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Freedom 250 UFC Match – Washington, D.C.

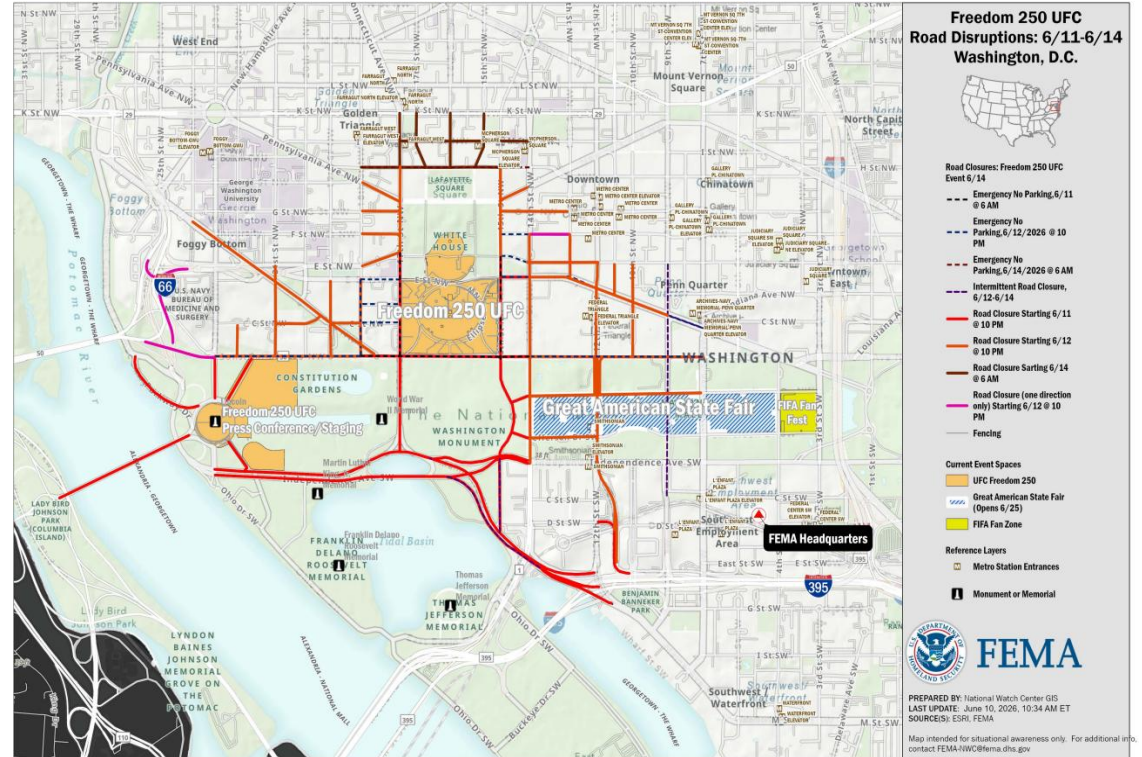
Situation: The Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC) Freedom 250 Match and Fan Festival is scheduled for June 13 and 14 in Washington, DC. Approximately 75K spectators are expected each day. Multiple federal and local law enforcement agencies are supporting this event. FEMA is the lead federal agency for emergency and consequence management. DHS has designated the UFC match a SEAR event.

Local Response:

- MPD is the lead local law enforcement agency

FEMA / Federal Response:

- USSS and US Park Police are providing event security
- FEMA NWC at Enhanced Watch



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Severe Weather – Midwest and the Great Lakes – FINAL

Situation: On June 11, severe thunderstorms posed a threat to the Midwest and Great Lakes region. The storms have since shifted eastward, and all tornadoes and severe thunderstorm watches and warnings have expired. Three tornado touchdowns were reported in Illinois, Indiana, and Wisconsin, resulting in downed power lines, snapped power poles, wind damage to buildings, and multiple power outages across all three states. Overall, power outages are improving as recovery efforts continue. The affected areas are not within any FIFA World Cup locations.

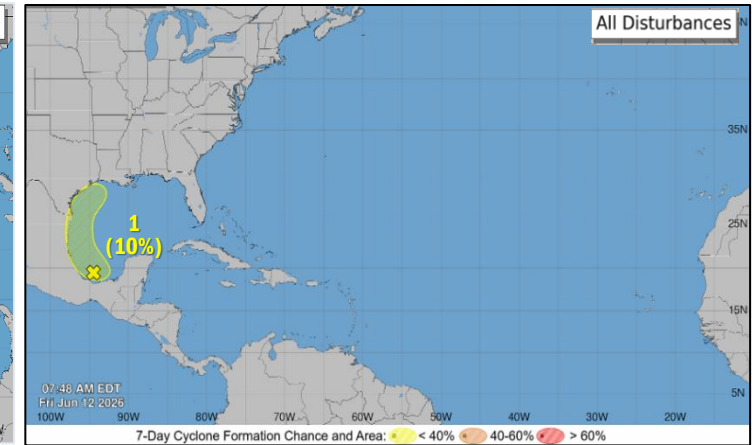
