## Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorms possible – Central/Northern Plains
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – Northern/Central Plains and Upper/Middle Mississippi Valleys
- COVID-19

## Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
  - Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
  - Disturbance 2: Low (20%)
  - Disturbance 3: Low (10%)
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Tropical Depression Seven-E
  - Disturbance 1: High (90%)
- Central Pacific: Disturbance 1 in Eastern Pacific moving towards Central Pacific
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

# Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



## **Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

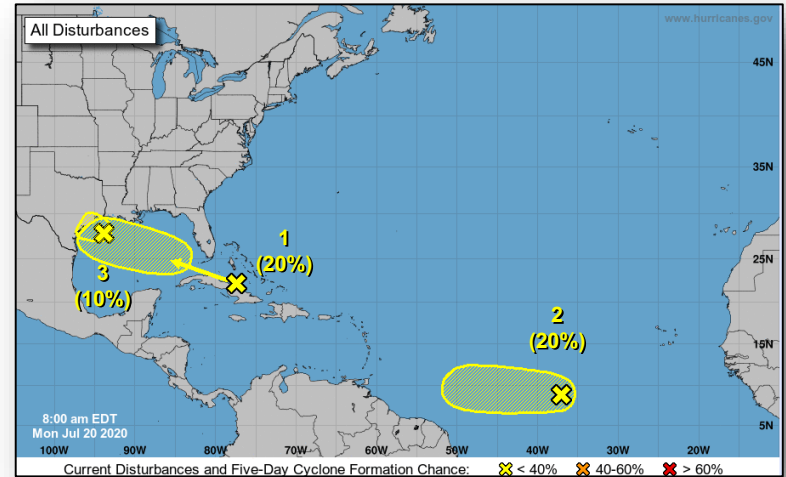
- Located over the Bahamas, central and eastern Cuba, and adjacent Atlantic waters
- Expected to move WNW through the Straits of Florida today, over the southeastern Gulf of Mexico by Tuesday, across the central Gulf on Wednesday, and reach the northwestern Gulf on Thursday
- Could become a little more conducive for development once it reaches the Gulf of Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

## **Disturbance 2** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,000 miles WSW of Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving W at 10-15 mph
- Expected to be marginally conducive for development during the next few days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

## **Disturbance 3** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over northwestern Gulf of Mexico
- Little additional development is expected before it moves inland over Texas tonight or Tuesday
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)

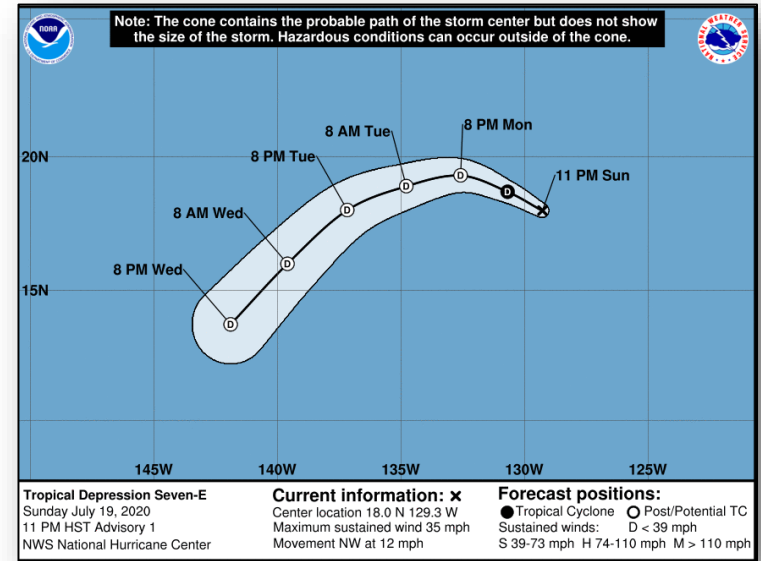


# Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



## **Tropical Depression Seven-E** (Advisory #1 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,300 miles WSW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Moving NW at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Little change in strength is forecast during the next 48 hours
- Expected to be a short-lived tropical cyclone that will degenerate into a remnant low by Tuesday morning

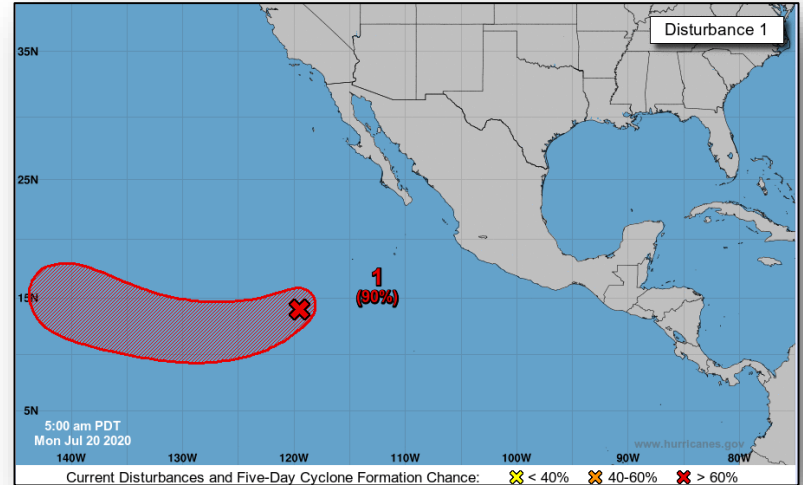


# Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



## **Disturbance 1** *(as of 8:00 a.m. ET)*

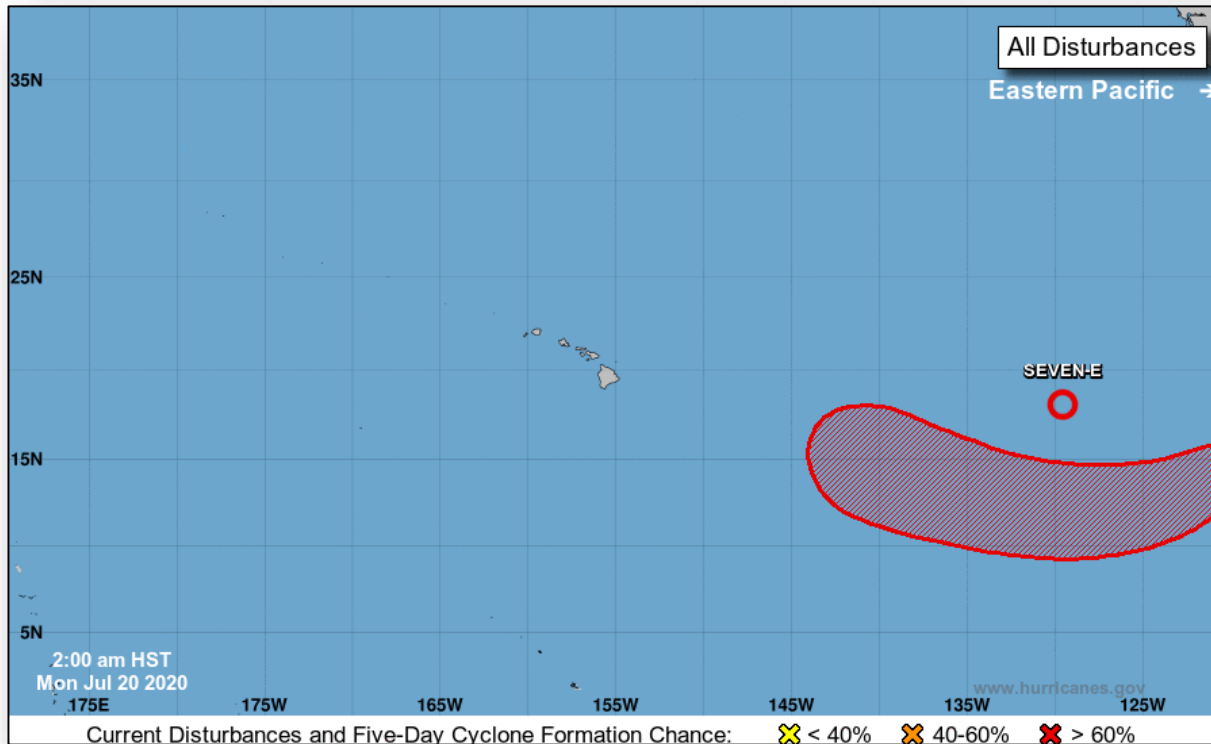
- 850 miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Moving WSW and then W at 10-15 mph
- Conditions are conducive for additional development
- Tropical depression or tropical storm is likely to form during the next day or two
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (70%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

**Situation:** Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 27 states, with 15 states in a plateau status. 30,220 Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,278 FEMA employees deployed.

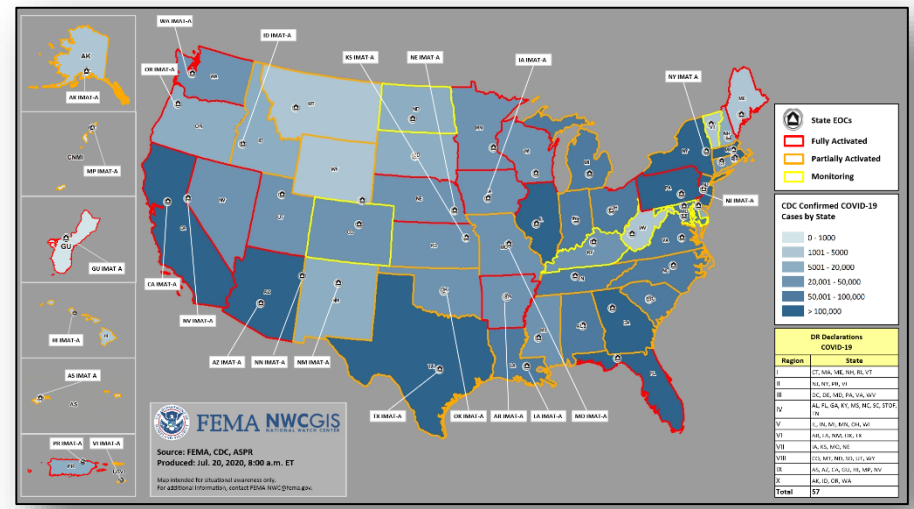
Nationwide Testing: 46,551,605 cumulative as of July 17

  - Worldwide: **593,087 (+7,360)**

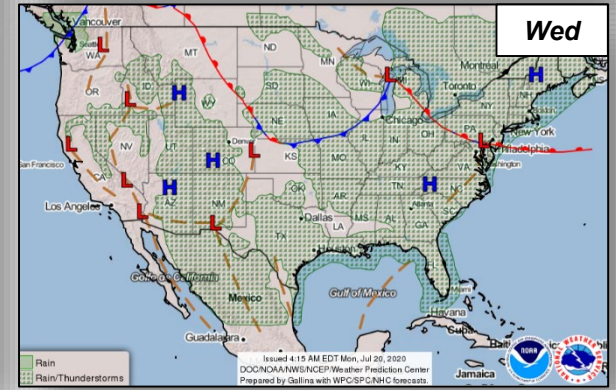
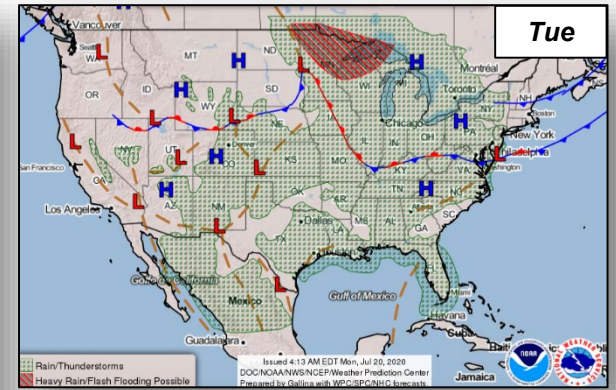
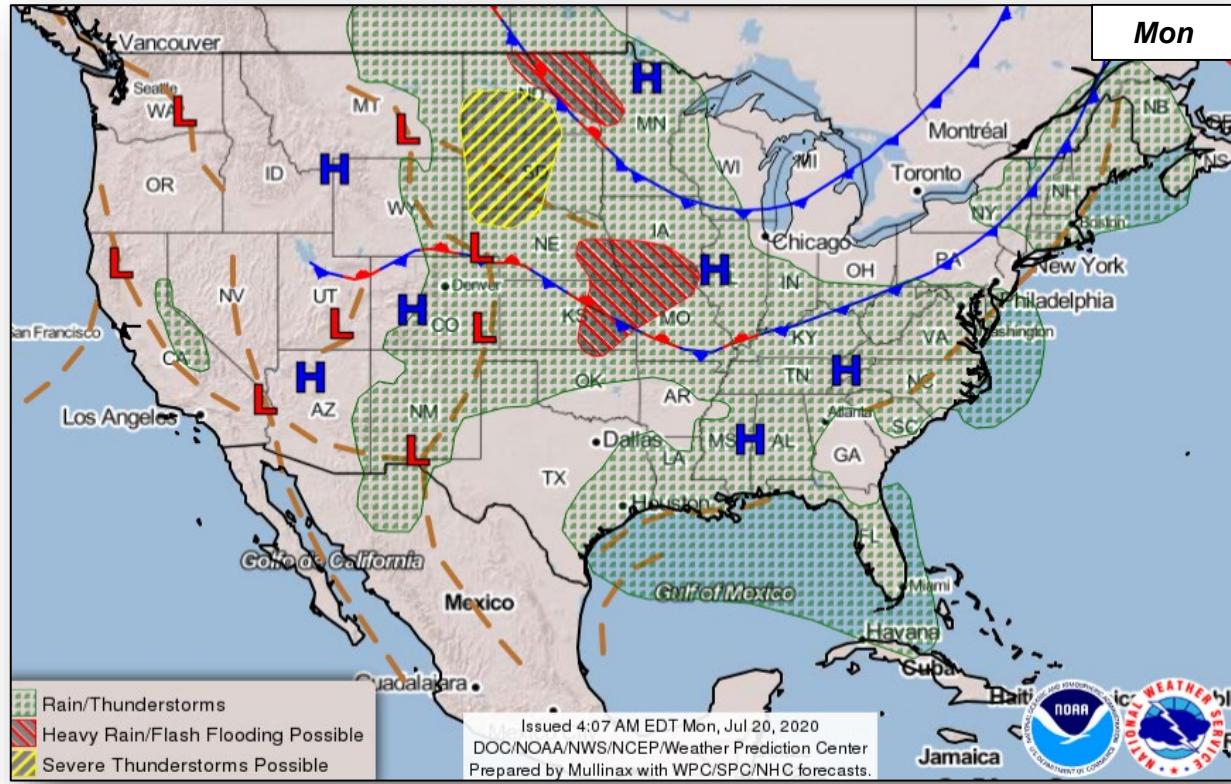
**Response:**

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring



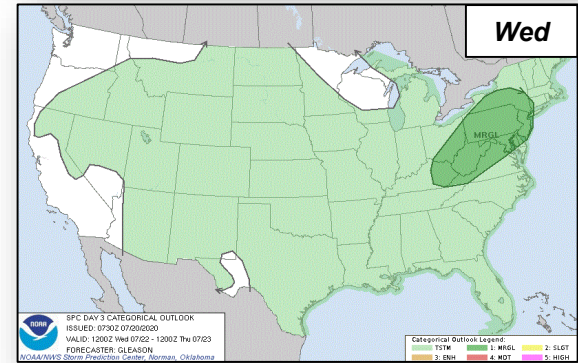
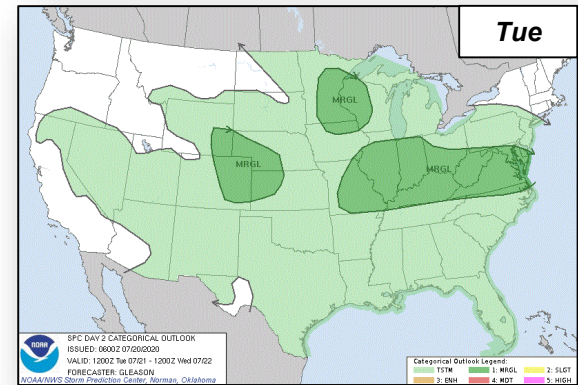
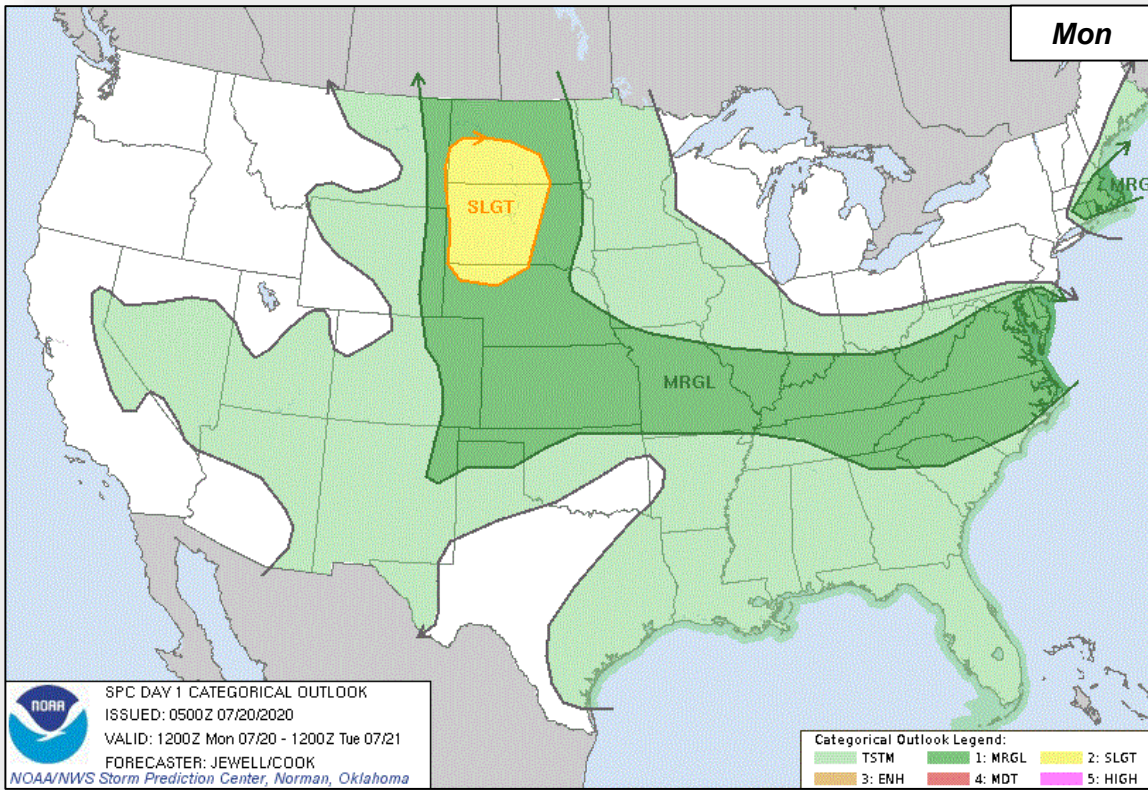

# National Weather Forecast





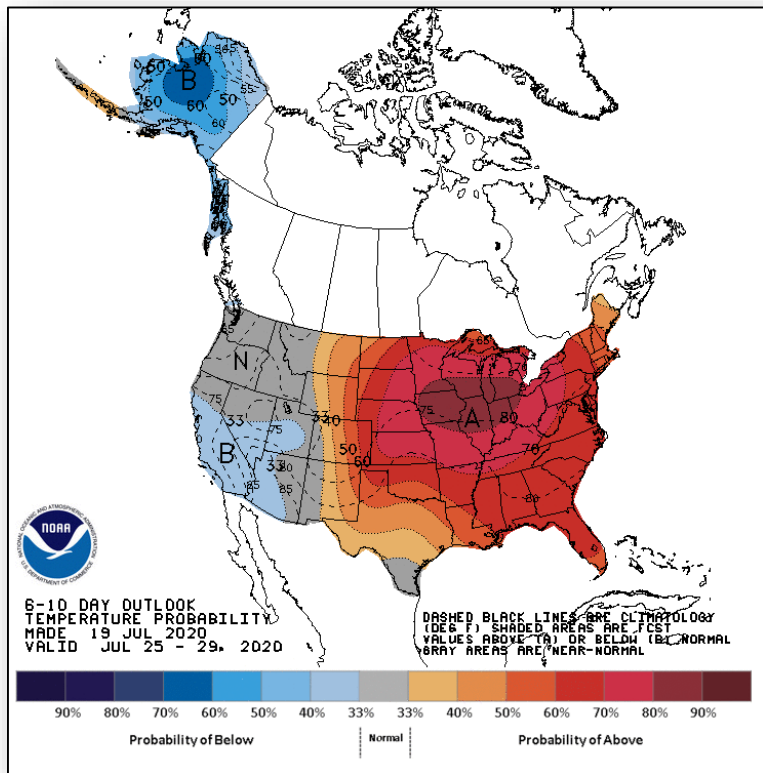

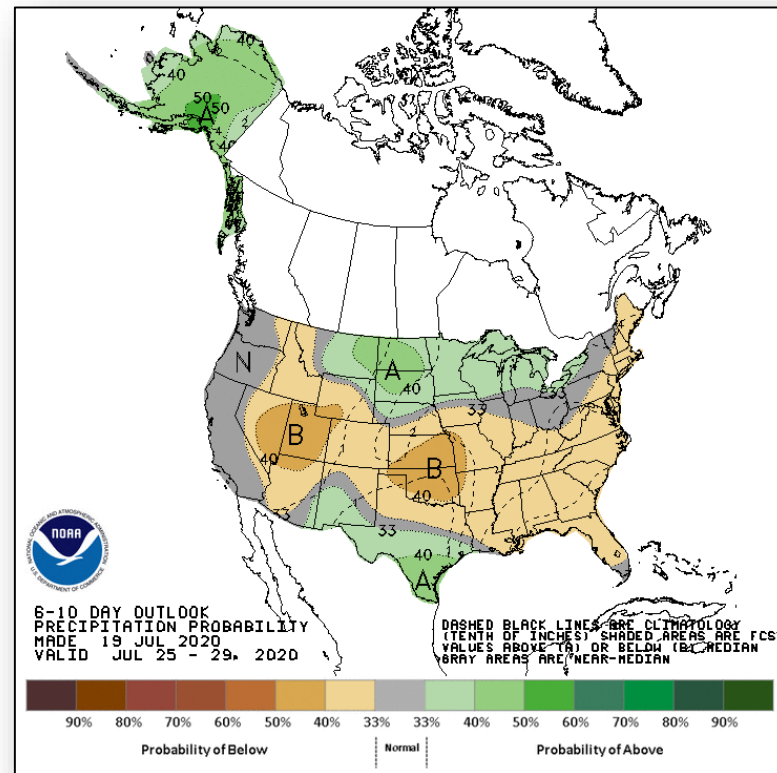
# Long Range Outlooks – July 25-29

**6-10 Day Precipitation Probability**

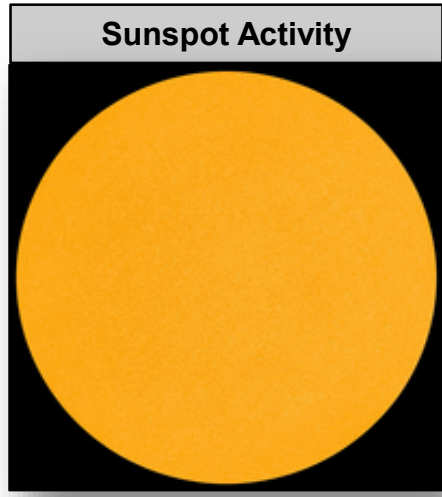
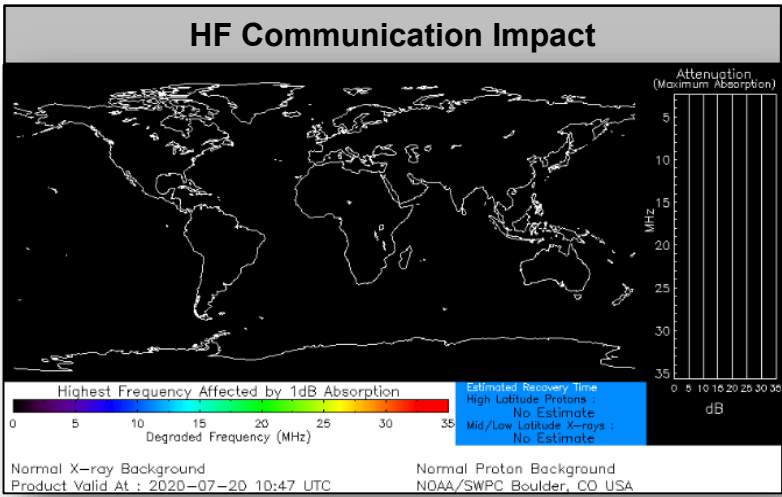

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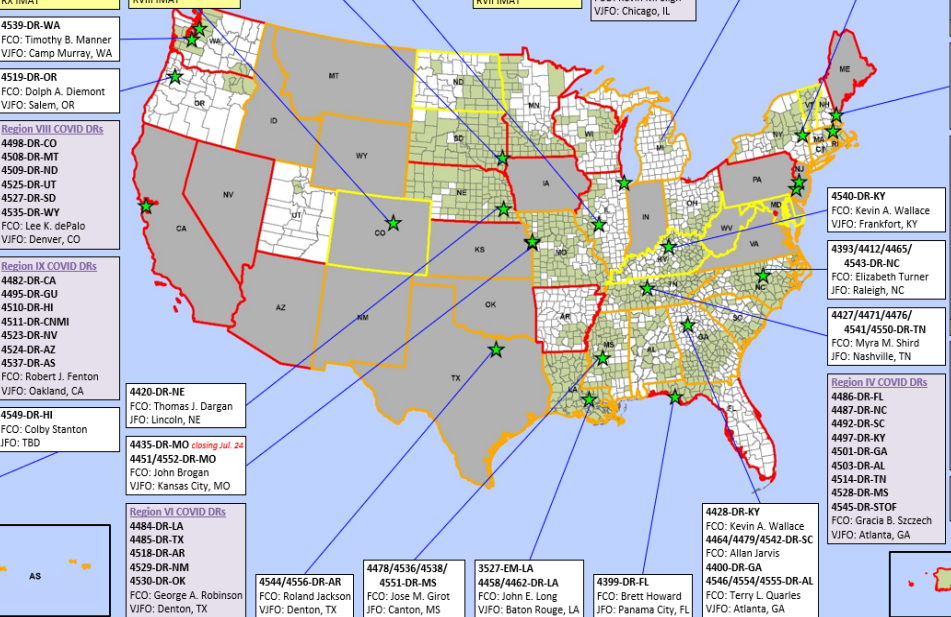
