Civil Unrest and Protests




Situation: Numerous protests, civil disturbances and marches are occurring in numerous cities around the nation. The demonstrations were sparked by the May 25 death of George Floyd in police custody in Minneapolis, MN. This event is receiving widespread local and national media coverage. All state EOCs were previously activated for COVID-19. Several states and cities have cited protests and civil unrest as a specific reason for activation as shown below. Media reports that at least (40) cities around the US have implemented nightly curfews.

FEMA Response:

- Region VII: JFO in Sioux Falls, SD activated COOP plans due to a breach of Empire mall; working from lodging UFN
- RRCC: Regions III, V, and VII working remotely








Severe Weather Outlook






Fire Weather Outlook











