

Tropical Storm Bret - Atlantic

Tropical Storm Bret. (Advisory #16A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 160 miles W of St. Vincent
- Moving W at 18 mph
- On the forecast track, the center will continue moving westward away from the Windward Islands and across the eastern and central Caribbean Sea during the next couple of days
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 125 miles
- Expected to dissipate over the central Caribbean Sea by Saturday night or Sunday






Tropical Storm Cindy – Atlantic

Tropical Storm Cindy. (Advisory #5 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 990 miles E of the Lesser Antilles
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- On the forecast track, expected to remain well east and northeast of the northern Leeward Islands through early next week
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Some strengthening forecast during the next couple of days
- Tropical storm force winds extend 60 miles







Tropical Outlook - Seven Day

Central Pacific






 No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next seven days



Disturbance 1 (As of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- Area of low pressure located several hundred miles south of southern Mexico
- Moving WNW parallel to the southwestern coast of Mexico
- Tropical depression is expected to form by early next week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (10%);7-day: High (80%)

Current Situation:

FEMA remains in close coordination with officials in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. IMATs, logistics staging teams and other resources are deployed and available to support, if needed; however, based on the forecast tracks no direct impacts are currently expected from either Bret or Cindy.





Severe Weather Outlook





Fire Weather Outlook


