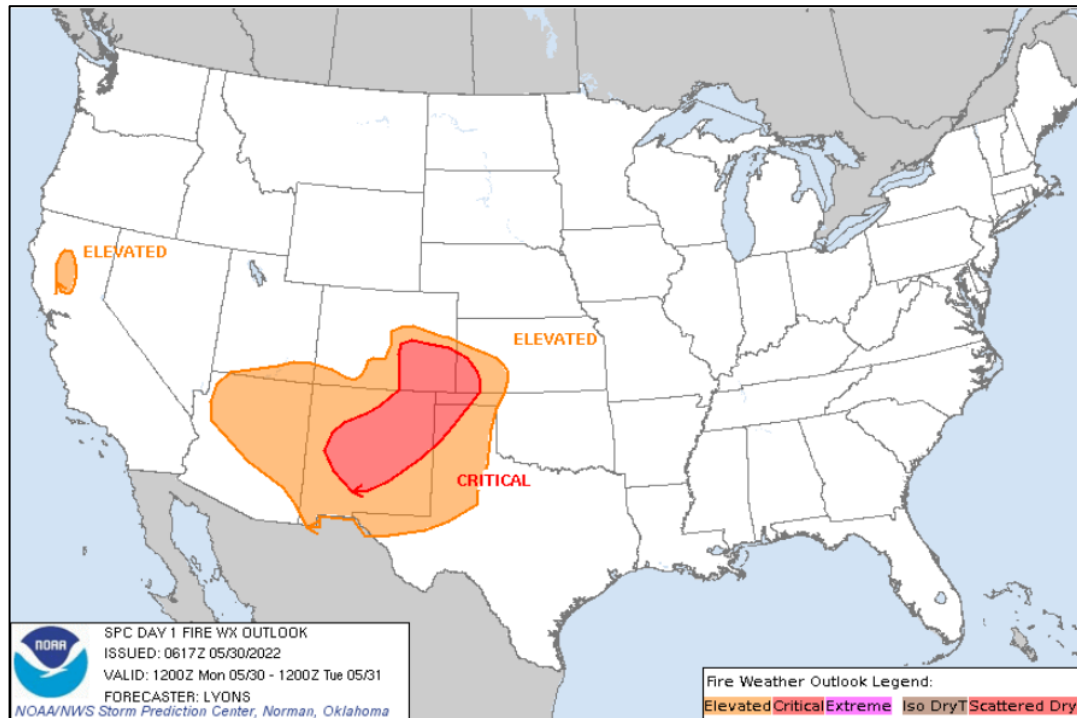
Severe Weather Outlook



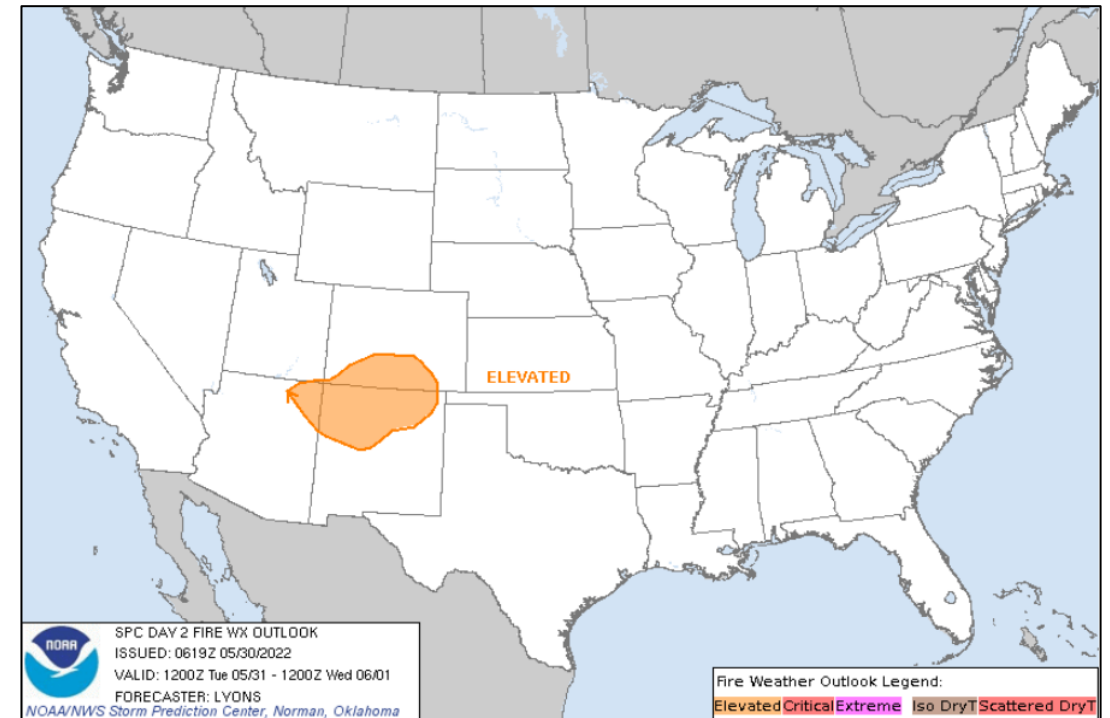
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Fire Weather Outlook

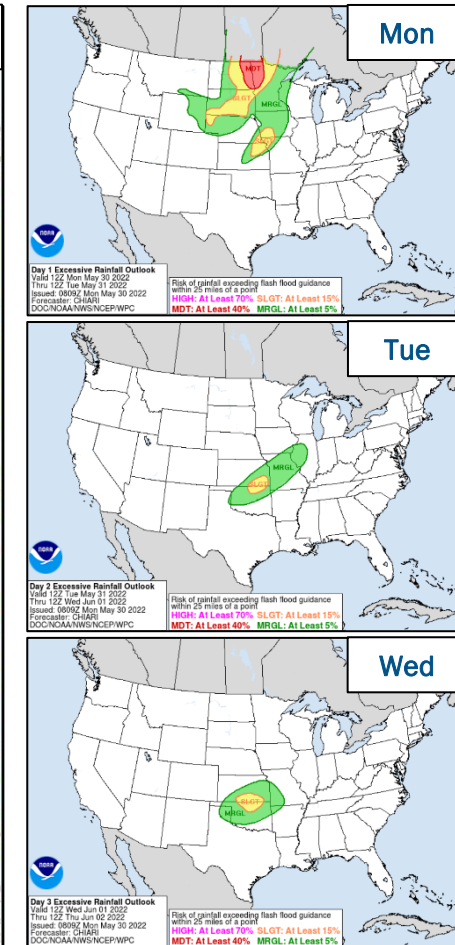
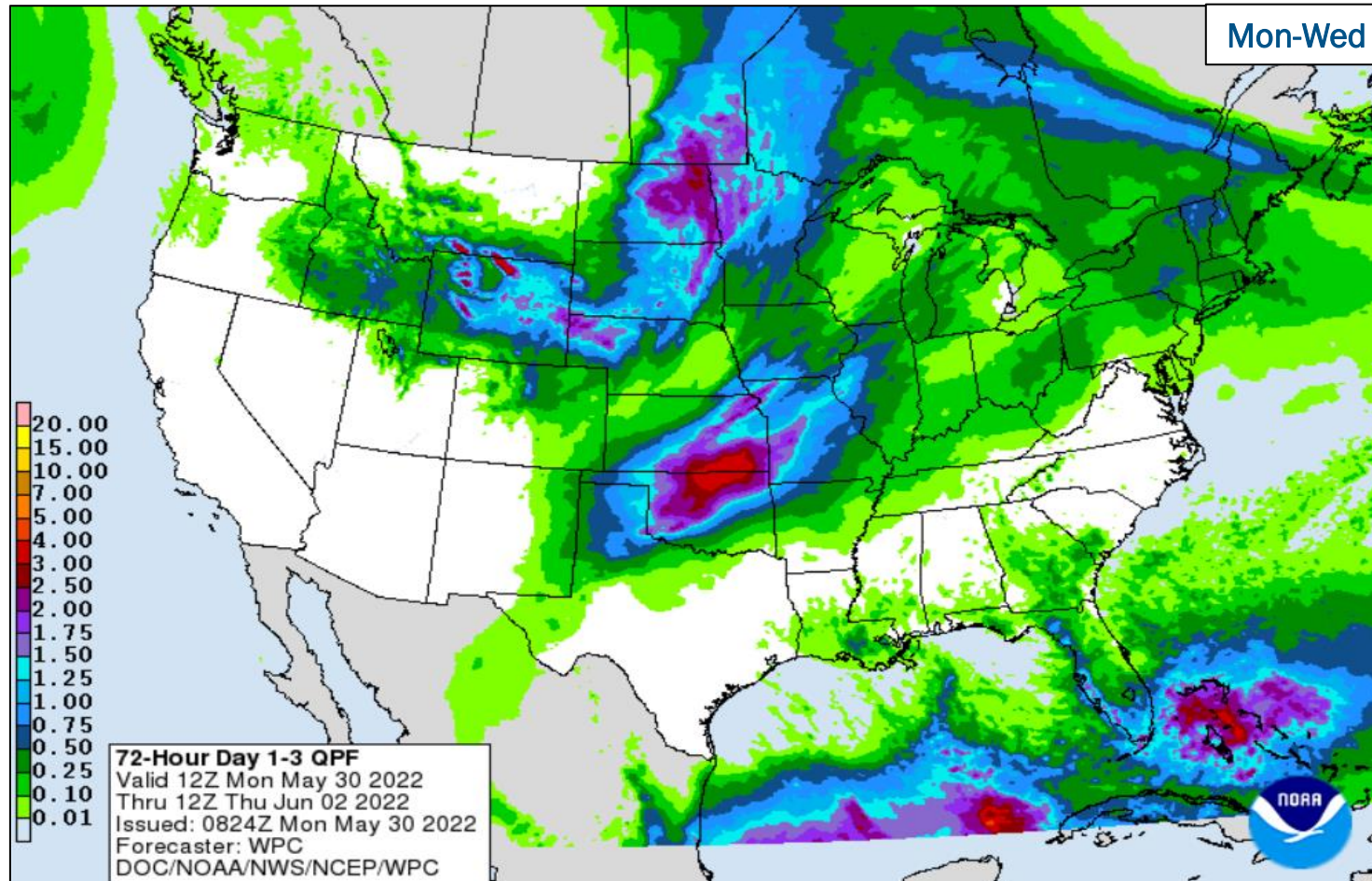

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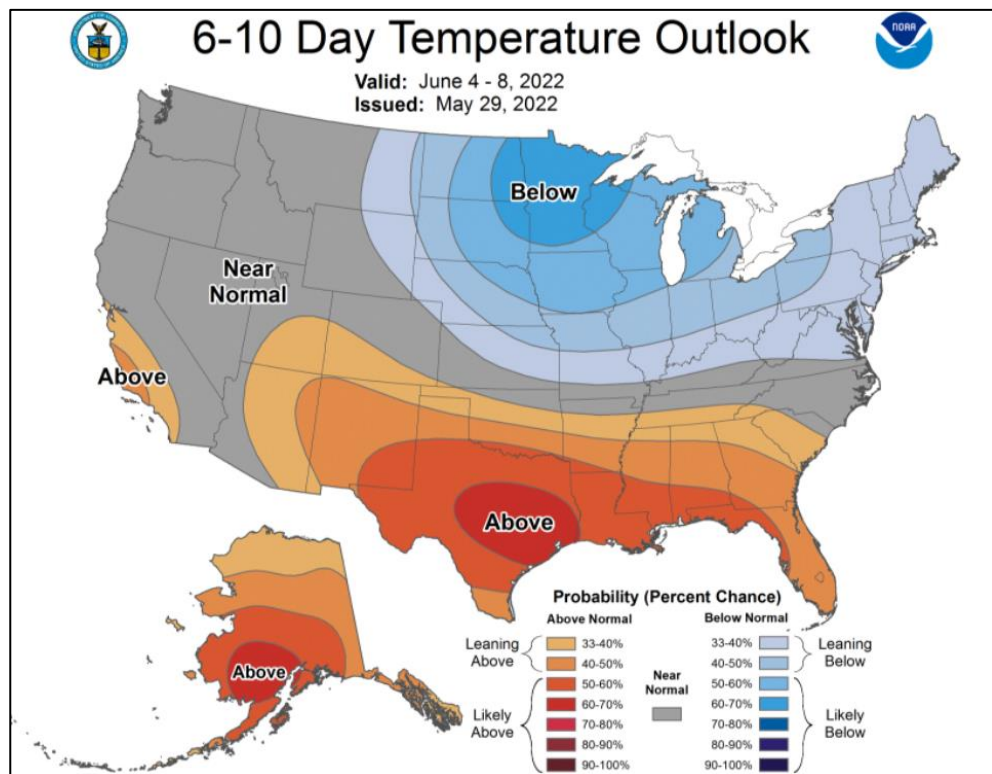
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



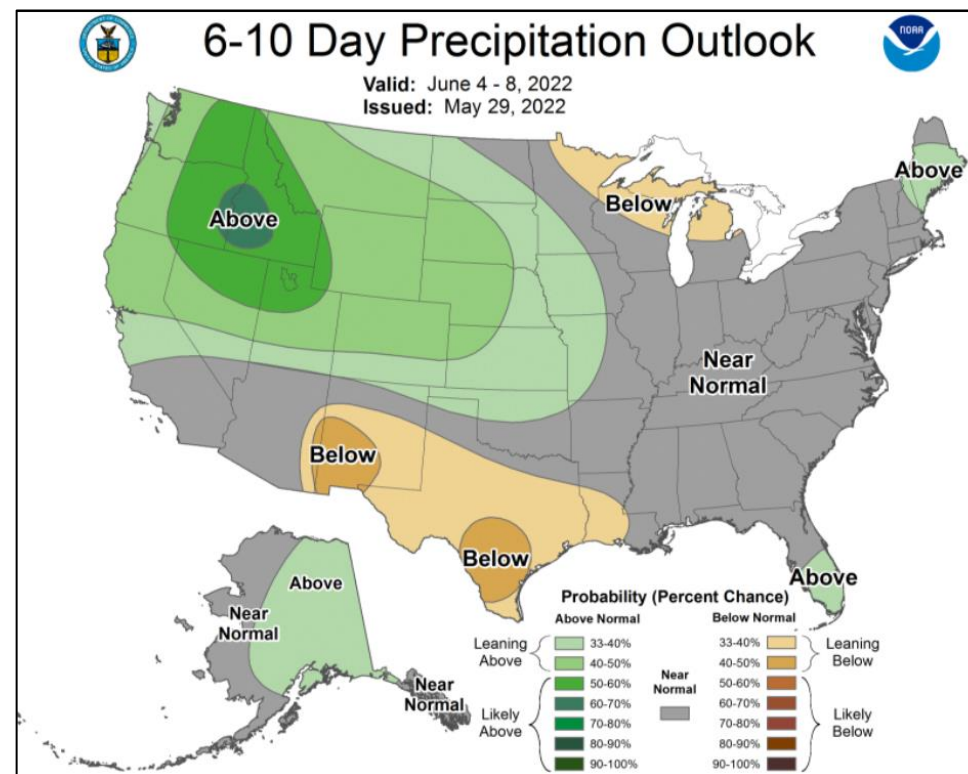
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Long Range Outlooks – June 4 - 8

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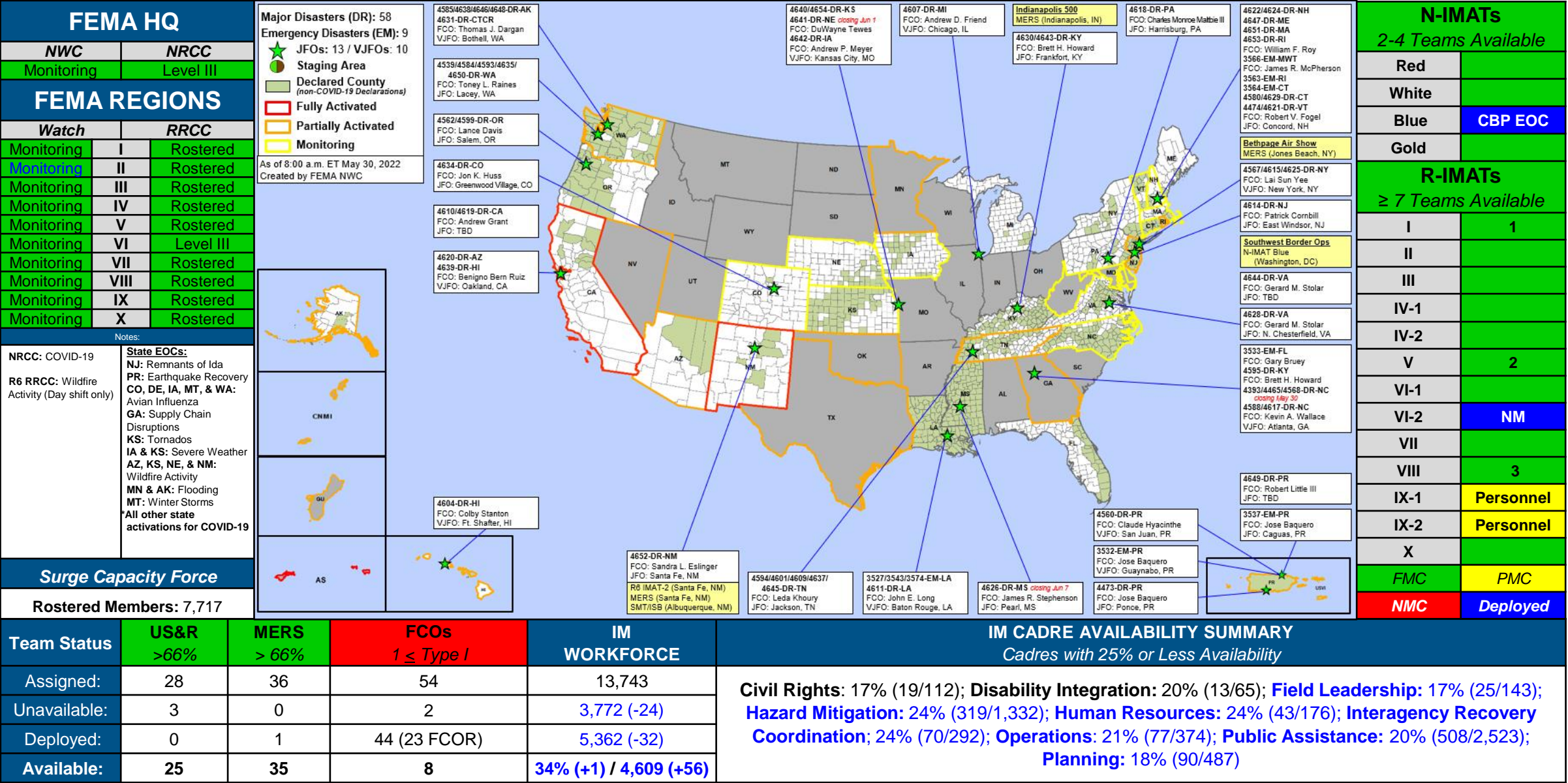
