- Severe Thunderstorms – Central Plains, Upper Mississippi Valley to Great Lakes, and Northeast
- Fire Weather – Four Corners Region
- Excessive Heat – Central and Eastern U.S.
- Tropical Activity:
 - Atlantic: Disturbance 1 – Low (10%)
 - Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1 (EP95) – High (80%)
 - Western Pacific: Invest 95W (Medium)

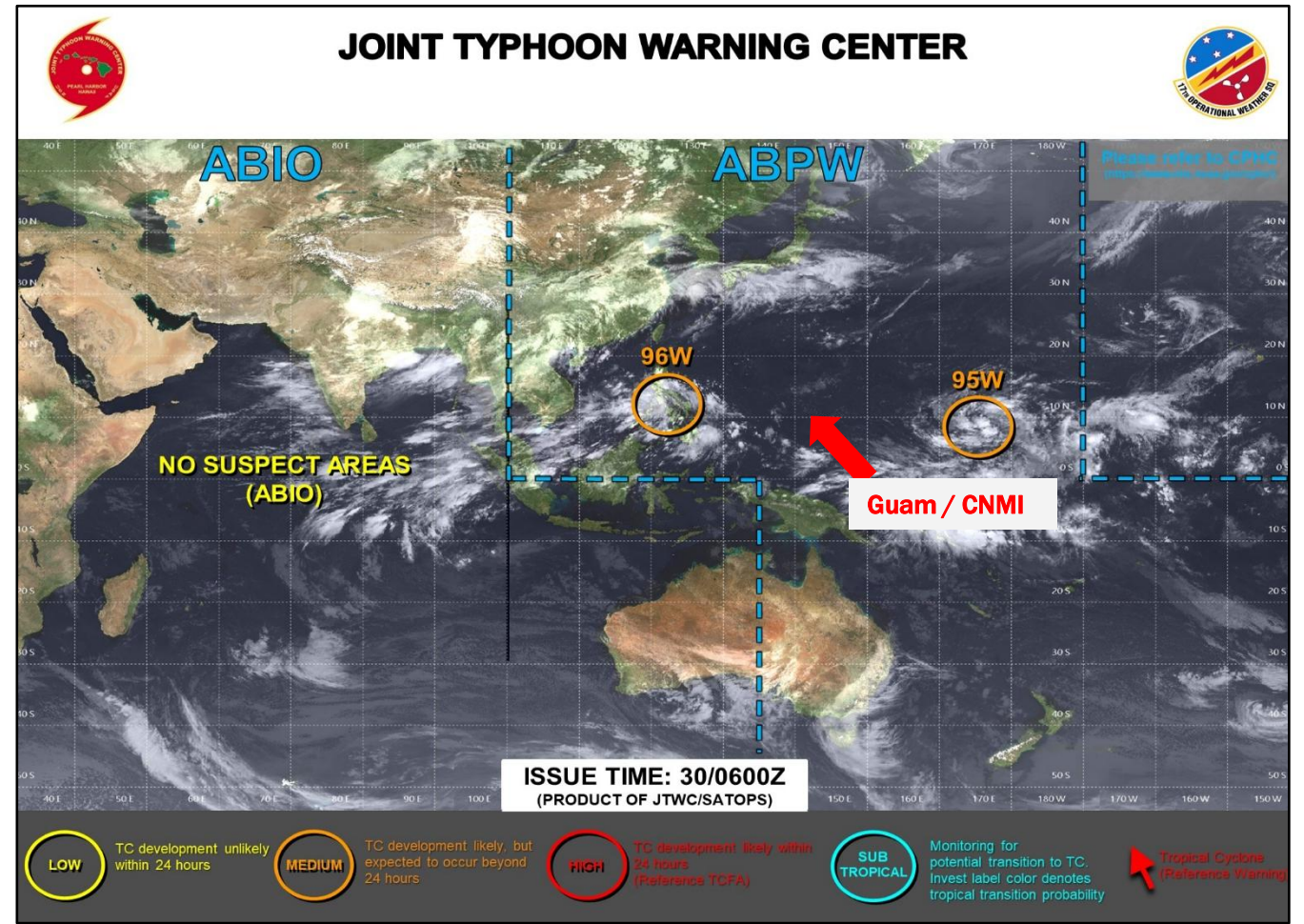


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Invest 95W – Western Pacific

Situation: (JTWC, as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- Approximately 1,410 miles ESE of CNMI
- Moving W toward CNMI
- Maximum sustained winds 23-29 mph
- Favorable environmental conditions for development
- Formation chance – 24-hour: Medium

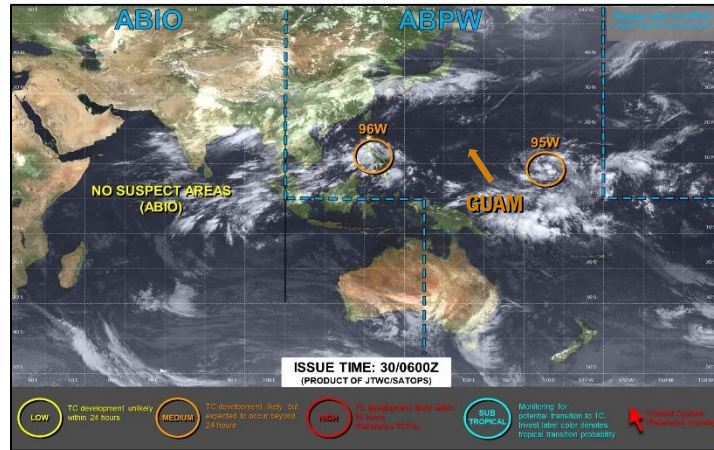

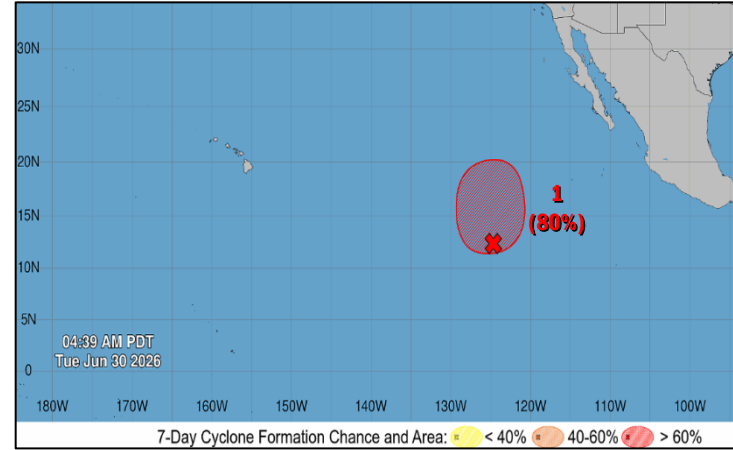

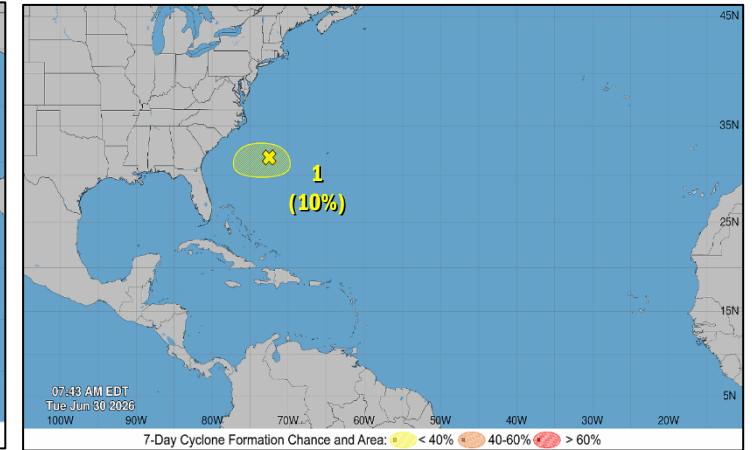
Eastern and Central Pacific



Disturbance 1 (EP95): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located well SW of the southern tip of the Baja California Peninsula
- Gradual development is **expected** during the next few days, and a tropical depression is likely to form during the **next couple of days**
- A tropical depression is likely to form tonight or tomorrow as the systems moves NW**
- Environmental conditions are forecast to become less conducive for development by late week
- Formation chance – 48-hour: **High (80%)**; 7-day: **High (80%)**

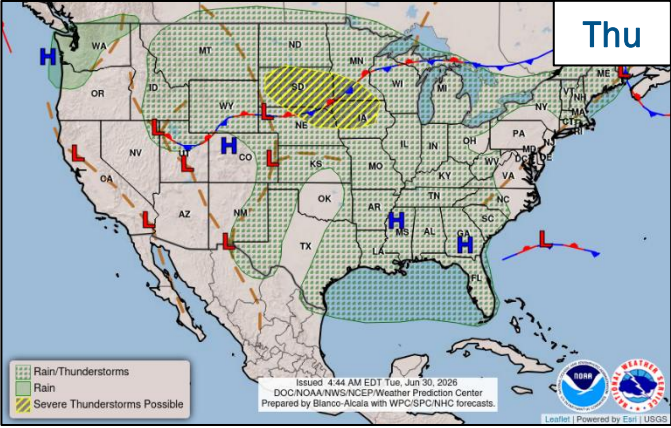
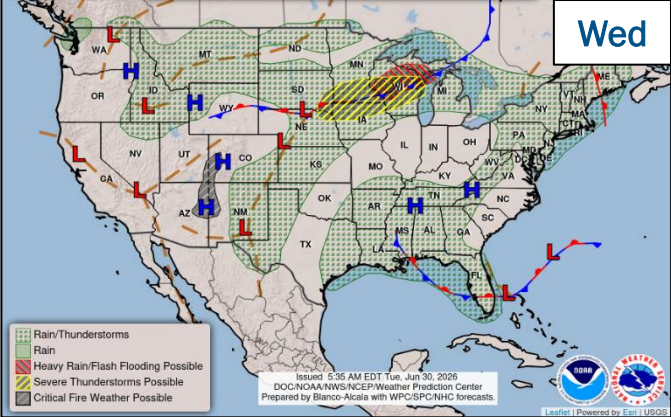
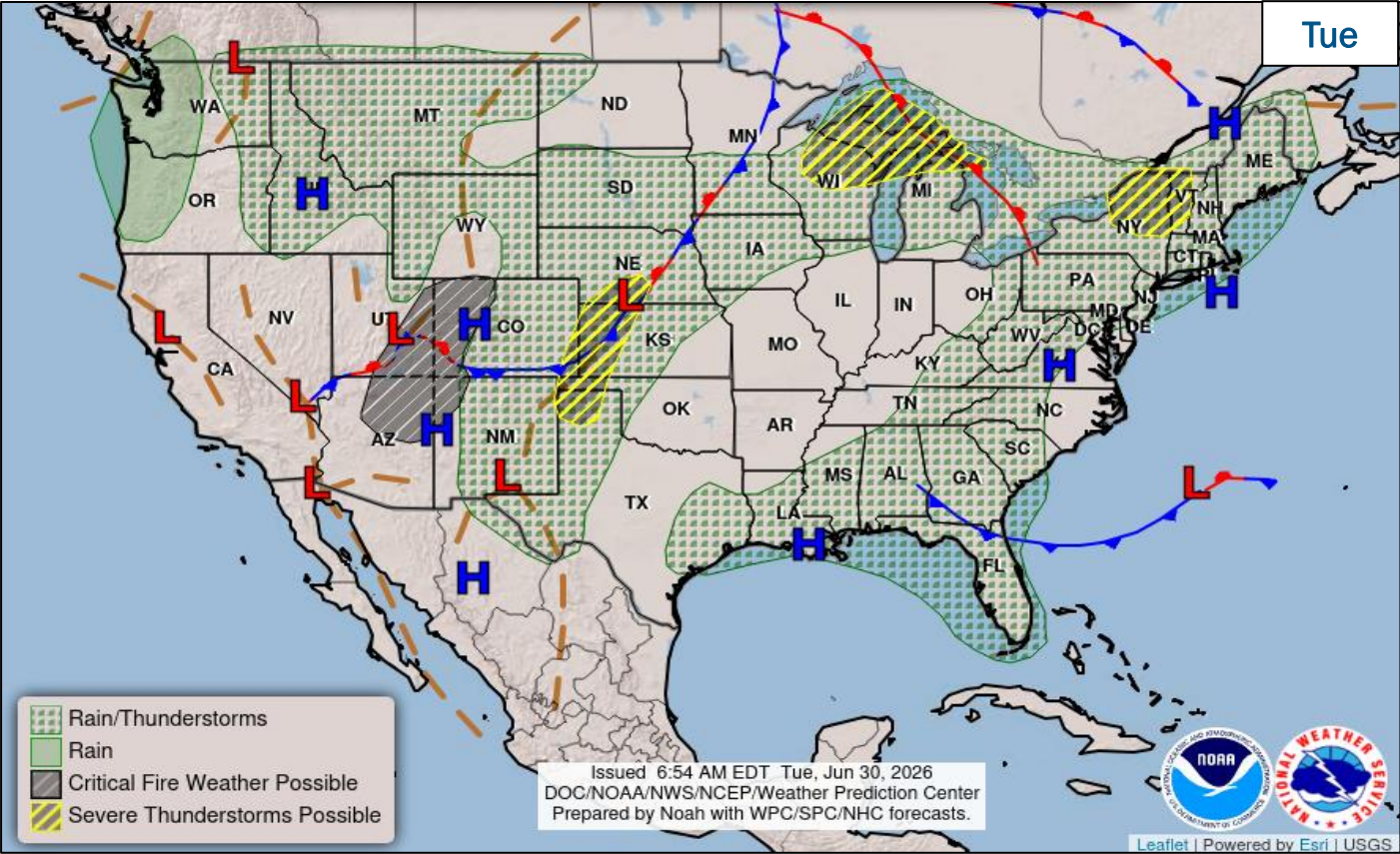
Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located offshore the Southeastern U.S. Coast
- Environmental conditions are becoming less conducive for significant development as it drifts south**
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)



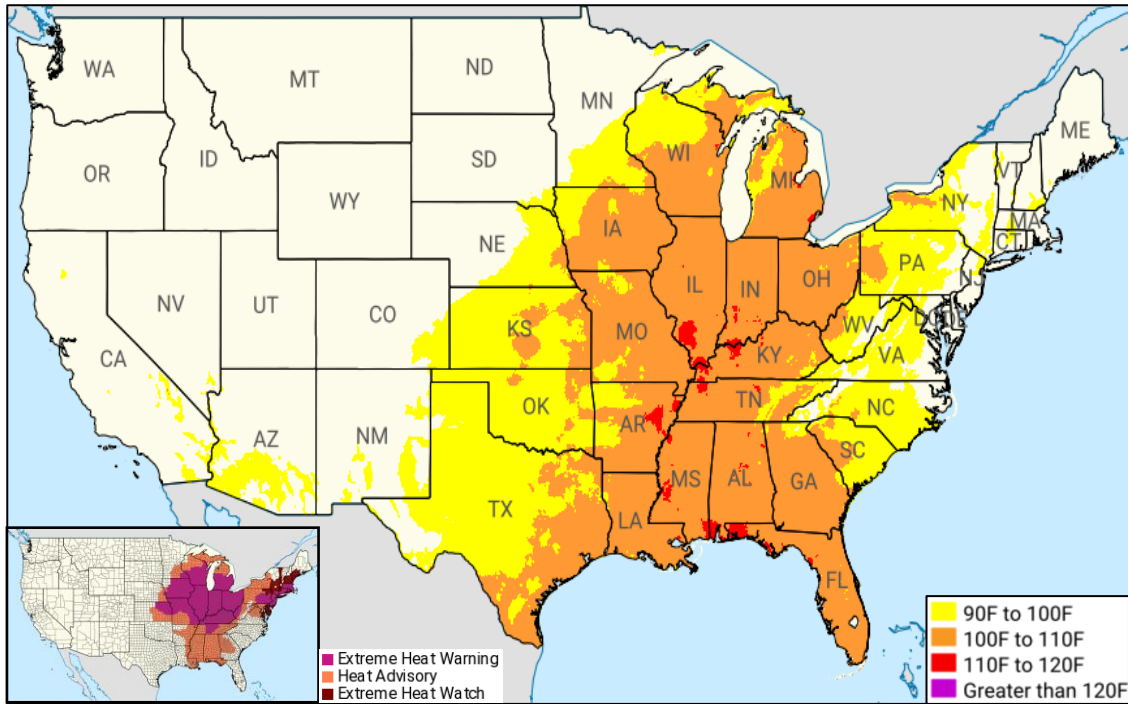

Situation: The Acting FEMA Region 8 Regional Administrator approved a Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) for the Aspen Acres Fire, which has burned approximately 22,826 acres with 0% containment near Custer County, CO (*pop. 6k*). Eleven towns have evacuated, affecting approximately 4,129 residents, with 1,200 total structures threatened, including primary residences. Two shelters are open. Local road closures are in effect. Aside from the FMAG approval, no additional federal assistance has been requested.

Response:

- FMAG approved Jun 29
- CO SEOC at Partial Activation (Wildfires)
- Denver MOC at Enhanced Watch (Fire Weather); RRCC is Rostered
- NWC at Enhanced Watch (FIFA World Cup / America 250)



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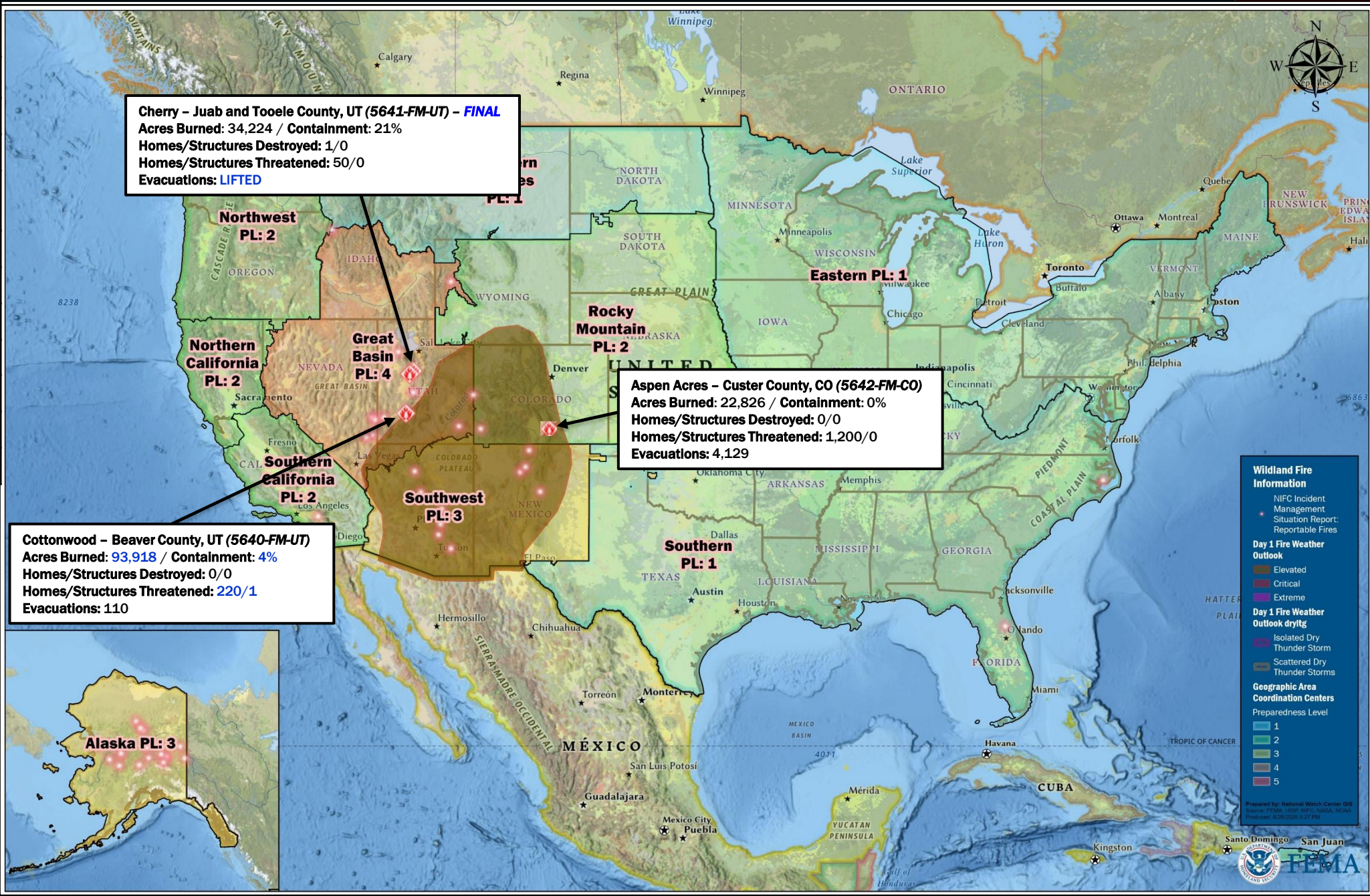
