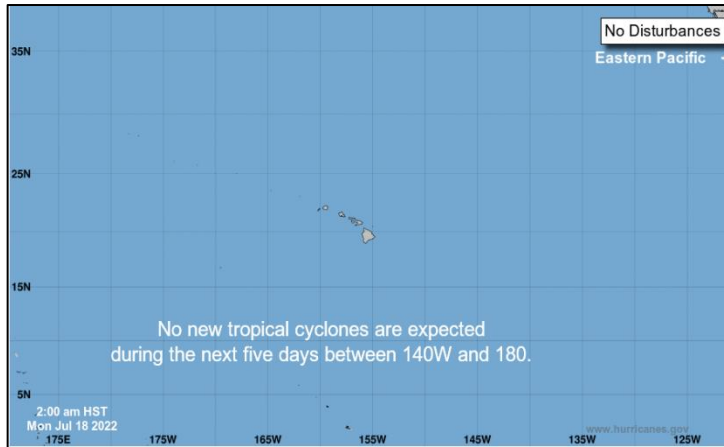

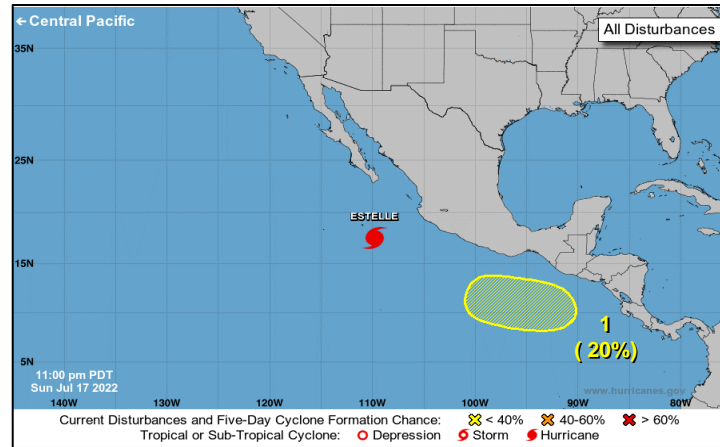
Tropical Outlook – Five Day

Central Pacific



- No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days

Eastern Pacific



Hurricane Estelle (CAT 1): (Advisory #12 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 335 miles SW of Cabo Corrientes, Mexico
- Moving NW at 13 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 80 mph
- Some slight strengthening is possible during the next day or so, but weakening is expected to begin around the middle of the week
- Hurricane force winds extend up to 25 miles
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend up to 105 miles

Disturbance 1 (As of 2:00 a.m. ET)

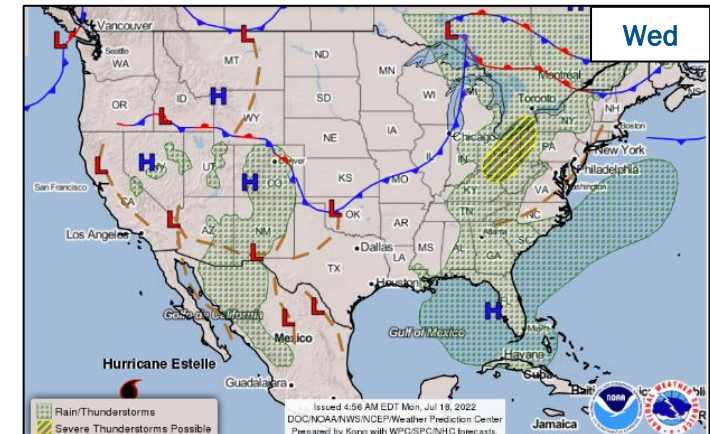
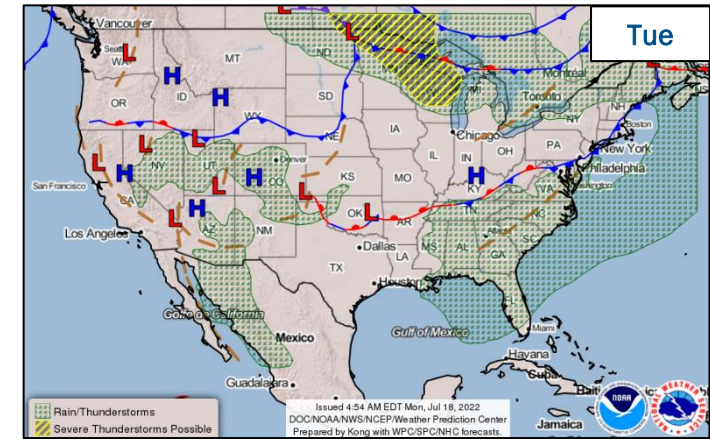
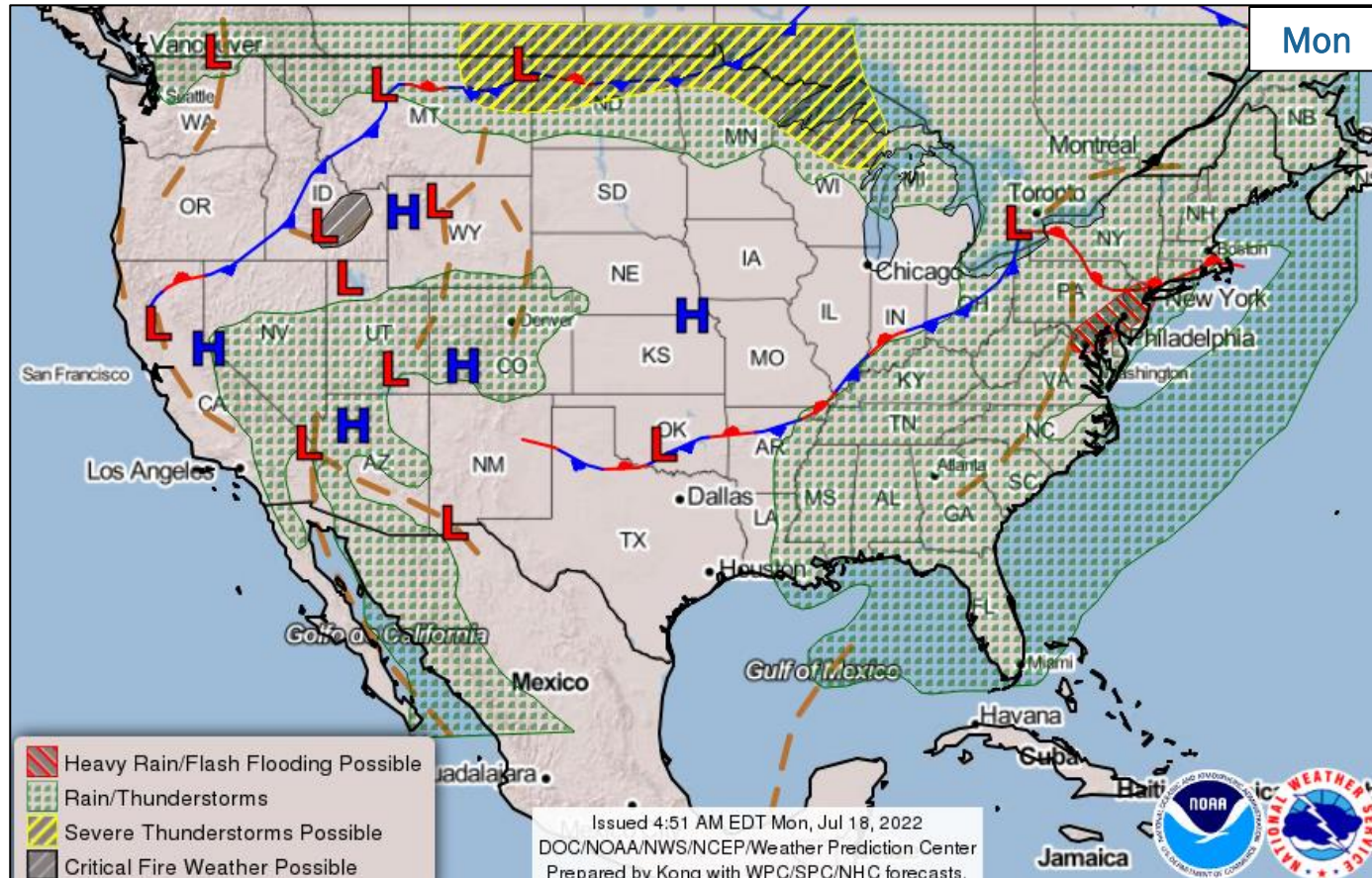
- Expected to form a few hundred miles off the coast of Central America and southern Mexico late this week
- Formation chance – 48-hours: Low (near 0%) 5 day: Low (20%)

- No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days

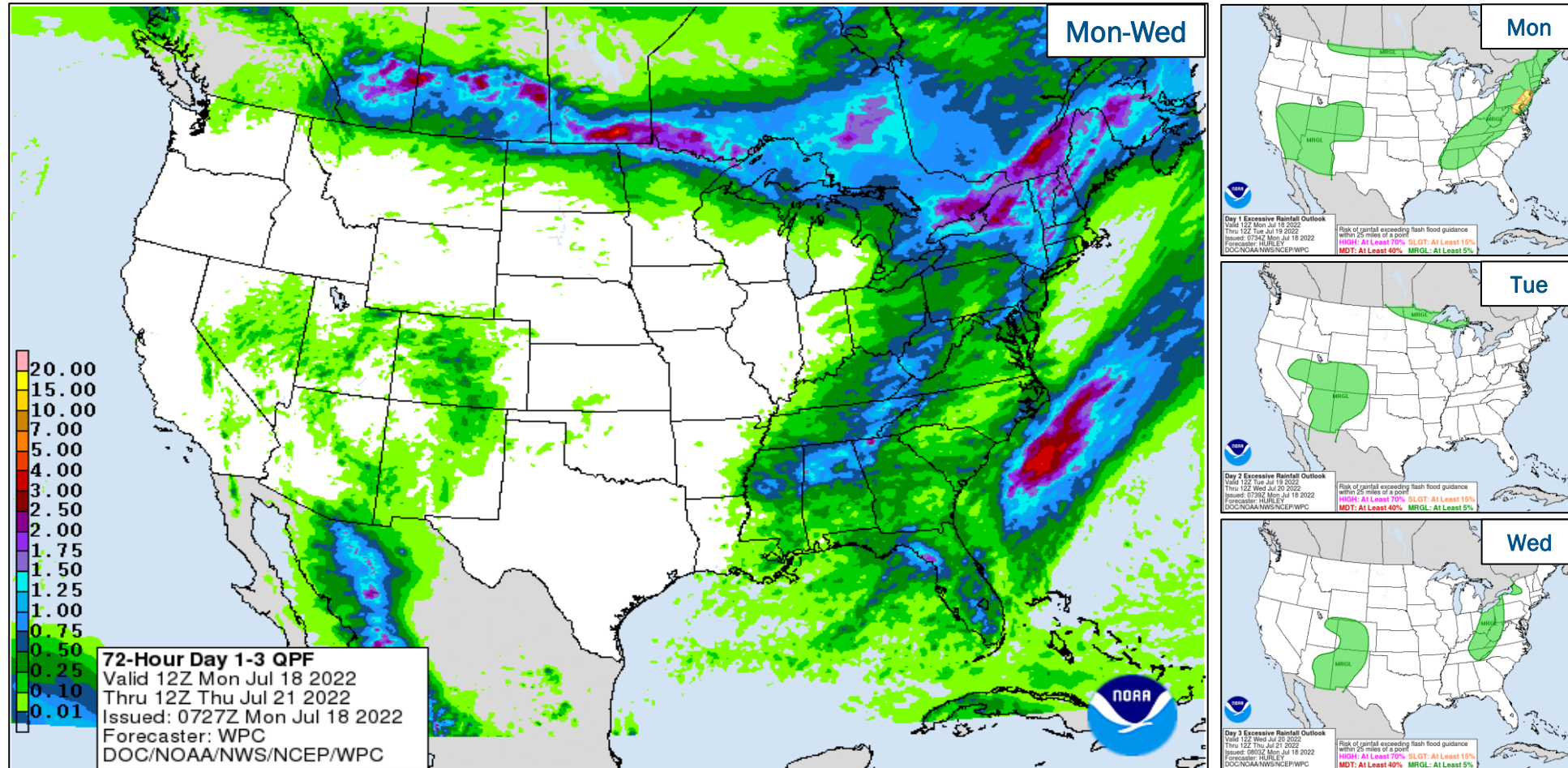

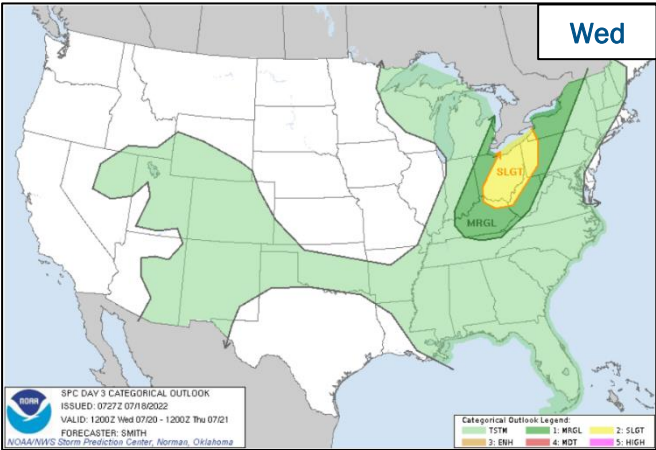
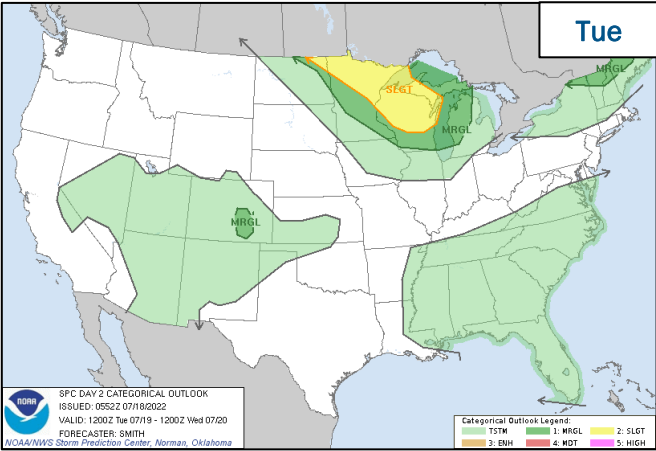
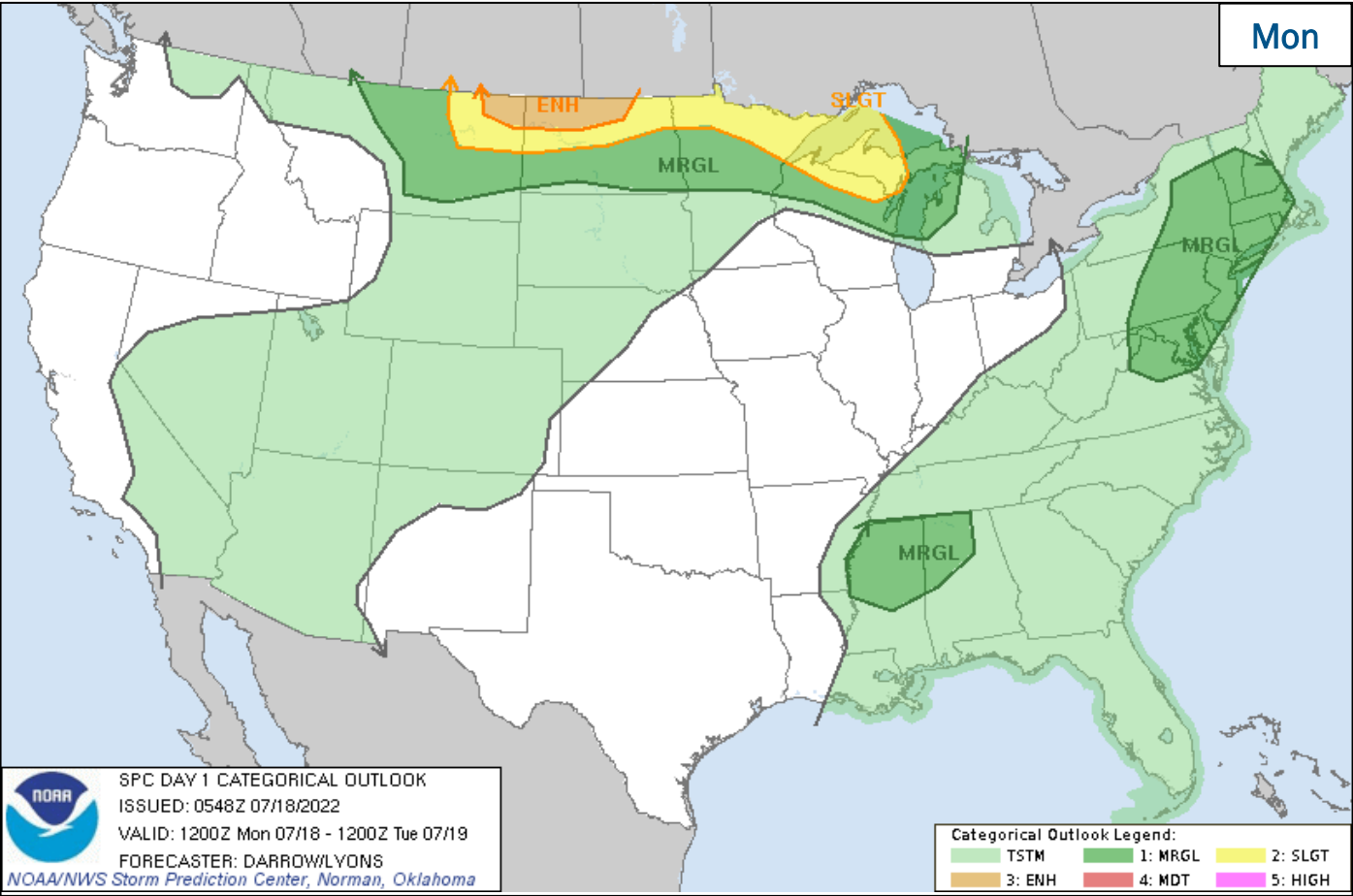
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

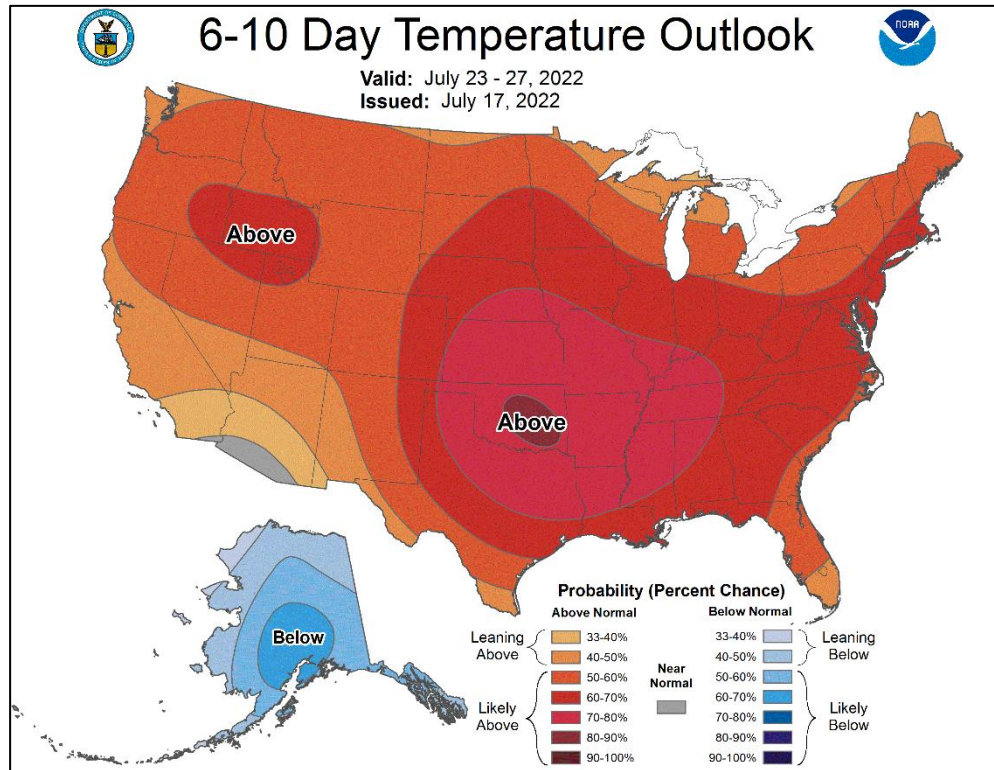

Severe Weather Outlook

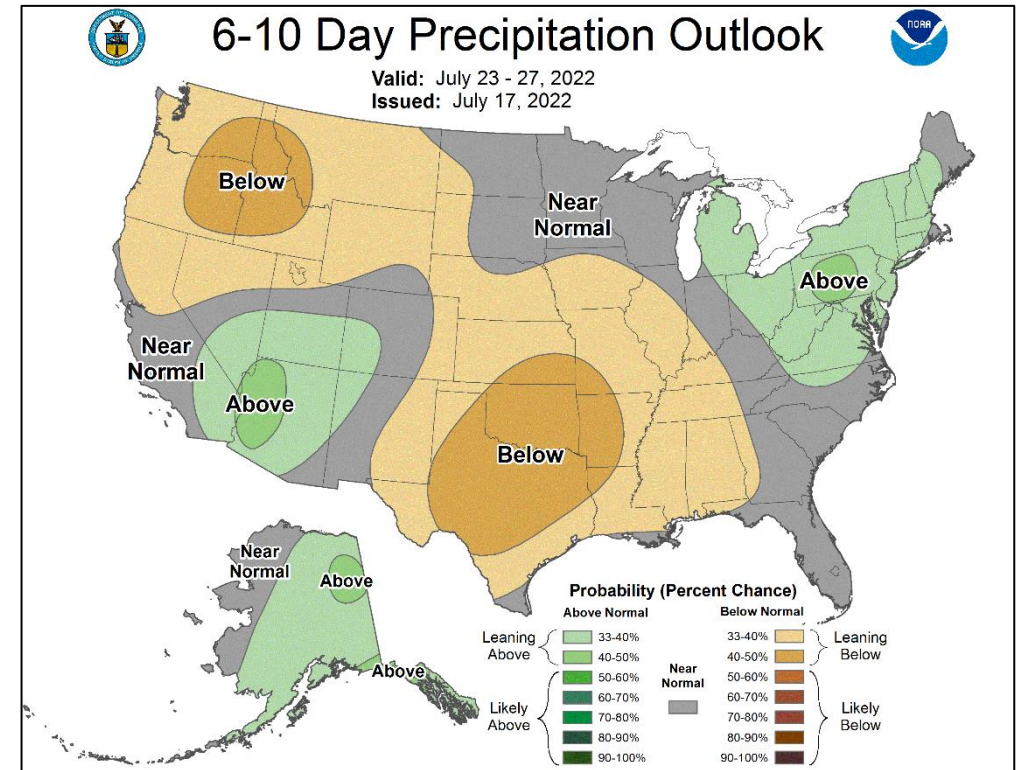

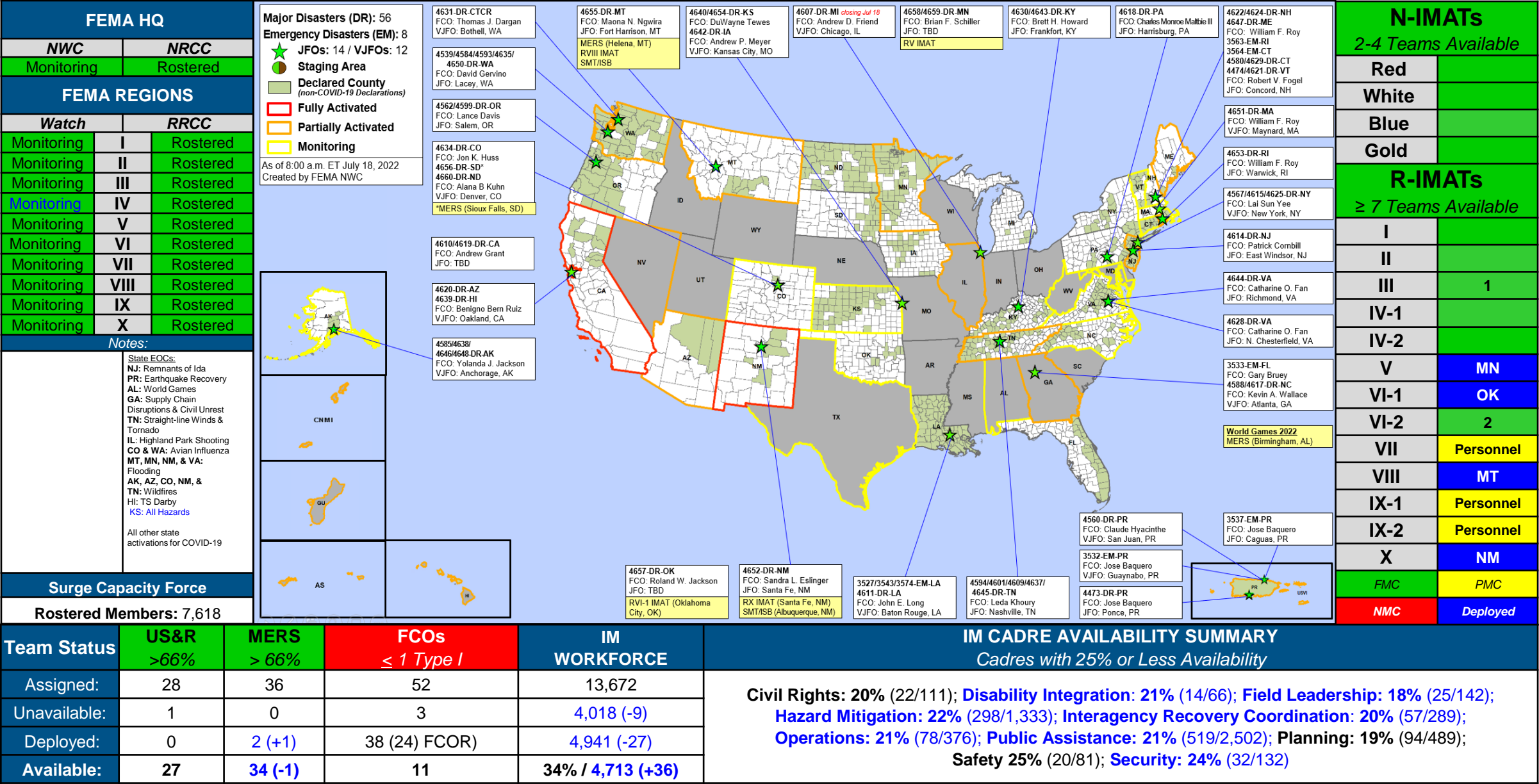
