


Tropical Outlook - Five Day

Tropical Storm Bonnie (Advisory #47 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,035 miles W of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving W at 20 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Expected to dissipate by Monday
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 60 miles


<u>Disturbance 1</u> (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles SW of the southwestern coast of Mexico
- Tropical depression is likely to form by tomorrow
- Formation chance 48-hours: High (70%) 5 day: High (90%)

<u>Disturbance 2</u> (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Expected to form early next week south of the coast of Central America
- Formation chance 48-hours: Low (near 0%) 5 day: Low (20%)








Severe Weather Outlook







Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Fire Weather Outlook


