






## Tropical Storm Bret SATELLITE LOOP




## Tropical Storm Bret FORECAST TRACK



# Tropical Storm Bret Most Likely Arrival of TS Winds




## Tropical Storm Bret 5-DAY RAINFALL

### **Tropical Storm Bret - Preparations**

#### **Current Situation:**

The area of low pressure in the Atlantic is now Tropical Storm Bret and could become a hurricane in a couple of days. On forecast track, Tropical Storm Bret will approach the Lesser Antilles by late this week.

PR and USVI EOCs at Normal Operations (anticipated to activate on June 21)


#### **FEMA/Federal Preparation:**

- LNOs, pre-designated FCOs, DCE and ESFs 1, 2, 3, 8, 12, 13 and 14 deploying to PR and USVI


#### HQ:

- National IMAT Blue deploying to IOF in PR, to be in place by 8:00 a.m. ET, June 21

- NWC in coordination with Region II will continue to monitor; the next update will be in the 5:00 p.m. ET National Situation Report








## **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**
