National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorms possible Central/Southern High Plains
- Excessive Heat Warnings in effect Central CA to Southeast
- Red Flag Warnings Idaho, northern California, Nevada, Arizona, Colorado, Wyoming, and Utah
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Cristina
 - Disturbance 1 High (70%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Current Situation:

- Fire began July 11th; burning 24 miles east of the city of Chelan
- Burning private land
- Threatening infrastructure: Power/telephone lines, school, fire station, municipal airport, and ecological resources in and around the town of Mansfield (pop 330)
- Damaged/destroyed infrastructure: Power/telephone lines

Response:

- FMAG approved July 12
- WA EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- NWC & Region X / Bothell MOC continue to monitor

Eastern Pacific

Tropical Storm Cristina (Advisory #23 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 870 miles W of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving W at 13 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 70 miles
- Forecast to weaken during the next 48 hours; likely to degenerate into a remnant low Monday

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- South of Lazaro Cardenas, Mexico
- Conditions likely to become favorable a tropical depression could form during the next couple of days
- Formation chance through 48 hrs.: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

COVID-19 Update



Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 14 states, including TX with, 21 states in a plateau status, including NC, TX and FL. 31,403 Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,292 FEMA employees deployed.

Nationwide Testing: 40,045,940 cumulative as of July 10.

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 Response Update as of July 11)




- NRCC at Level I


National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Fire Weather Outlook











