


# **Tropical Outlook - Five Day**

### Central Pacific Eastern Pacific Atlantic





- Formation chance 48-hours: High (near 100%); 5 day: High (near 100%)




No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days


# **Hurricane Darby – Eastern Pacific**

#### Situation: (Advisory #24 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 690 miles E of Hilo, HI
- Maximum sustained winds 75 mph
- Moving W at 16 mph
- Steady weakening is expected during the next couple days;
   forecast to be a post-tropical remnant low by Saturday
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 60 miles
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 10 miles
