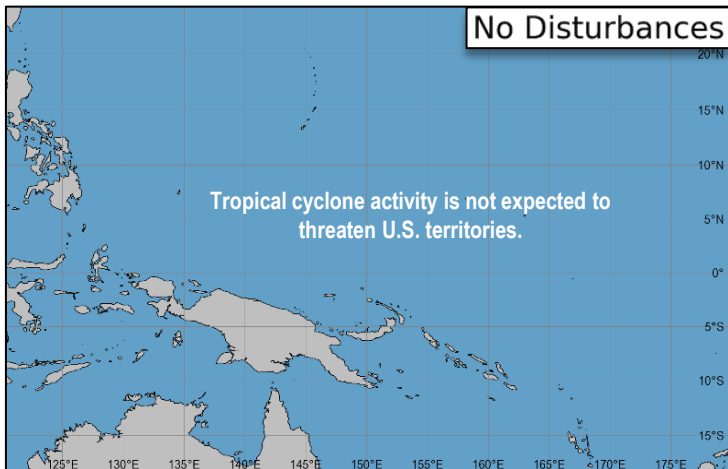

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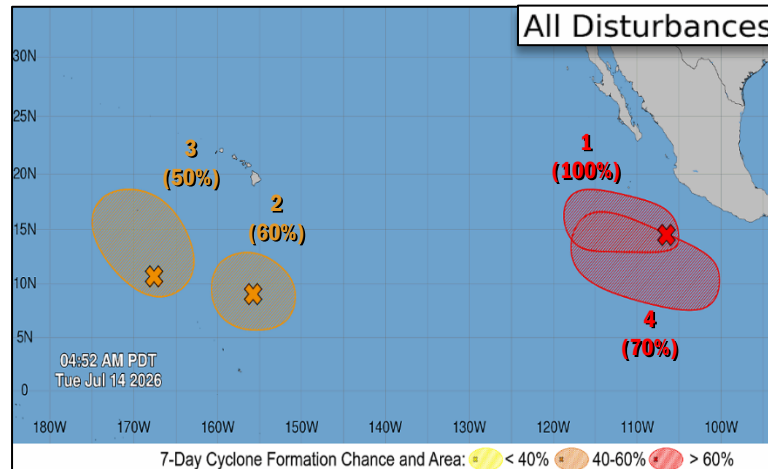
Tropical Outlook

Western Pacific



- Tropical cyclone activity is not expected to threaten U.S. territories

Eastern and Central Pacific



- Disturbance 1 (EP96):** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)
 - Located a few hundred miles SSW of the coast of southwestern Mexico
 - Moving WNW; Conditions favorable for gradual development; tropical depression or storm is expected to form today or tonight
 - Formation chance – 48-hour: High (90%); 7-day: High (100%)
- Disturbance 2 (CP91):** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)
 - Located several hundred miles S of the Hawaiian Islands
 - Minimal movement; tropical depression could form over the next day or two
 - Formation chance – 48-hour: Medium (60%); 7-day: Medium (60%)
- Disturbance 3 (CP90):** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)
 - Located several hundred miles SW of the Hawaiian Islands
 - Moving WNW; system could become a tropical depression later in the week
 - Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (30%); 7-day: Medium (50%)
- Disturbance 4:** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)
 - Located offshore of Southern and Southwestern Mexico
 - Moving WNW; tropical depression could form by the end of the weekend
 - Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: High (70%)

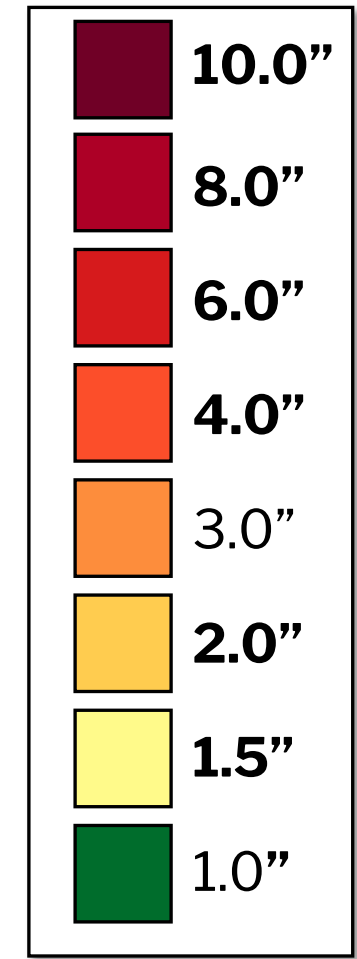

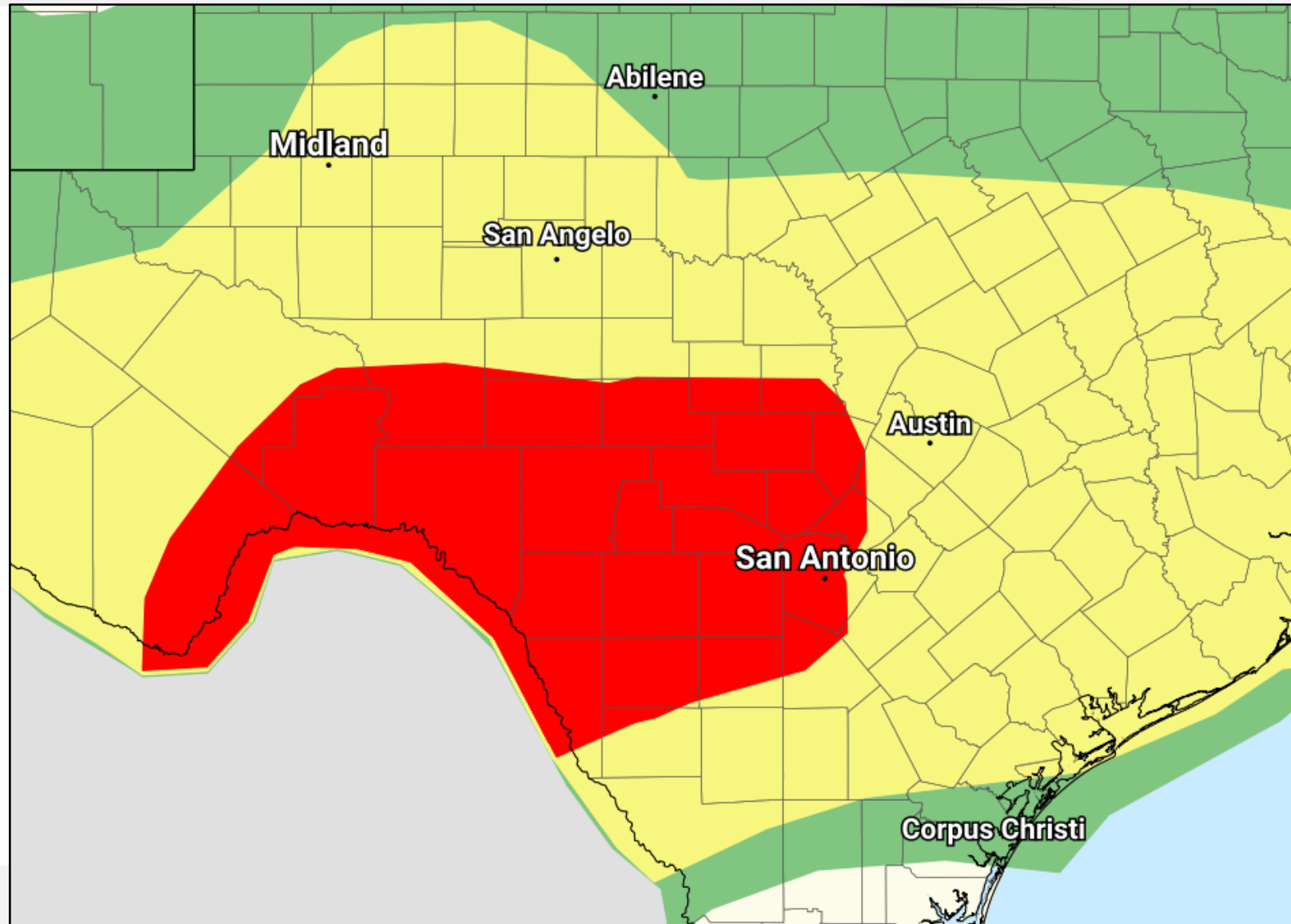
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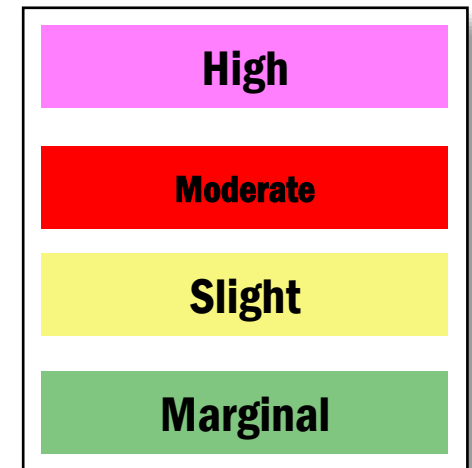
Estimated Rainfall Received OVER PREVIOUS 24 HOURS



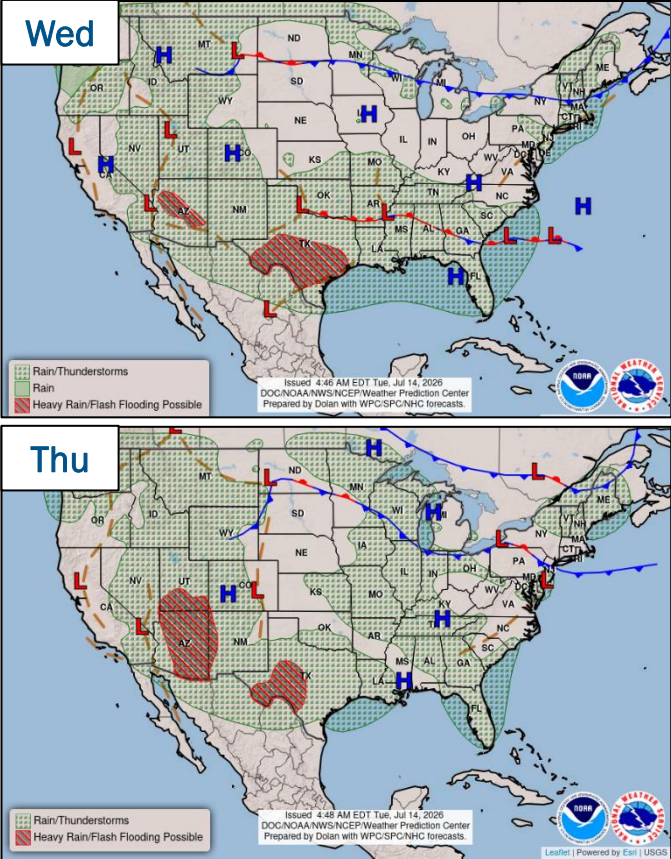
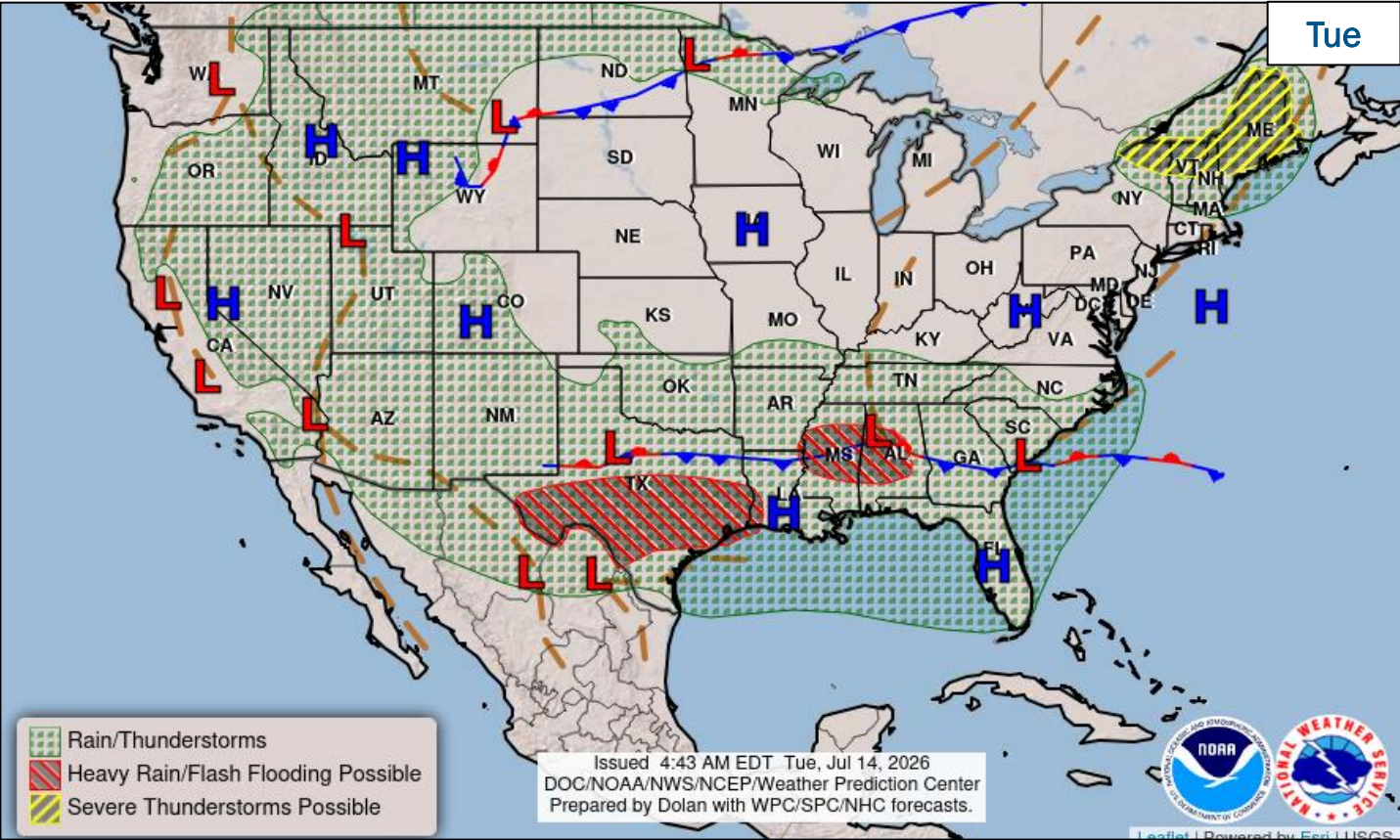
South-Central Texas Flash Flooding Risk THROUGH THURSDAY NIGHT



Risk of Flash Flooding

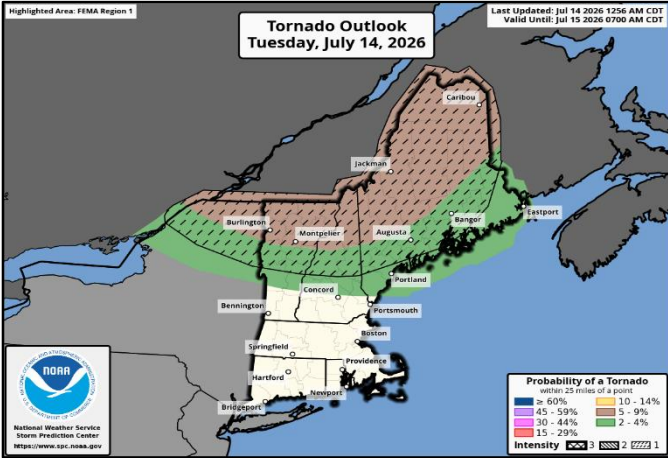
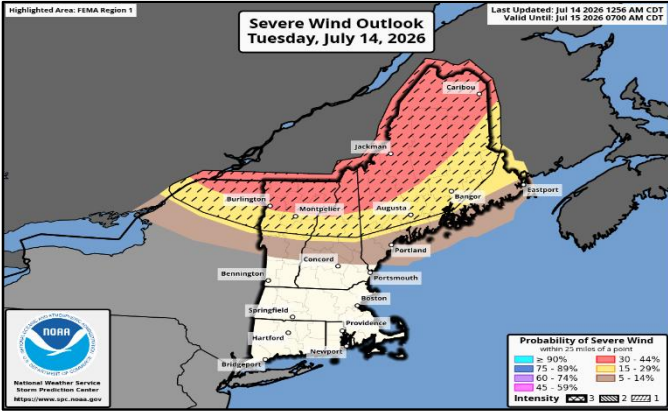
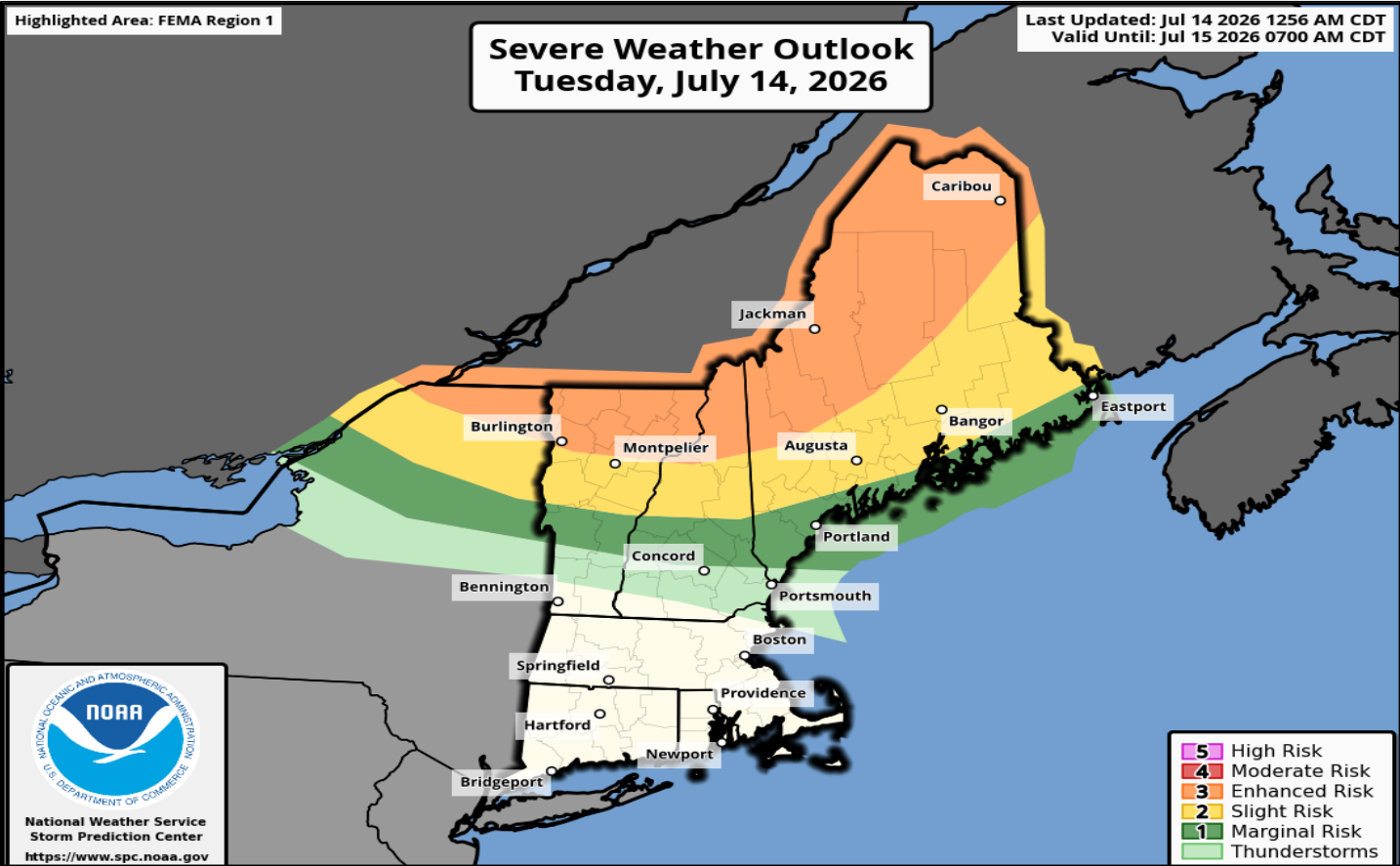
