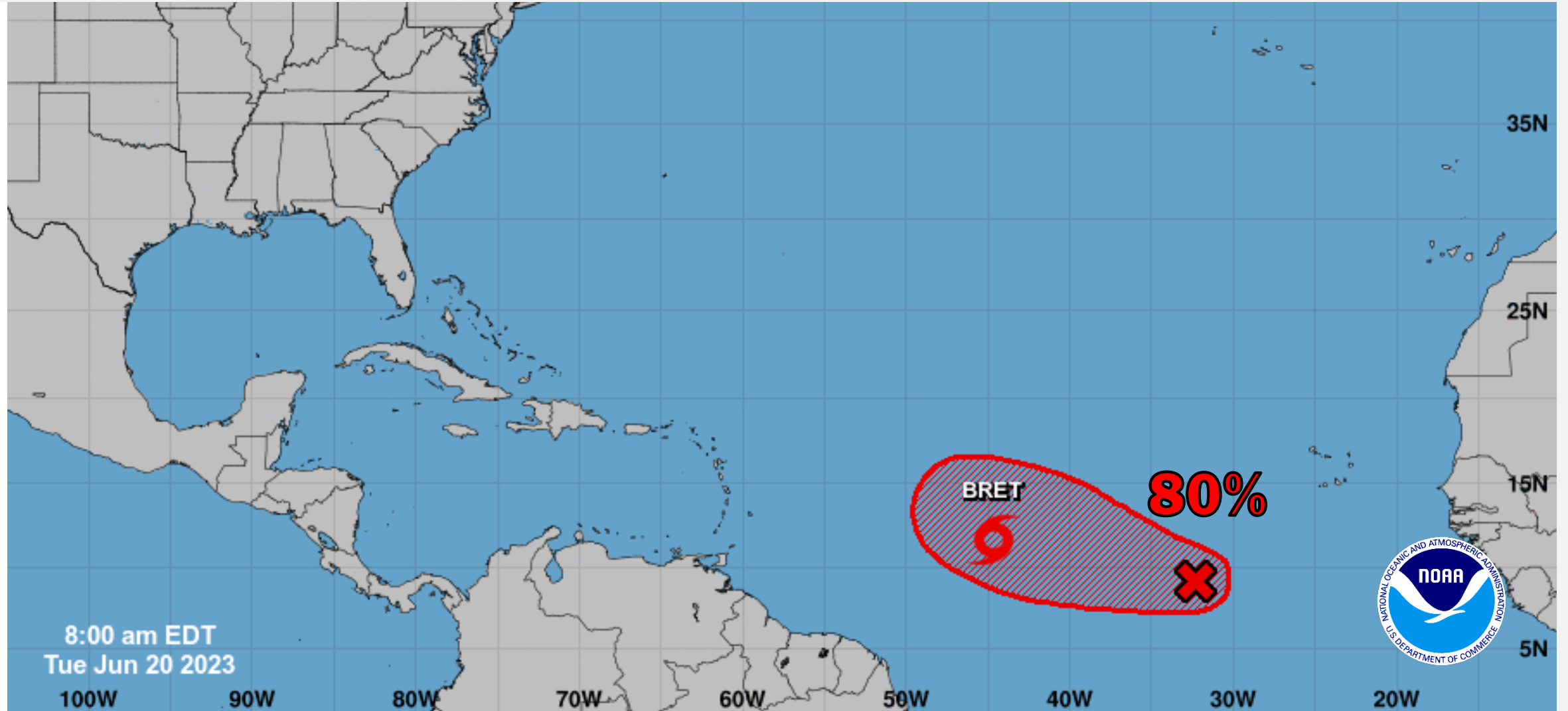

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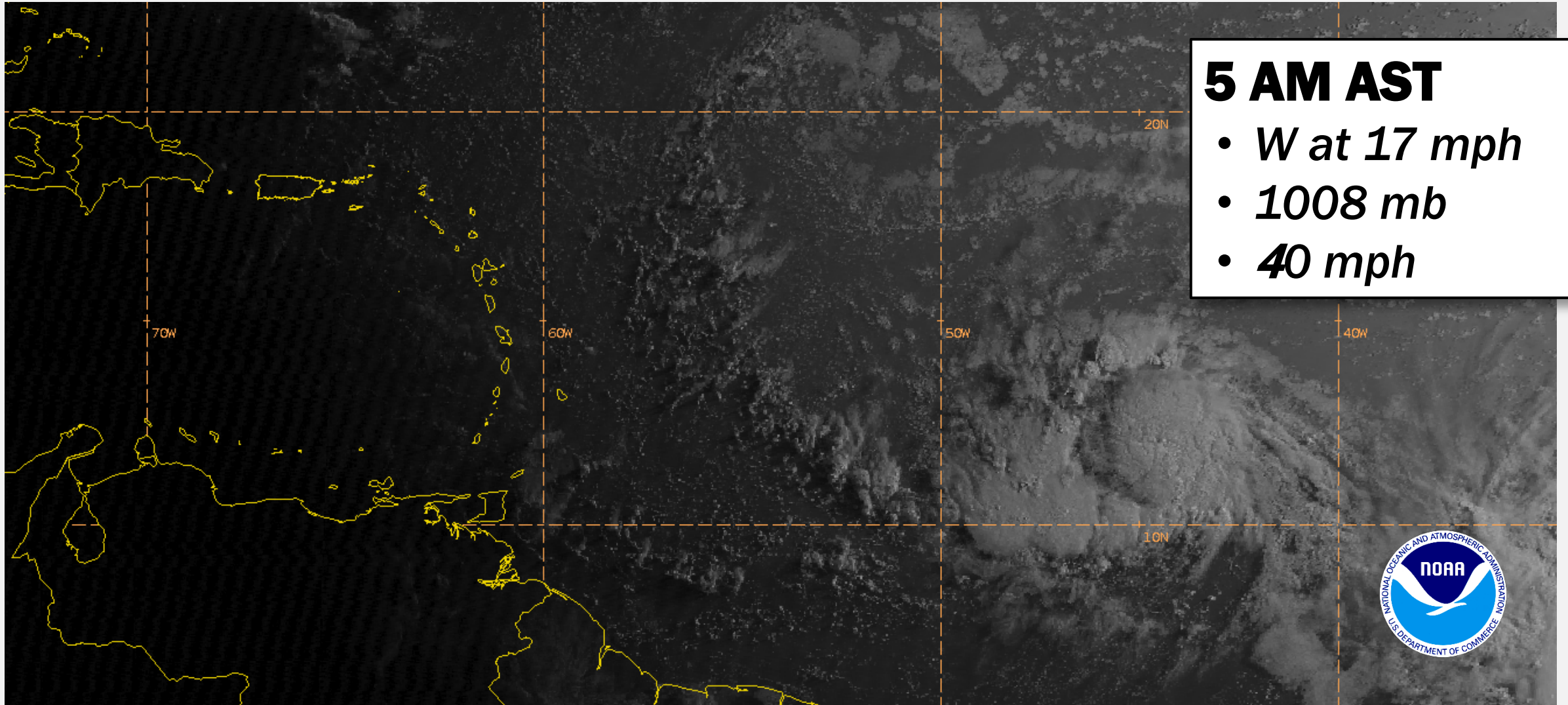

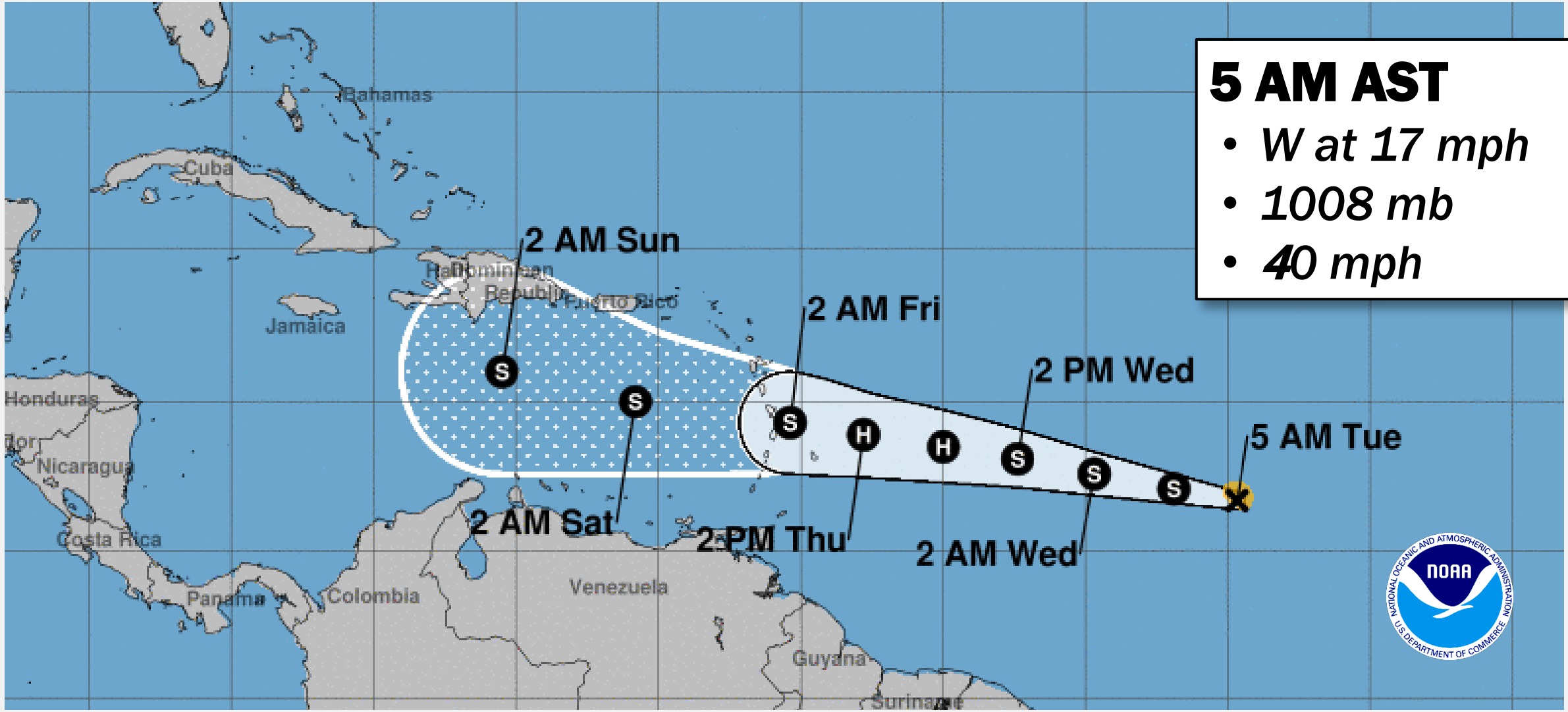

SATELLITE LOOP



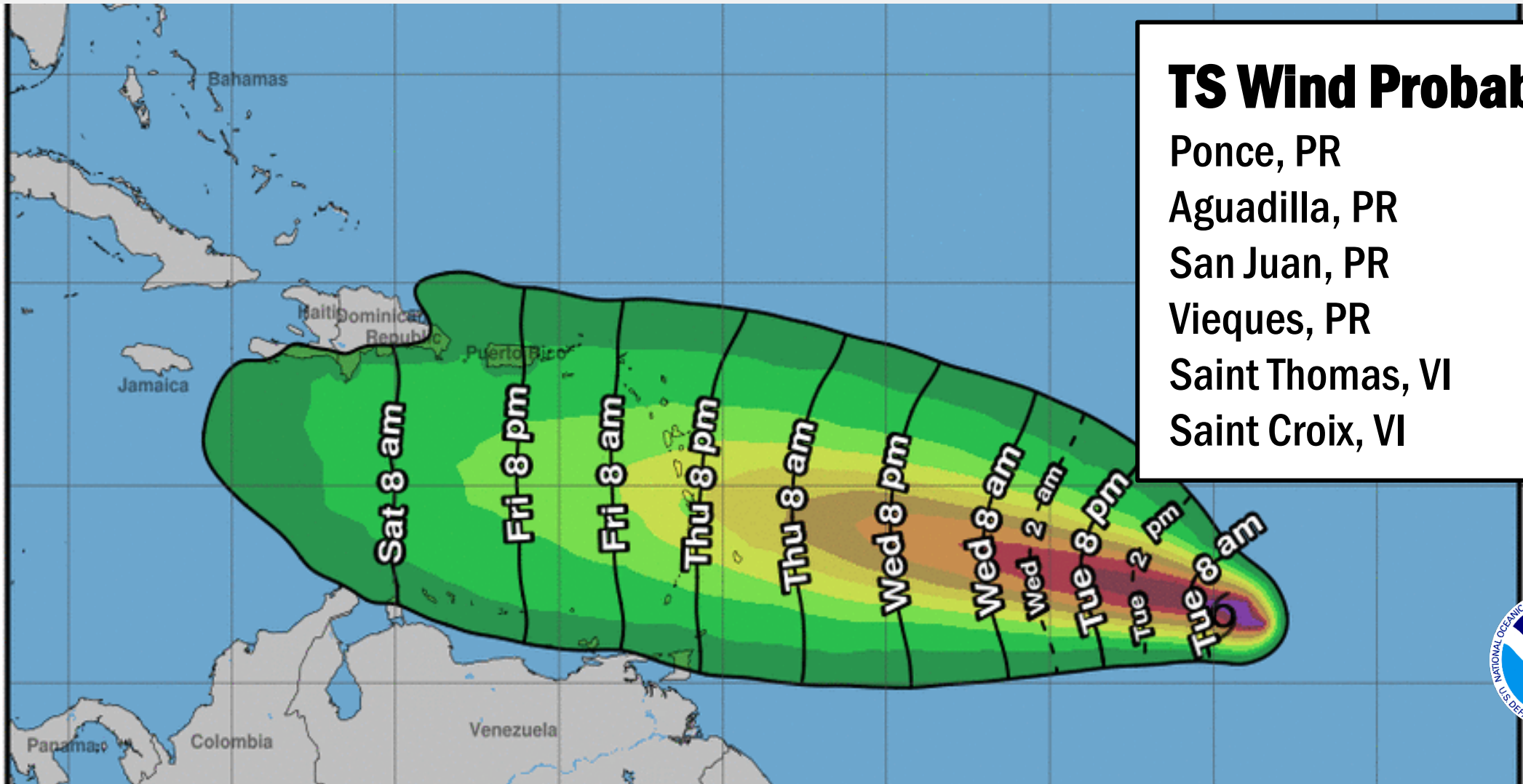

MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS



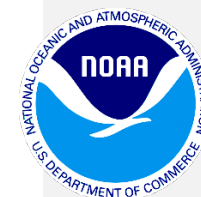
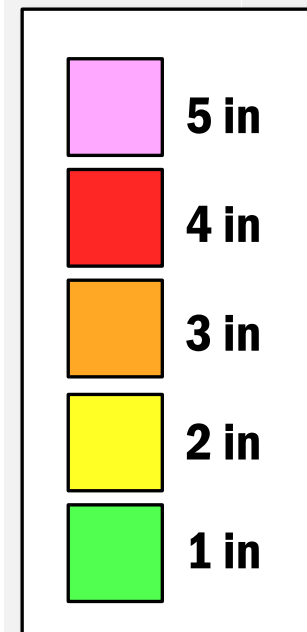
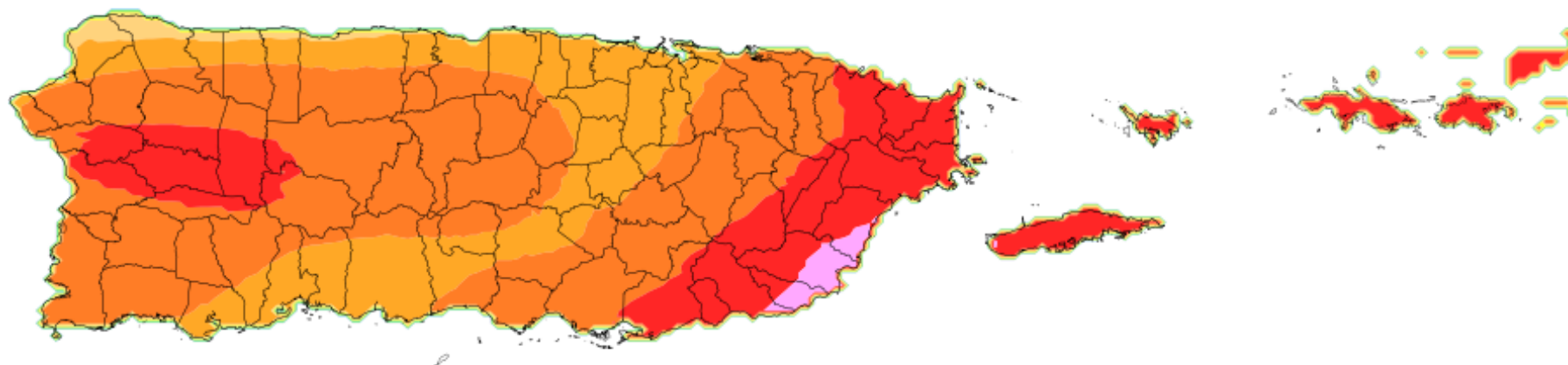

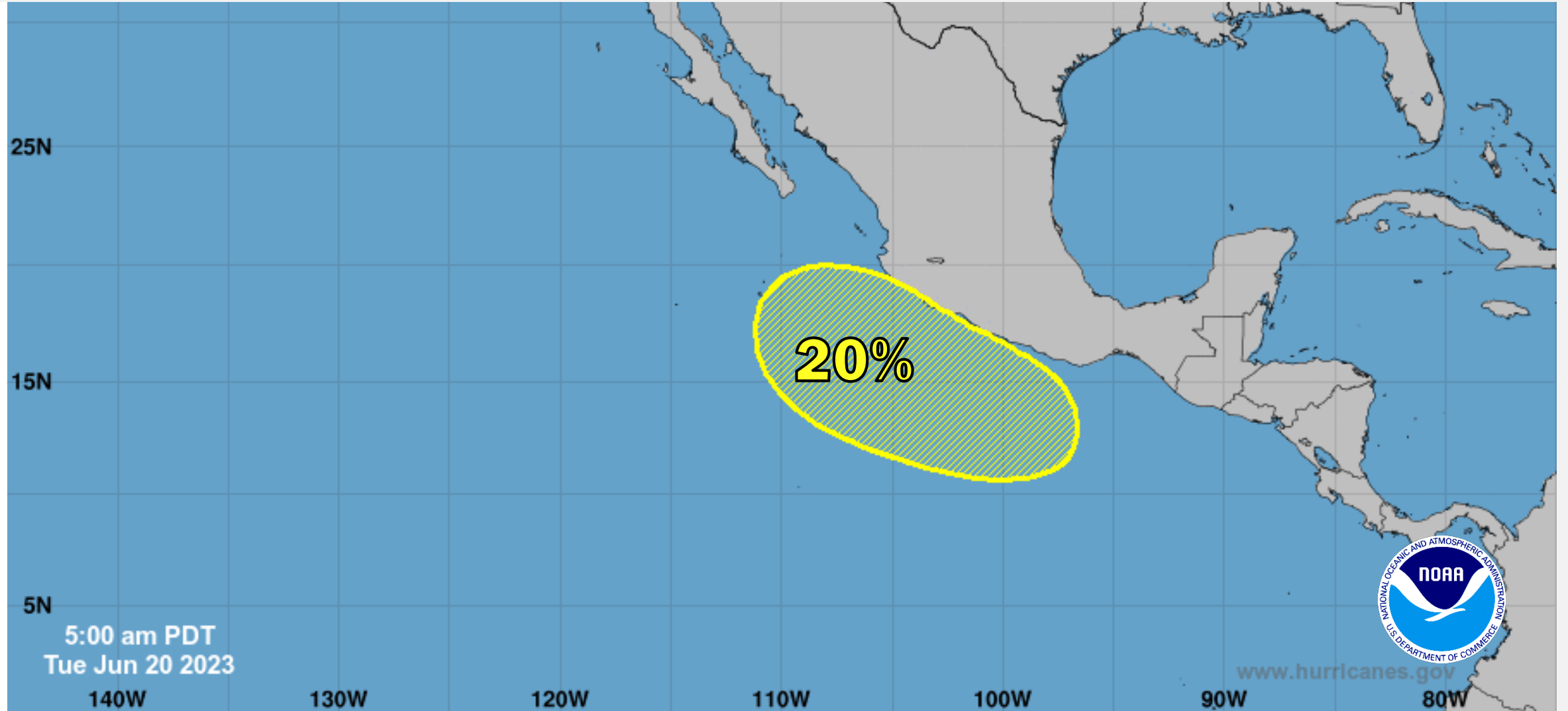

5-DAY RAINFALL



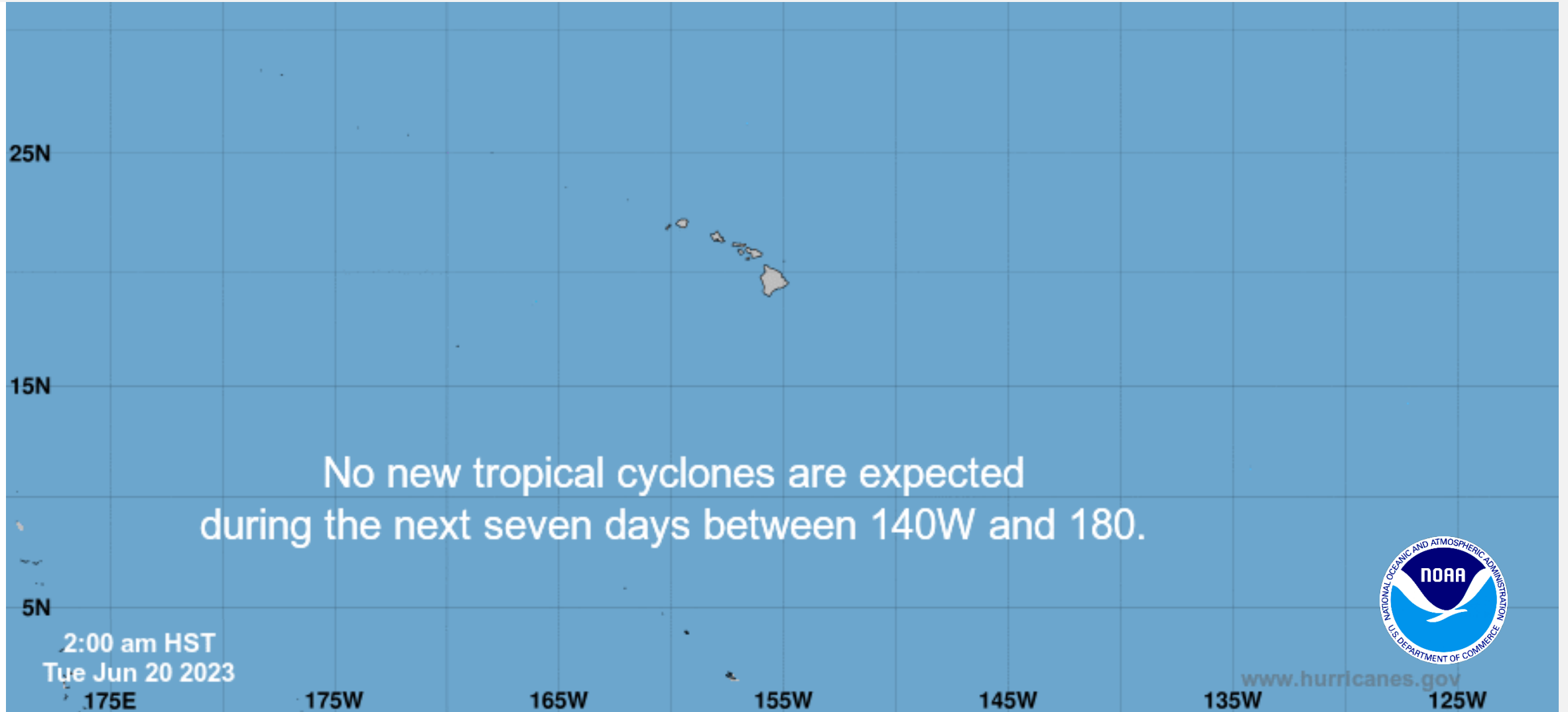

Tropical Storm Bret – Preparations

Current Situation:

The area of low pressure in the Atlantic is now Tropical Storm Bret and could become a hurricane in a couple of days. On forecast track, Tropical Storm Bret will approach the Lesser Antilles by late this week.

Territory /Local Preparation:

- PR and USVI EOCs at Normal Operations (anticipated to activate on June 21)

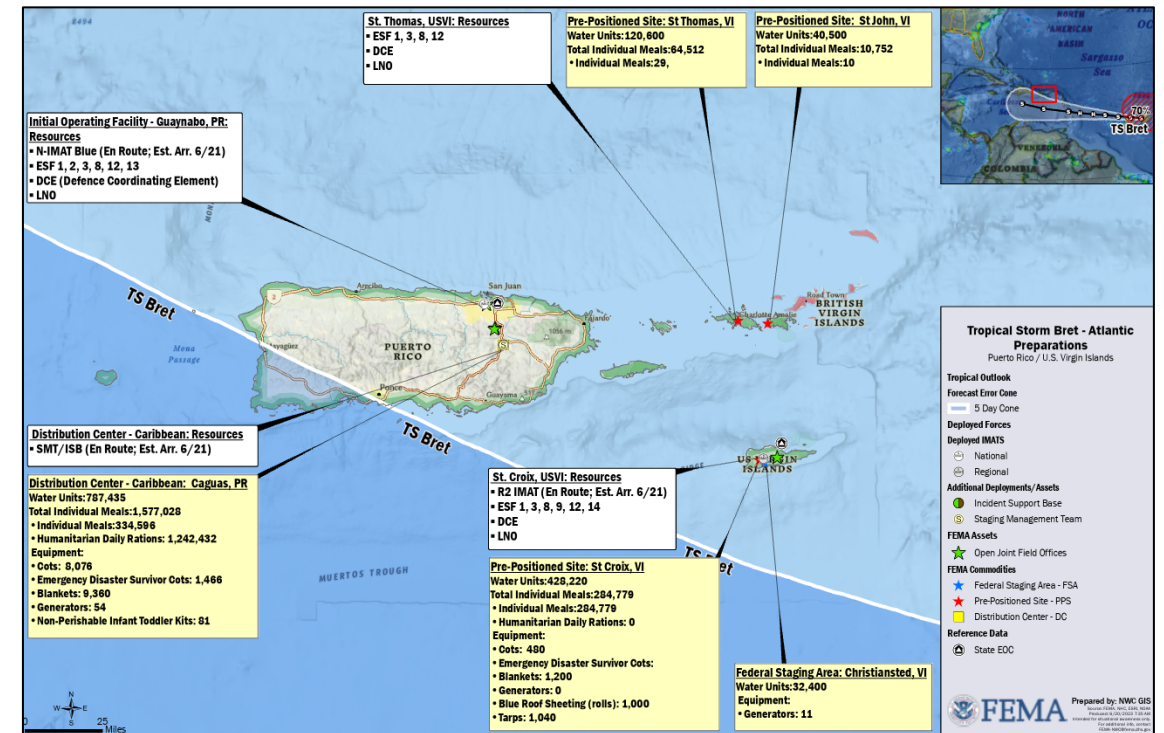
FEMA/Federal Preparation:

Region II:

- RWC at Enhanced Watch
- RRCC with ESFs 1, 2, 3, 8, 12, 13, 14 and DCE will activate, day shift only, at 12:00 p.m. ET today, June 20
- IMAT: Deploying to USVI, operational at 8:00 a.m. ET, June 21
- LNOs, pre-designated FCOs, DCE and ESFs 1, 2, 3, 8, 12, 13 and 14 deploying to PR and USVI

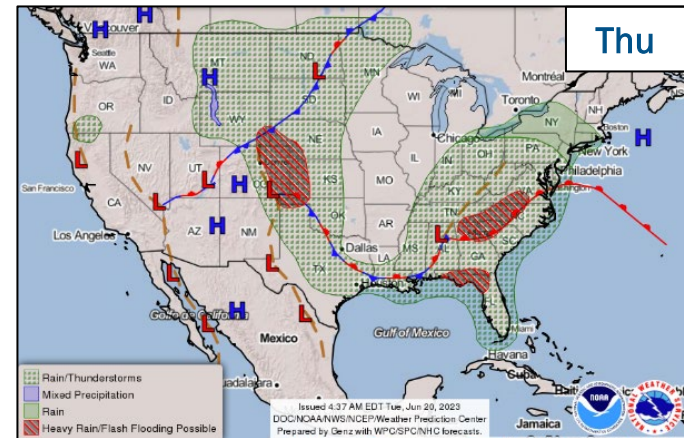
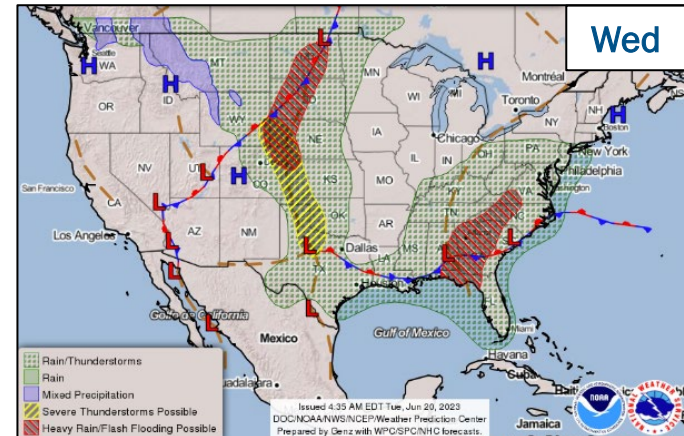
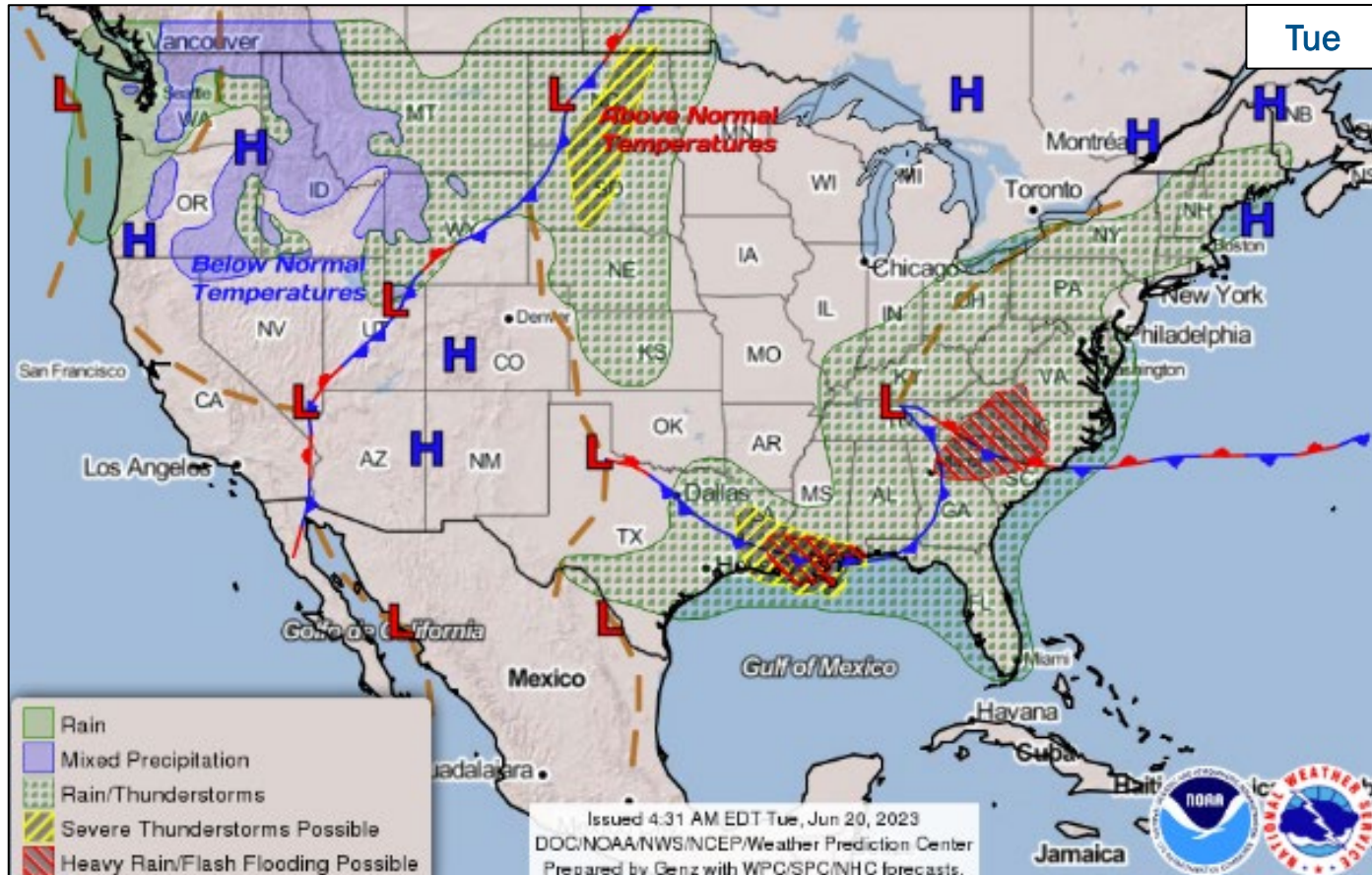
HQ:

- National IMAT Blue deploying to IOF in PR, to be in place by 8:00 a.m. ET, June 21

- USACE: Three Type 4 power teams deploying to PR and USVI
- NWC in coordination with Region II will continue to monitor; the next update will be in the 5:00 p.m. ET National Situation Report



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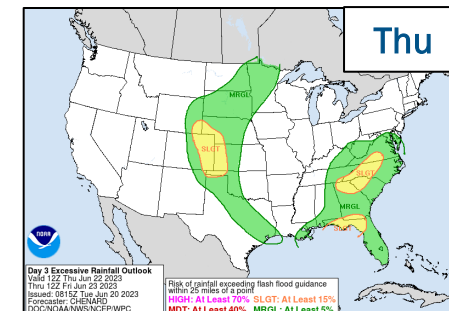
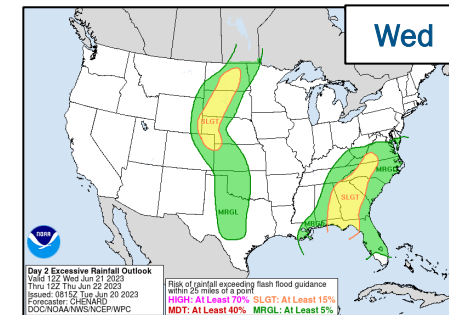
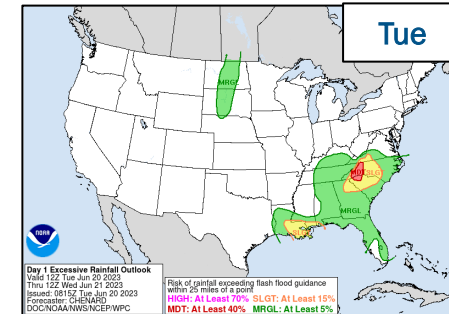
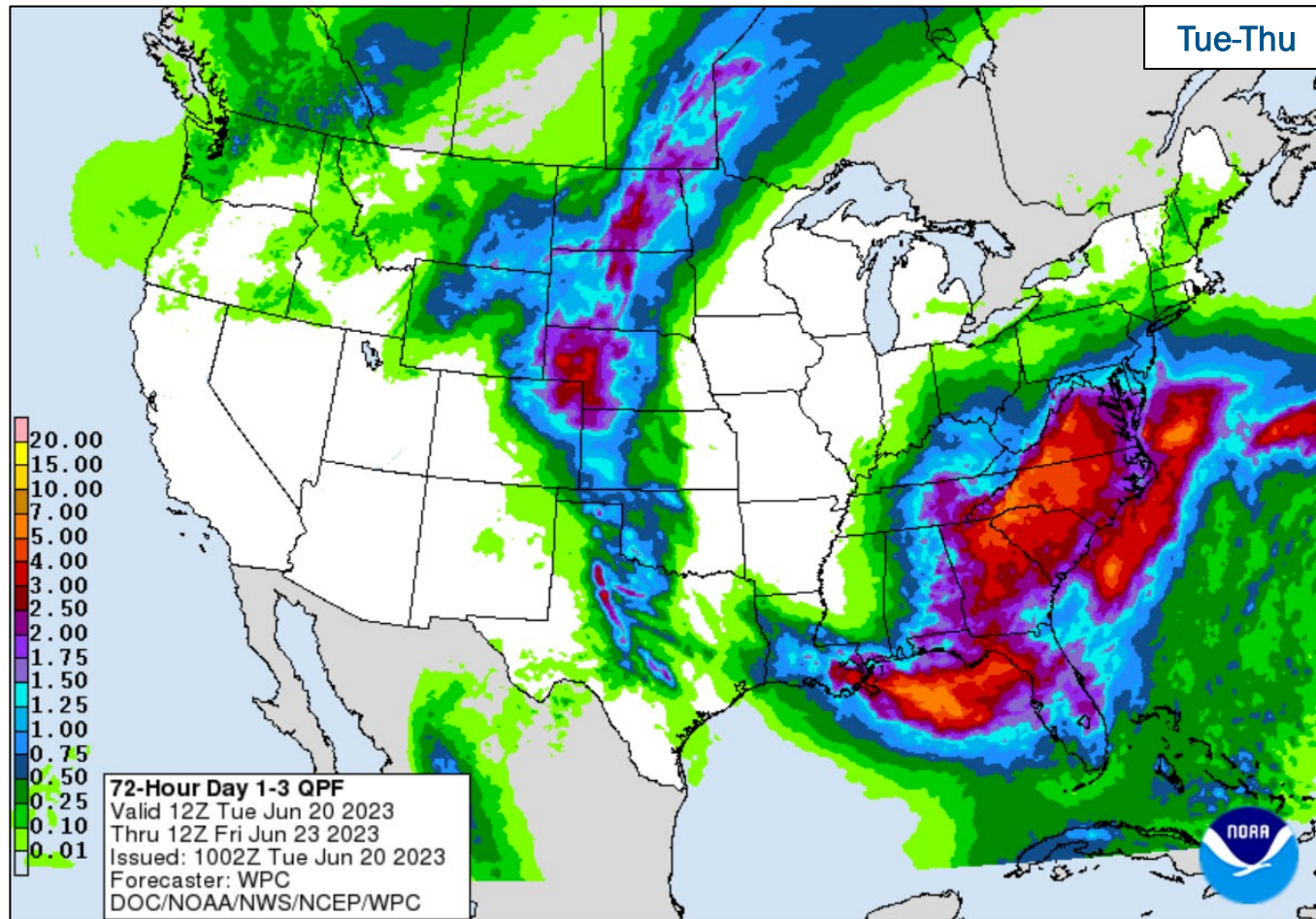

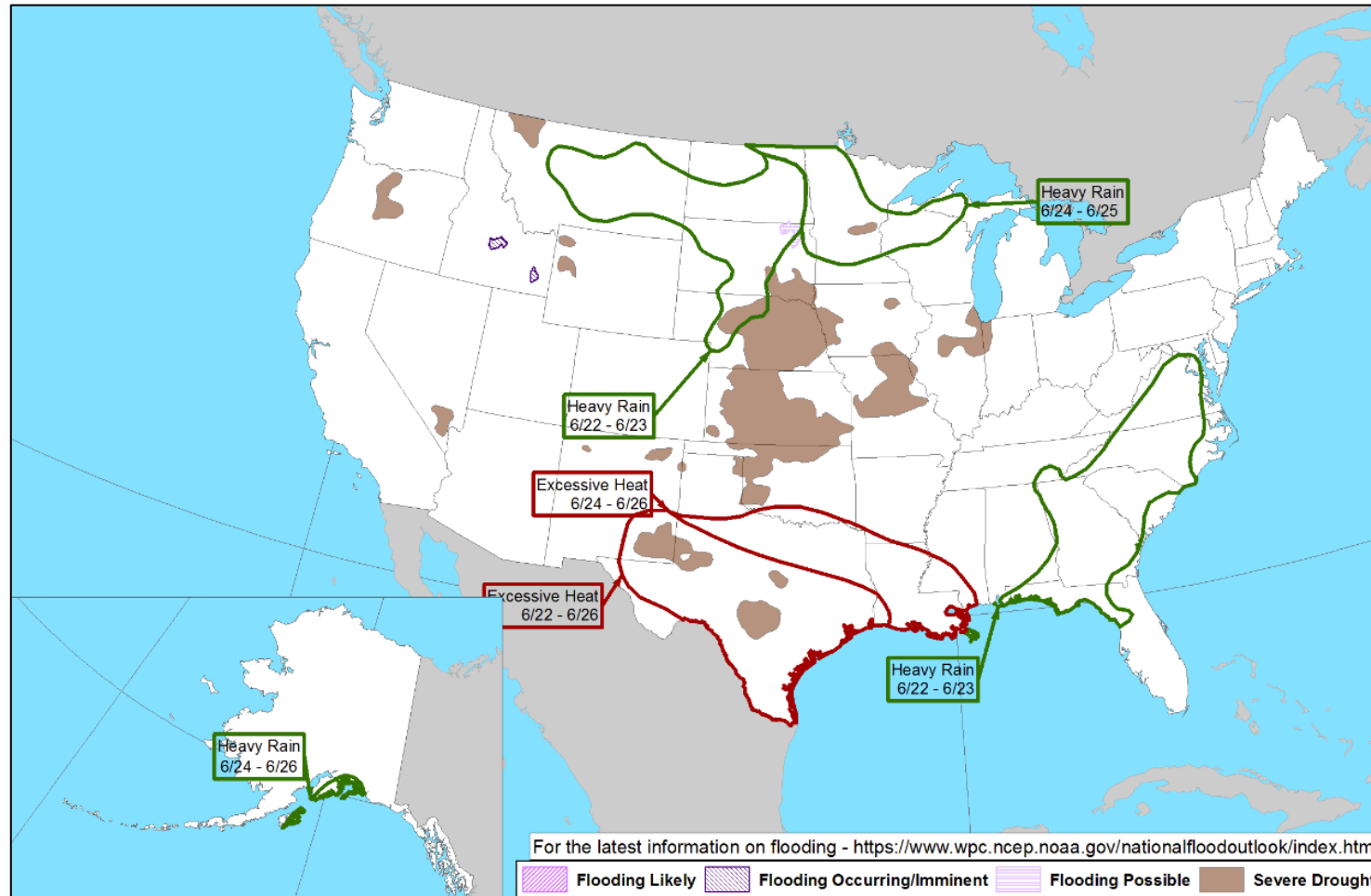
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



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Hazards Outlook – Jun 22-26



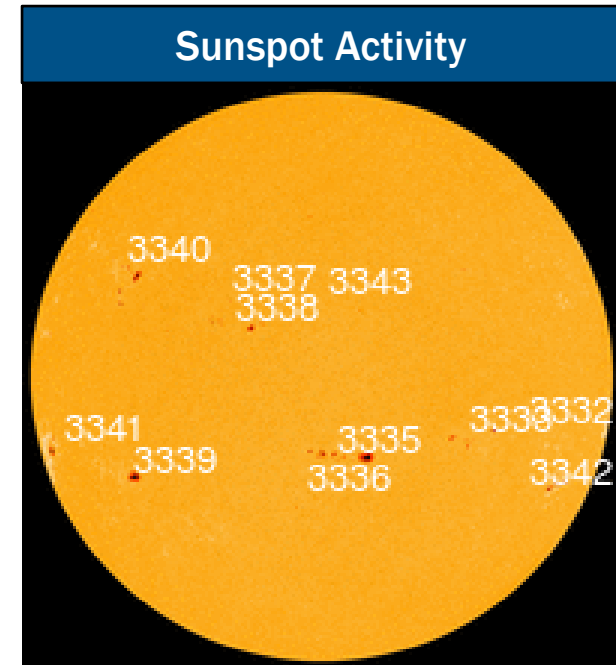
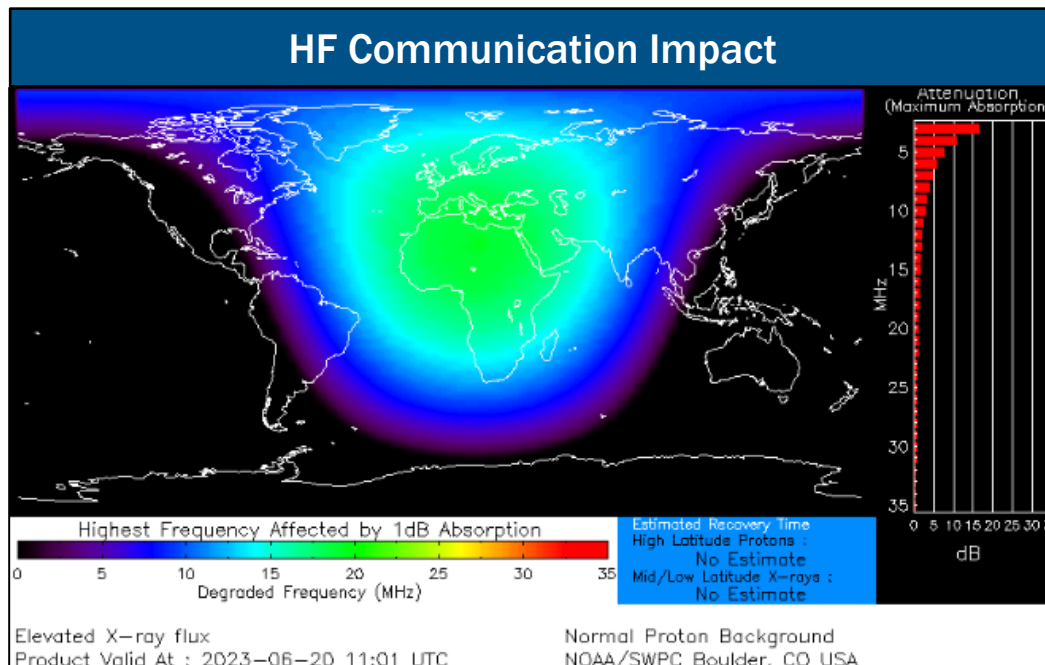

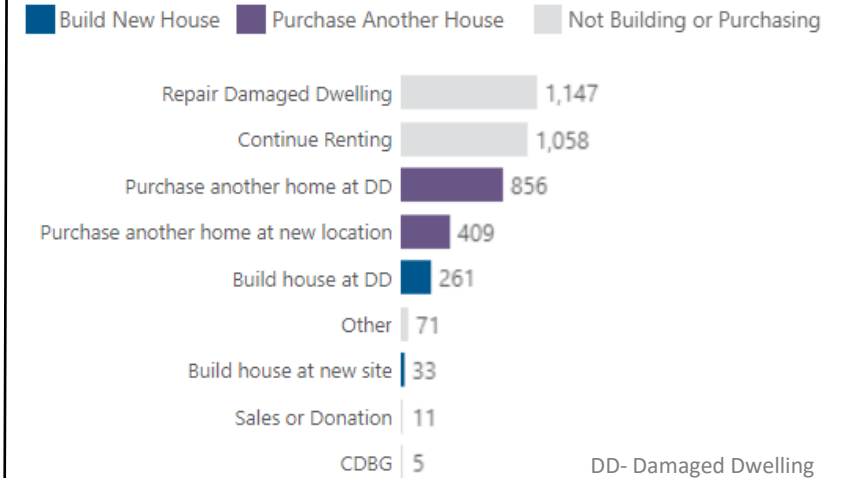
Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State
