- Severe Weather possible Northern Plains, Upper Mississippi Valley, & Great Lakes
- Heavy Rain / Flash Flooding possible Upper/Middle Mississippi valleys & Great Lakes
- COVID-19


Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,000 miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California
- Development possible late this weekend or early next week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

COVID-19 Update

Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 27 (+7) states, with 15 (-3) states in a plateau status. 30,220 (+3) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,226 (+20) FEMA employees deployed.

Nationwide Testing: 46,551,605 (+1,121,781) cumulative as of July 17

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 Response Update as of July 17)

Deaths caused by COVID-19


United States: 137,864 (+926)

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring






National Weather Forecast









Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall








Hazards Outlook – Jul 20-24

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
