## Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible - Carolinas

## Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
  - Disturbance 1 – Low (10%)
- Eastern
  - Disturbance 1 – Medium (40%)
- Central Pacific – No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

**Declaration Activity:** None

# COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. **37,586** FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; **2,647 (-8)** FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide testing: **21,693,633 (+879,364)** cumulative as of June 9.

## Lifelines Impacts:

### Food, Water, Shelter


- U.S. meatpacking facilities for beef, pork and poultry are operating at more than 95% of their average capacity compared to the same time last year

### Transportation

- NY Metro-North and LIRR transit systems preparing for increased ridership by ensuring railcars are sanitized and requiring use of cloth face coverings and hand sanitizer; Metro-North distributing 500k cloth face coverings, 10k gallons and 10k 2-oz hand sanitizer bottles provided by NY to the public

## Response:

- NRCC at Level I; Region I, II, and IV RRCCs at Level II; Region III, V, VI, VIII and X RRCCs at Level III; Region VII and IX RRCCs are rostered, COVID-19 response being worked from the Virtual JFOs in Kansas City, MO and Oakland, CA
- NWC and all RWCs and MOCs at Steady State, continue to monitor



- Formation chance through 5 days: **Medium (40%)**






**Atlantic**

- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)






# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall




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


