
Super Typhoon Mawar – Guam



<u>Situation:</u> Locally executed, state managed, and federally supported recovery operations continue within the areas impacted by Super Typhoon Mawar.

Lifelines: (SLB as of 6:00 a.m. ET, June 7)

- Food, Water, Shelter:
- 3 shelters open with 748 (+10) occupants; 1 shelter open at Andersen AFB with 57 (+18) occupants
- 73% (+5) of wells operational; 3 of 8 drinking water systems operational, 5 partially operational
- 100% of wastewater systems operational; 4 on island power, 5 (-1) on back-up generators
- Health and Medical:
- Medical facilities operational; continuing to restore full operational capabilities
- Energy:
- Power restored to 61% (+5) of system load (customer demand); 43% (+2) of customers restored; 100% (+4) of substations restored
- Communications:
- o 57% (+4) of cell sites operational



Territory/Local Response:

- GU EOC at Full Activation
- Governor declared a State of Emergency addressing water shortages due to Mawar



Eastern Pacific






Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Formation chance through 48 hours Low (near 0%); 7 days – Low (near 0%)




National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Hazards Outlook - Jun 9-13






