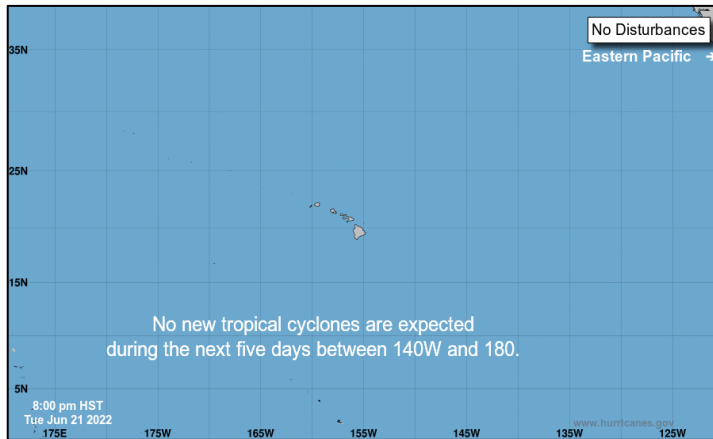

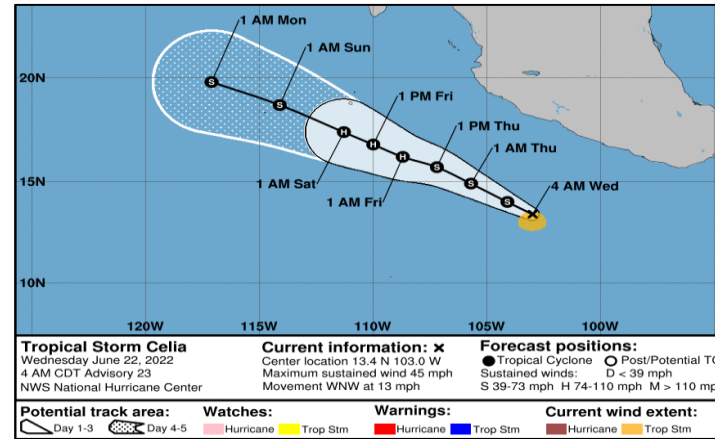
# Tropical Outlook – Five Day

- No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

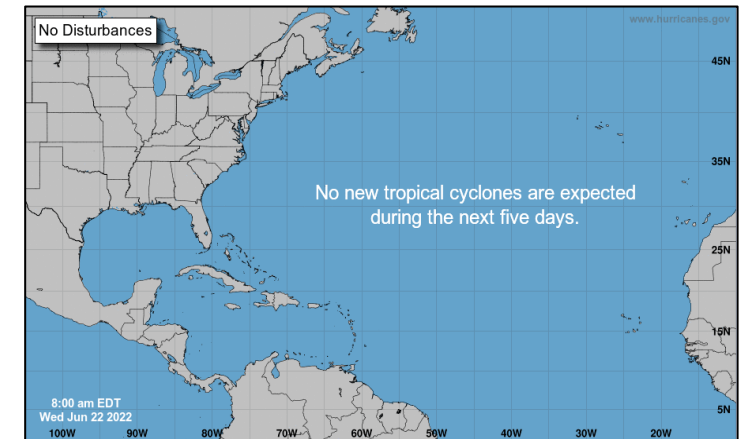
## Eastern Pacific



### Tropical Storm Celia (Advisory #23 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 310 miles SSW of Zihuatanejo, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 13 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Forecast to become a hurricane late Thursday
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 60 miles

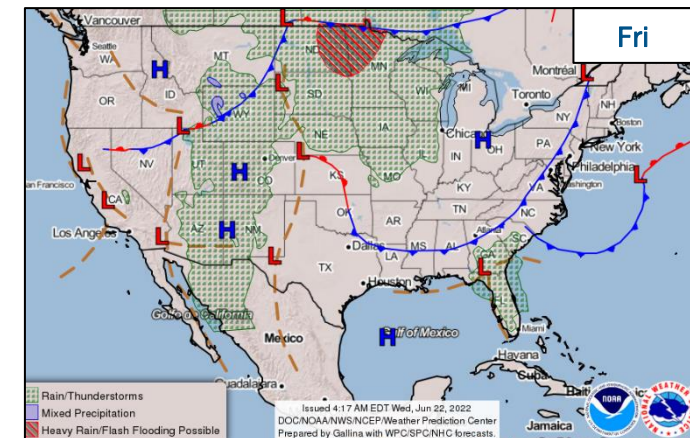
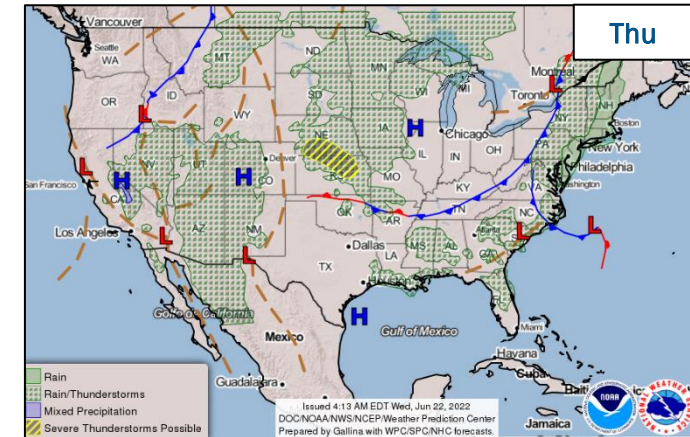
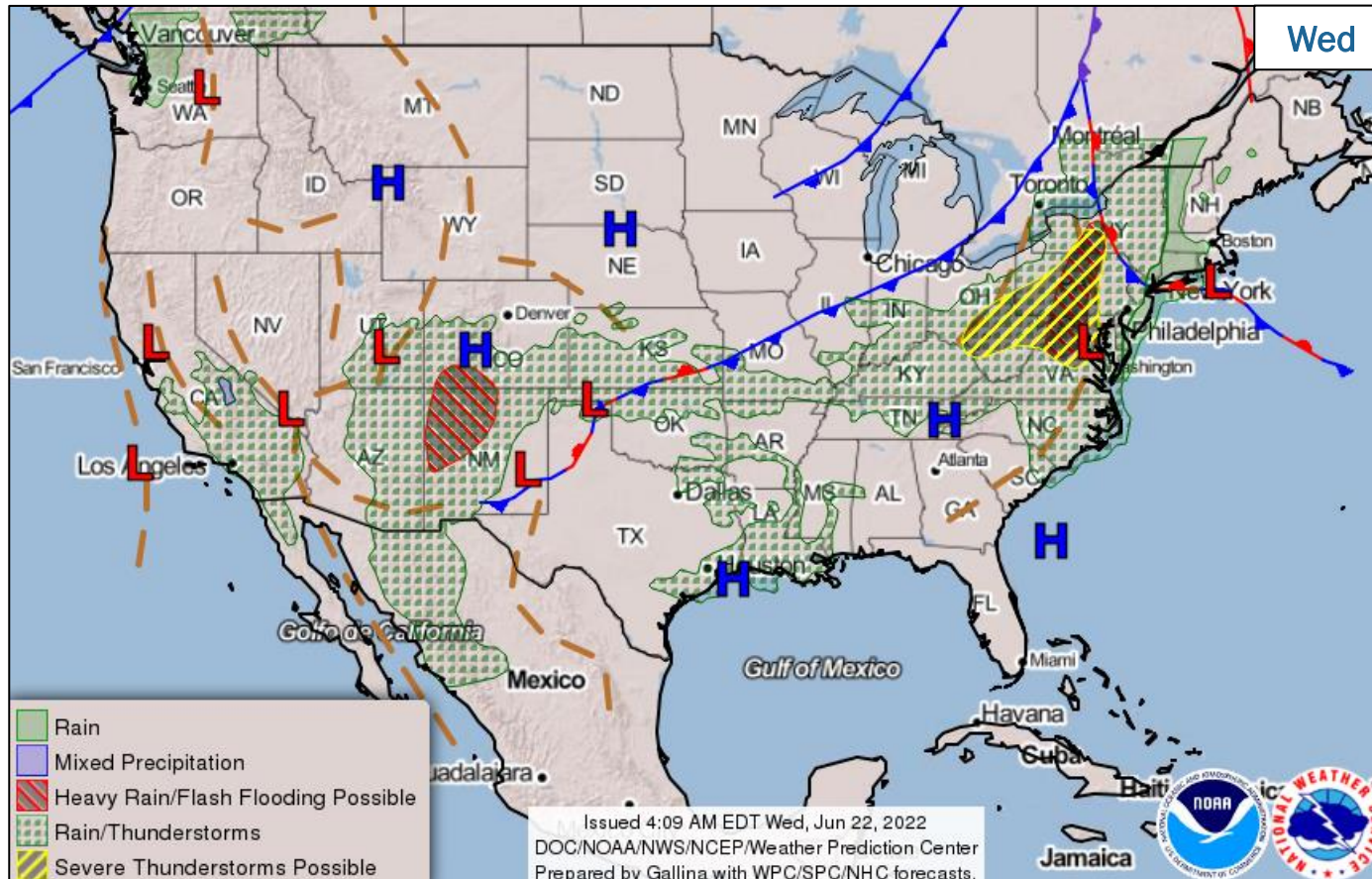

# National Weather Forecast

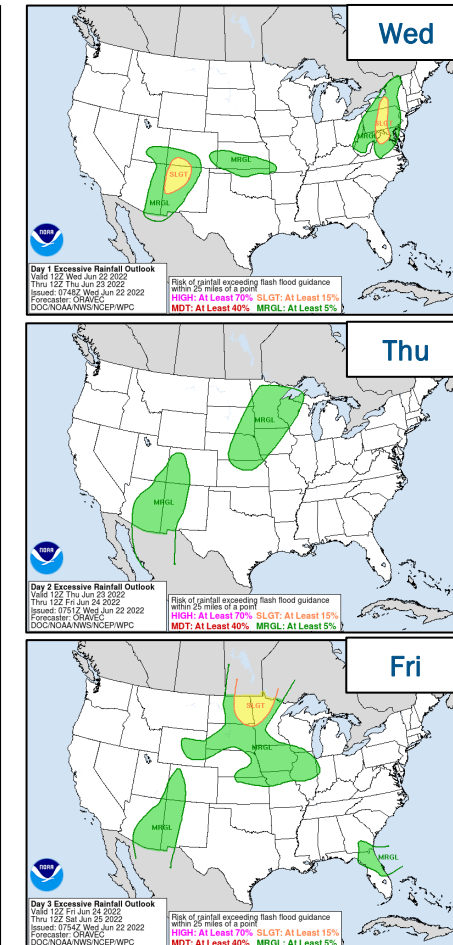
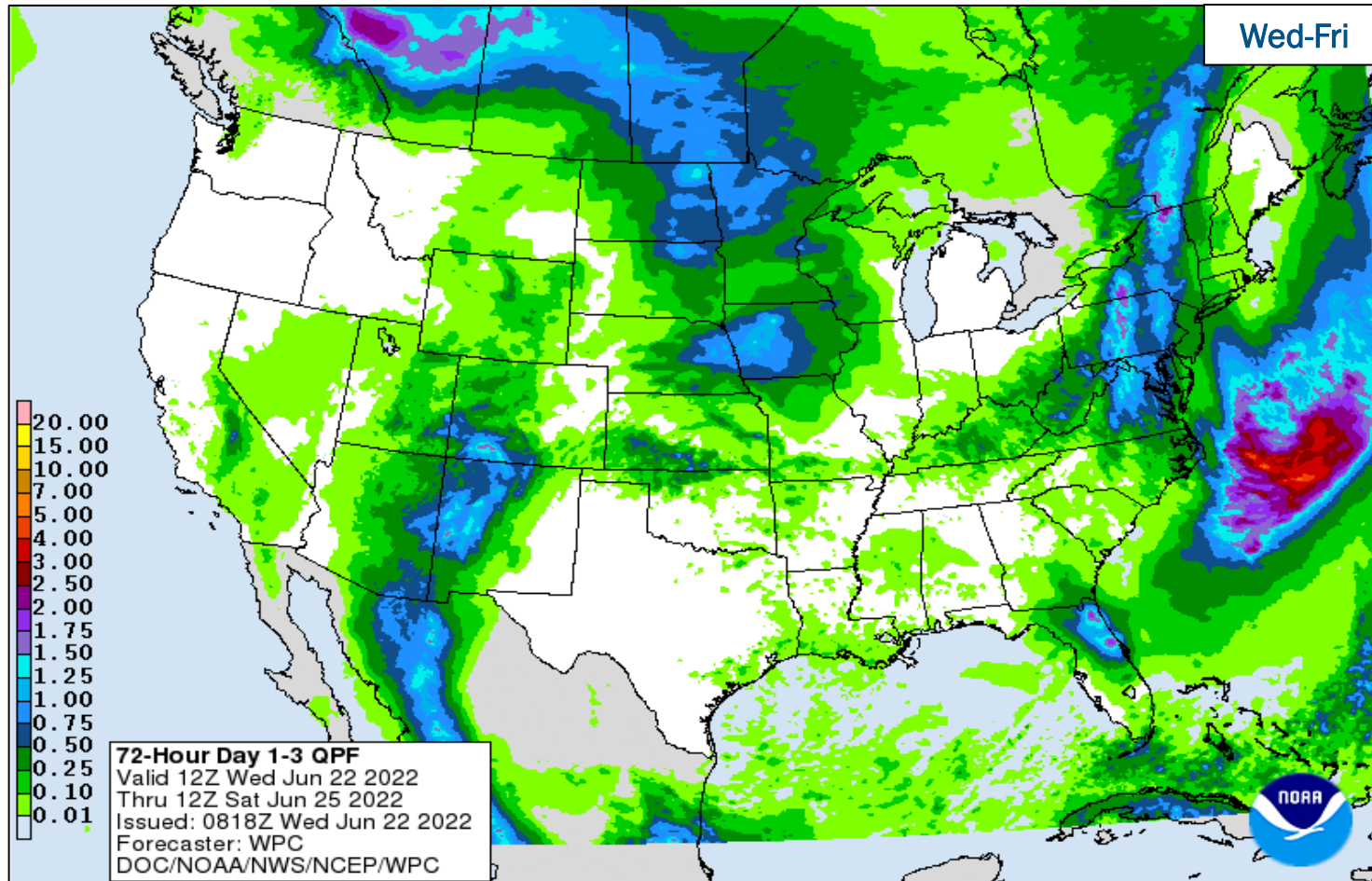

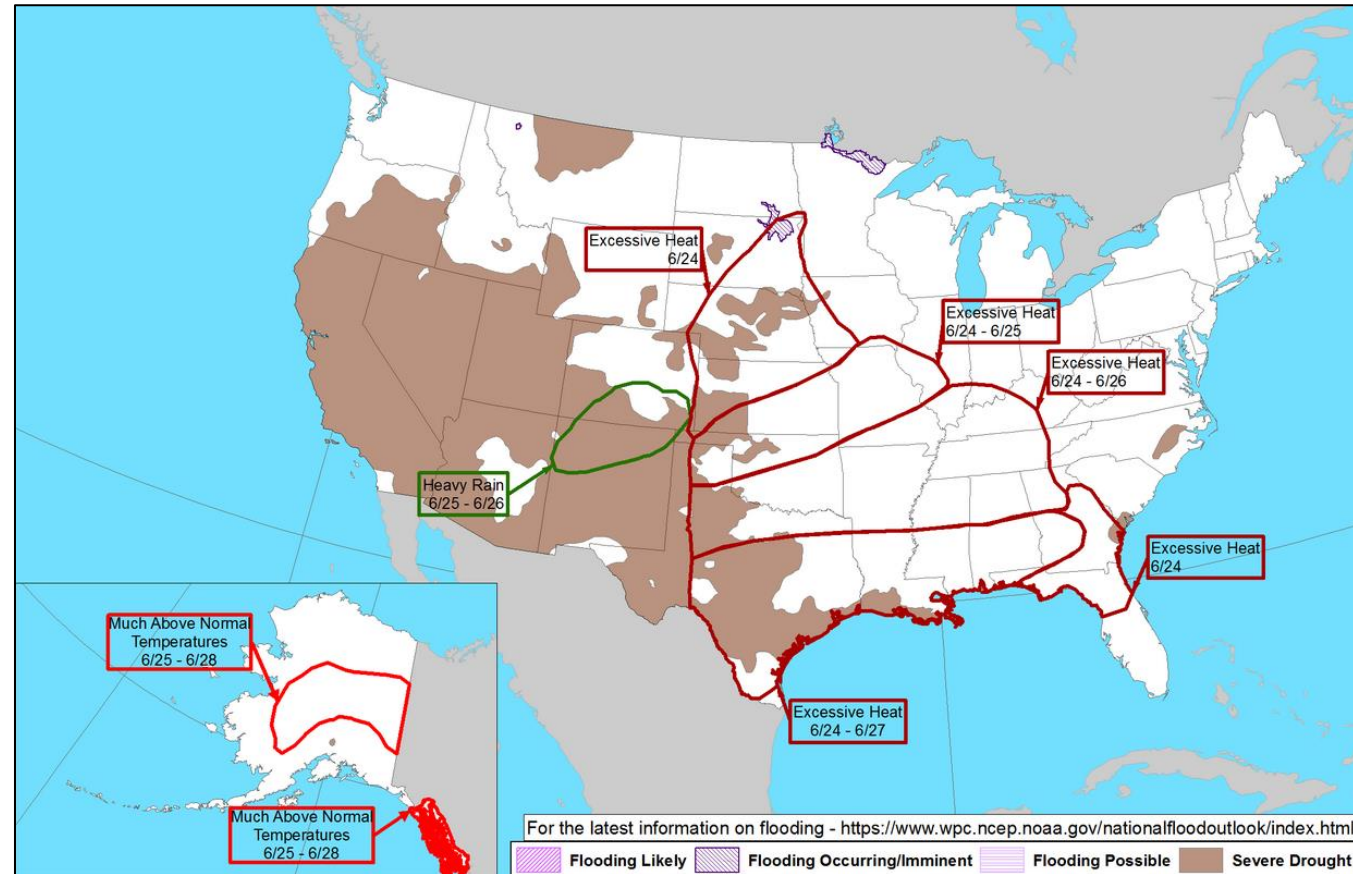
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

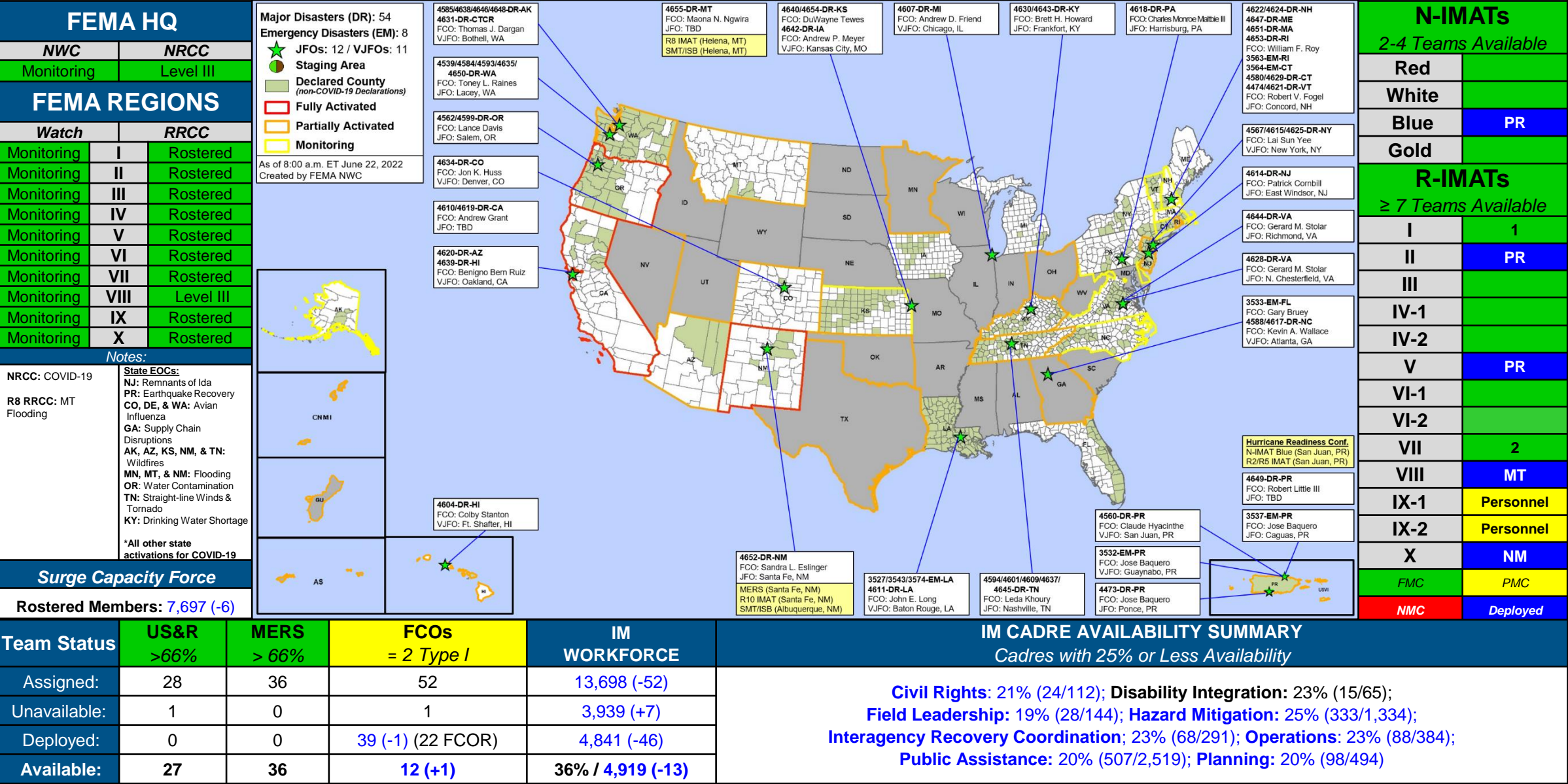
