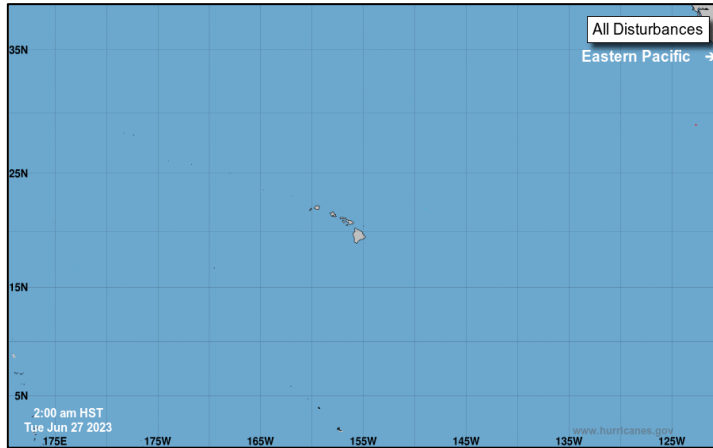

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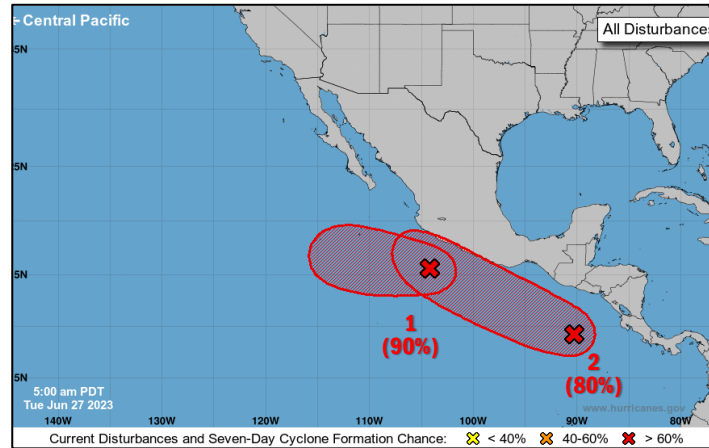
# Tropical Outlook – Seven Day

## Eastern Pacific



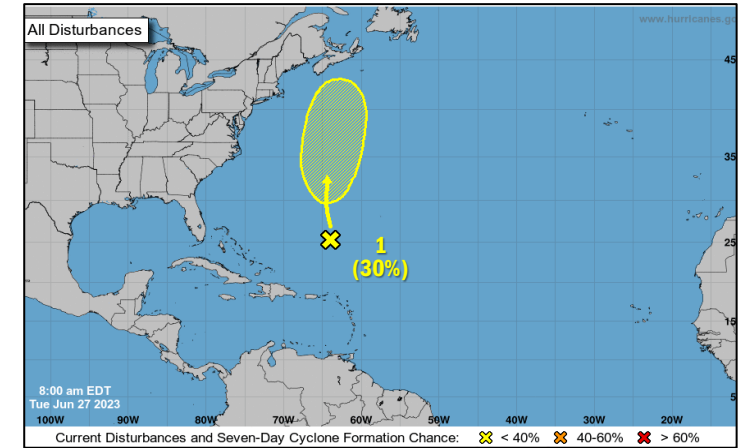
### Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a couple of hundred miles SW of the Zihuatanejo, Mexico
- Moving W
- Tropical depression is expected to form during the next day or two
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (70%); 7-day: High (90%)

### Disturbance 2 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Low pressure area located a few hundred miles south of the coasts of Guatemala and El Salvador
- Moving slowly WNW
- Tropical depression could form during the middle to latter part of this week
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Medium (50%); 7-day: High (80%)

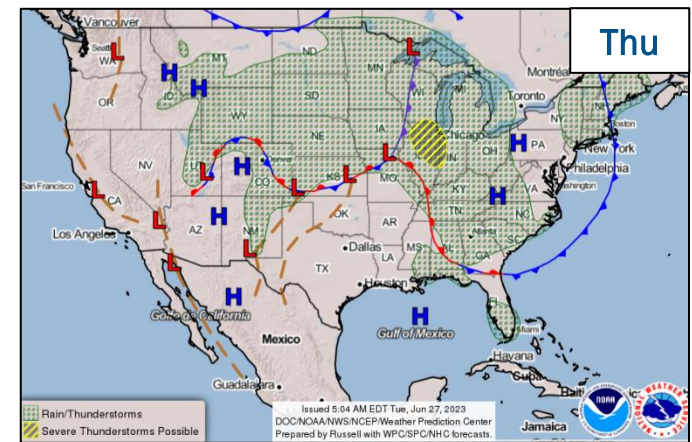
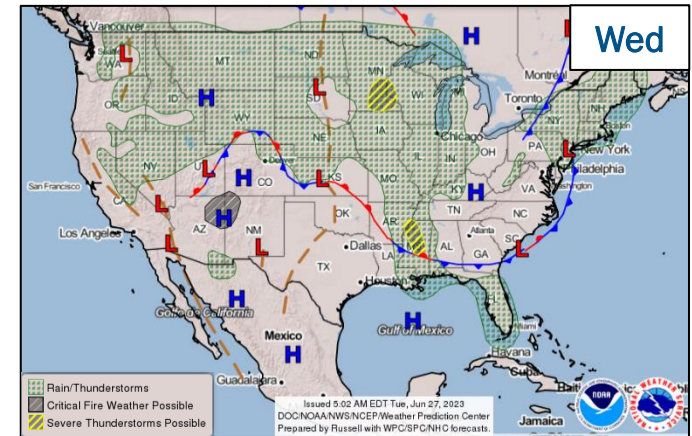
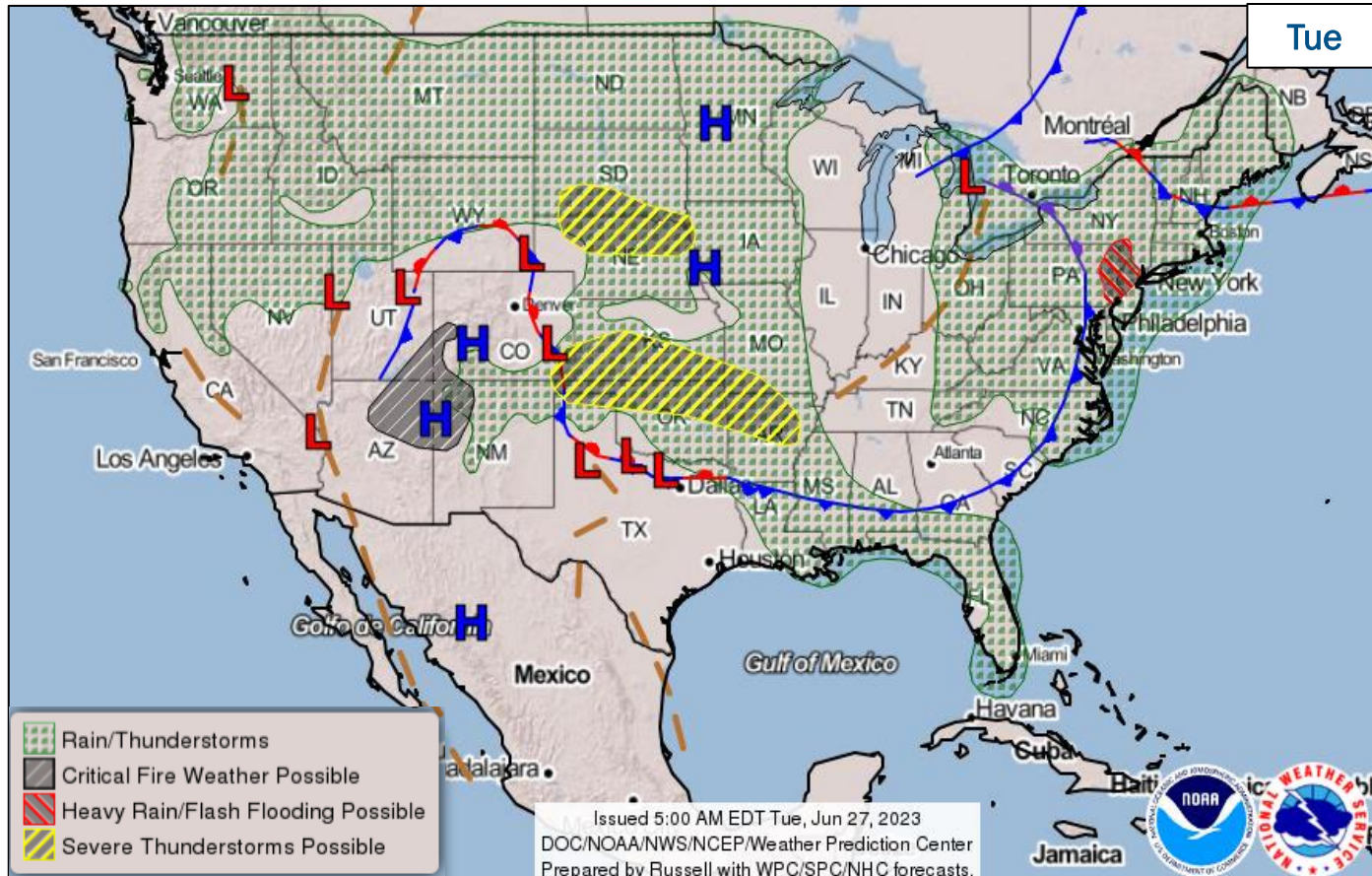
### Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (30%)



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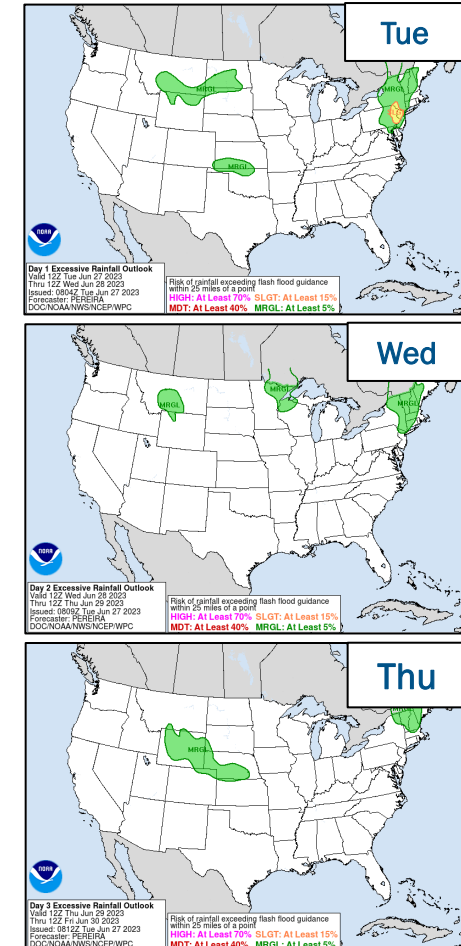
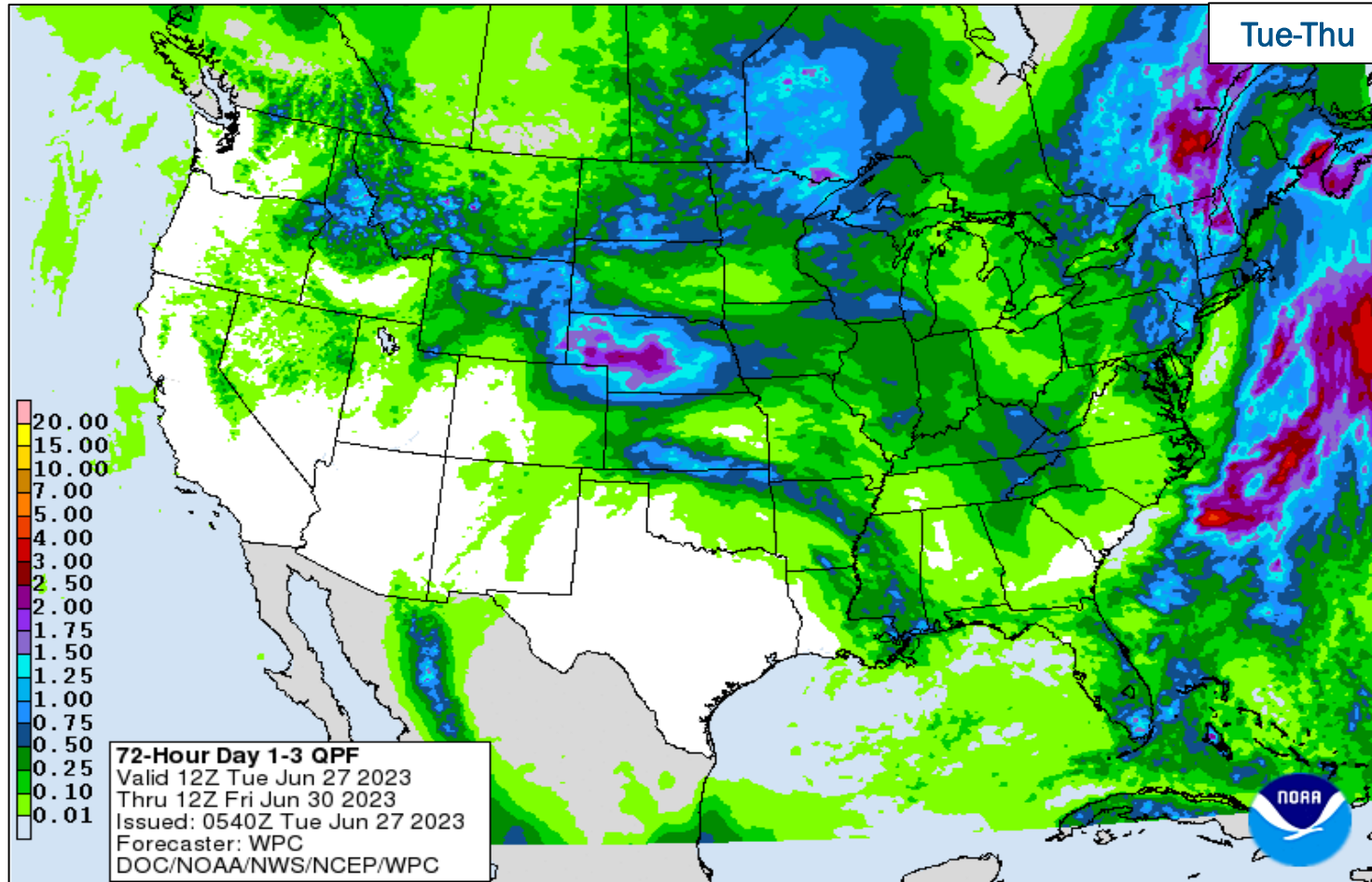

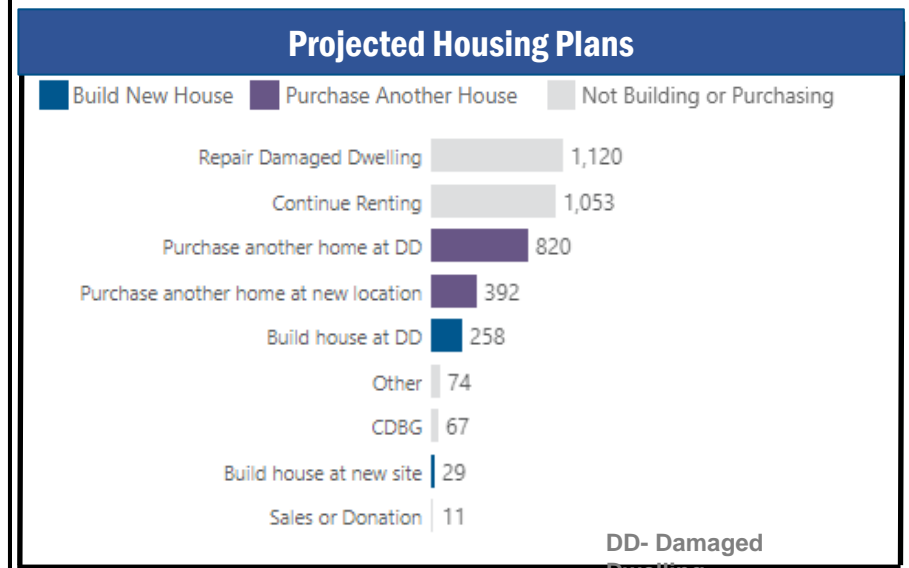
