## **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Severe thunderstorms possible – Central/Southern Plains; Middle/Upper Mississippi Valley
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – Middle/Upper Mississippi Valley; Northeast
- COVID-19

## **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Tropical Depression Six-E
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests



## **Tropical Depression Six-E** (Advisory #3 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 515 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving W at 16 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 30 mph
- Forecast to decay into a post-tropical cyclone on Wednesday



## Current Situation:

- Fire began July 13, 2020 and is burning on federal, state and private land
- Threatening homes in and around town of Vejo and unincorporated Brookside, UT (pop 7,600), buildings, infrastructure, utilities and agricultural equipment
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 1,500
- 2 shelters open with 7 occupants *(ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 5:40 a.m. ET)*

## Response:

- FMAG approved July 13
- UT EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- NWC & Region VIII / Denver MOC continue to monitor

**Situation:** Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 28 (+14) states, with 1 (-20) state in a plateau status. 30,334 (-1,069) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,268 (-24) FEMA employees deployed.


Nationwide Testing: 40,787,857 (+741,917) cumulative as of July 13.

  - Worldwide: 561,617 (+5,285)









States with Currently Occupied Units




