
### **Super Typhoon Mawar - Guam FINAL**



<u>Situation:</u> Locally executed, state managed, and federally supported recovery operations continue within the areas impacted by Super Typhoon Mawar. Mission priorities continue to focus on community lifeline stabilization and expanding recovery operations.

Lifelines: (SLB #17 as of 5:00 a.m. ET, June 9)

- Food, Water, Shelter:
- 3 shelters open with 682 (-16) occupants; 1 shelter open at Andersen AFB with 39 (-18) occupants
- Roofing materials arriving 6/13
- 71% (-2%) of wells operational; All 8 drinking water systems operational
- 10 (+1) Water stations positioned in key locations to provide potable water
- 100% of wastewater systems operational; 4 on island power, 5 on back-up generators
- Energy:
- Power restored to 51% (+2%) of customers
- Communications:
- o 67% (+2%) of cell sites operational



#### Territory/Local Response:

- GU EOC at Full Activation
- Governor declared a State of Emergency addressing water shortages due to Mawar













### **Severe Weather Outlook**






# **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**


