Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe storms – Northern Plains to Upper Midwest
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1 – Low (20%)
- Central Pacific – No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

COVID-19 Update



Situation: FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 37,399 FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; **2,514 (-38)** FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide testing: **23,765,801 (+297,820)** cumulative as of June 17

Lifelines Impacts:

Food, Water, Shelter

- The USDA Farmers to Families Food Box Program has been extended to August 30, 2020 and will be expanded to serve additional areas (FEMA SLB COVID-19, June 17)


Communications

- Commerce Department reported widespread rebounds in sales in multiple sectors during May, concentrated in clothing, furniture, electronics and motor (FEMA SLB COVID-19, June 17)

Response:


- NRCC at Level I; Region I and II RRCCs at Level II; Region III, IV, V, VI, VIII, and X RRCCs at Level III; Region VII and IX RRCCs are rostered, COVID-19 response being worked from the Virtual JFOs
- NWC and all RWCs and MOCs at Steady State, continue to monitor






Atlantic

- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



National Weather Forecast




Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall


