# Civil Unrest and Protests



**Situation:** Numerous protests, civil disturbances, and marches are occurring in multiple cities across the nation, sparked by the May 25 death of George Floyd while in police custody in Minneapolis, MN.

## **Lifeline Impacts:**

### Safety and Security

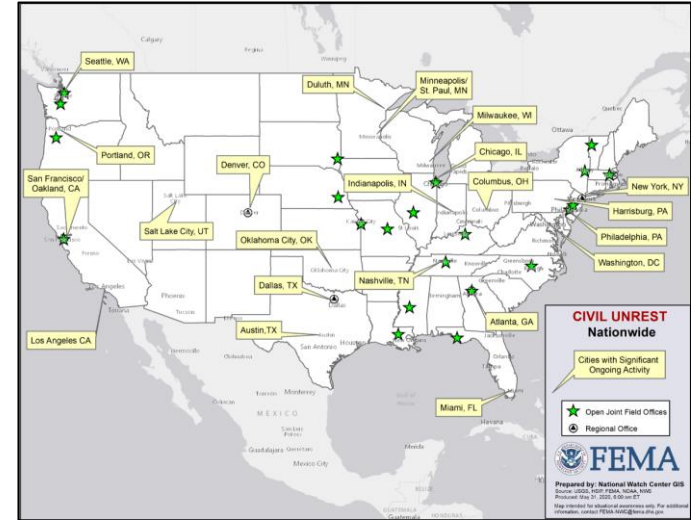
- Curfews in effect for numerous cities across the nation
- NY: NYPD temporarily suspended all solo patrols

### Transportation

- Multiple roads and highways closed due to protestors
- NY: Brooklyn bound lanes of the Brooklyn Bridge was closed for hours but has reopened
- CA: Los Angeles County metro services into downtown have been suspended

## **Response:**

- State of emergency:
  - States (3): GA, MN, MO
  - Counties (4): Monroe, NY; Allegheny and Dauphin, PA; Los Angeles, CA
  - Cities (5): Albany, NY; Philadelphia, PA; Nashville, TN; Seattle, WA; Portland, OR

  - States (4): Full: MN, WI, UT; Partial: AZ
  - Counties/Cities (4+): Cumberland and Delaware, PA; Henrico County, VA (Richmond); several CA counties; Washoe (Reno), NV
  - Cities (2): Chicago, IL; Minneapolis, MN
- PA requested EMAC from VA for mutual aid to support Philadelphia Police Dept.
- National Guard activated: GA, IL, IN, MN, OH, TX, MO, ND, UT, CA, NV, WA
- Region II: RWC building on lockdown; personnel must coordinate with U.S. Marshal Service Security Officers when leaving and entering the building
- Region III: RWC will work from alternate location beginning at noon
- Region V: RWC will continue to work from alternate location through June 2
- Region IX: RRCC working remotely

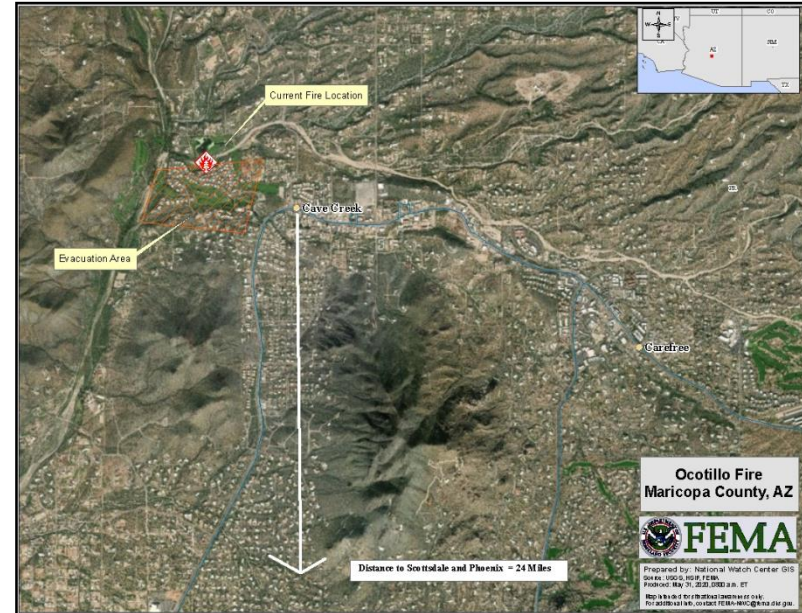

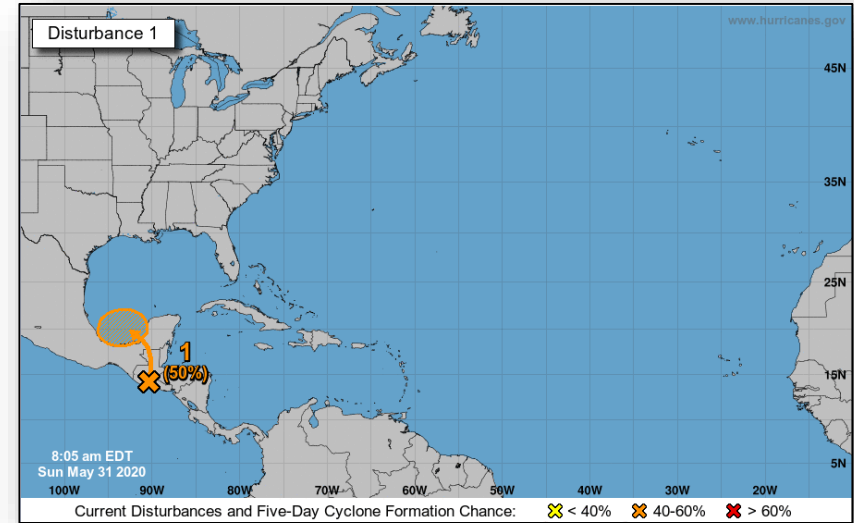


# Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



## **Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Eastern Pacific Tropical Storm Amanda is forecast to weaken into a remnant low or dissipate over Guatemala or southeastern Mexico by tonight
- The remnants of Amanda are expected to move NE and could possibly emerge over the southeastern Bay of Campeche on Monday
- If the remnants of Amanda move back over water, conditions appear conducive to support some redevelopment through the middle of the week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)



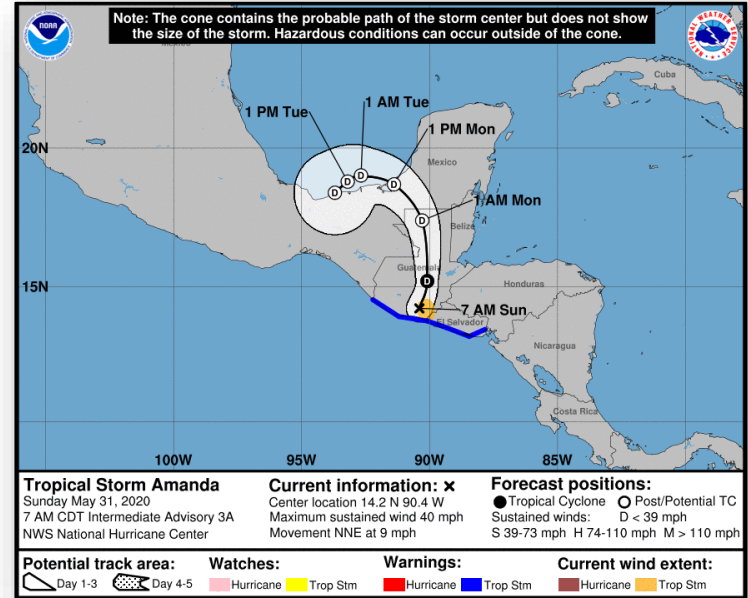
# Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



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## Tropical Storm Amanda (Advisory #3A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 30 miles SSE of Guatemala City, Guatemala
- Moving NNE at 9 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Weakening is expected to begin this morning while the center moves farther inland
- Expected to degenerate into a remnant low or dissipate over the mountains of Central America later today
- Tropical storm force winds extend 45 miles





# COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 46,756 FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; 2,949 (-12) FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide testing: **16,794,182 (+1,028,068) cumulative as of May 30.**

### Health & Medical

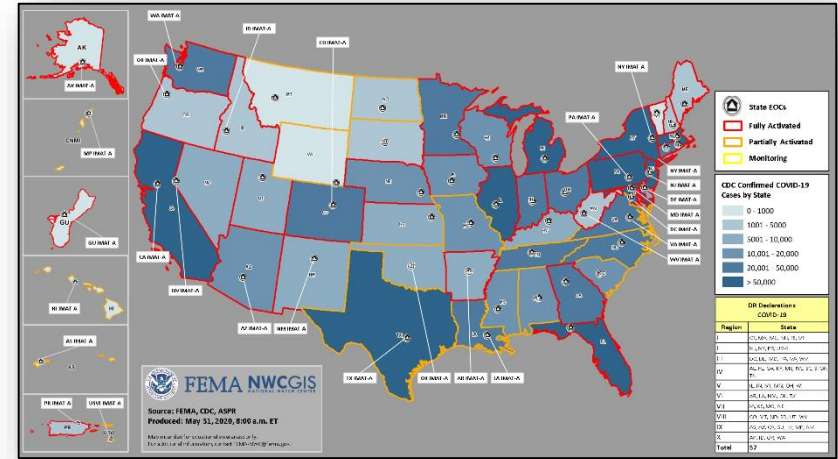
- WA Governor mandated testing for all long-term care facility residents and staff; skilled nursing facilities and assisted living (with memory care) facilities must complete testing by June 12 and June 26, respectively

### Food, Water, Shelter

- CA: Salvation Army and state delivered trailers to the Anaheim Emergency Shelter to be used as isolation units for shelter residents exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms
- NV: Salvation Army is partnering with Veterans Affairs to provide pallets of hygiene products and other items to Navajo Nation

## Response

- NRCC Level I; Region IX RRCC Level I; Region III and VIII RRCCs at Level III; Region VII RRCC is rostered but the Region continues to support COVID-19 response from the JFO in Kansas City, MO; all remaining RRCCs at Level II

**6-10 Day Precipitation Probability**

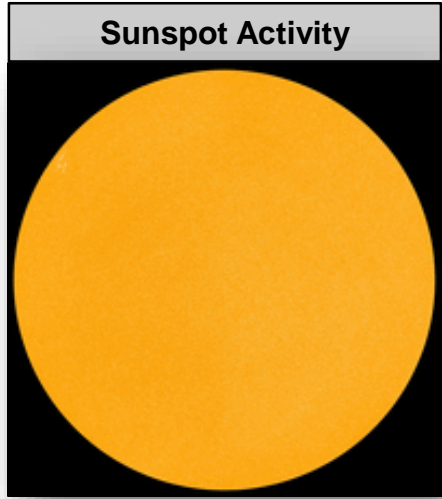
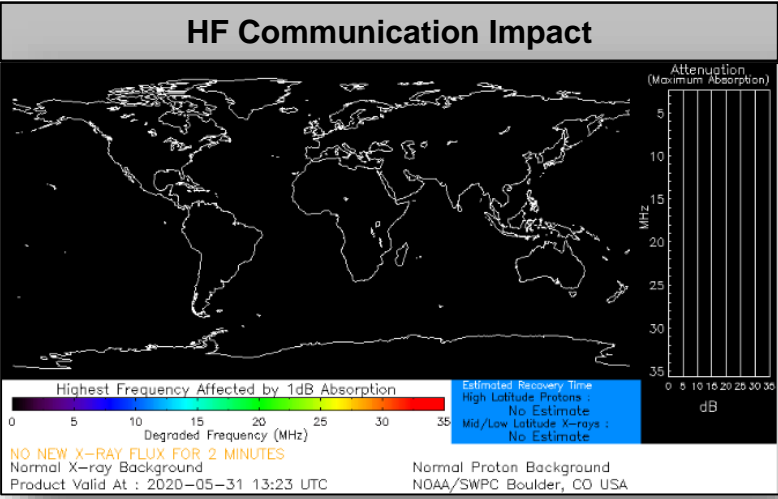

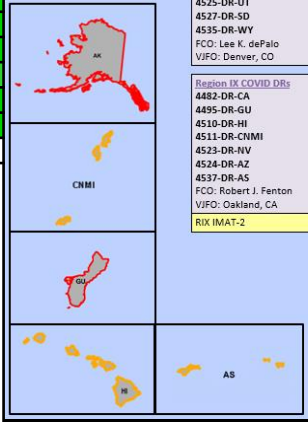
