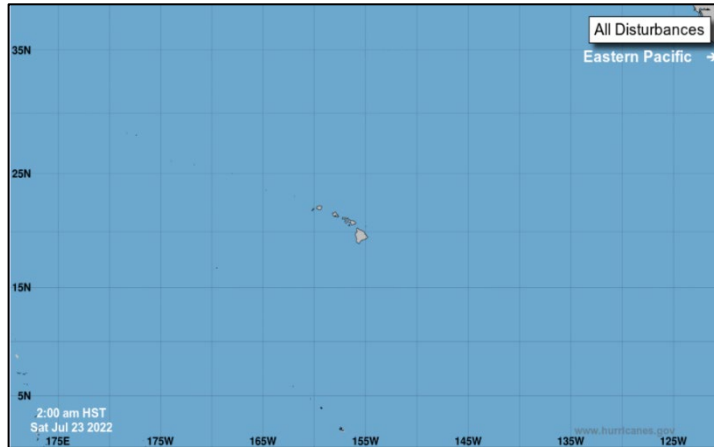

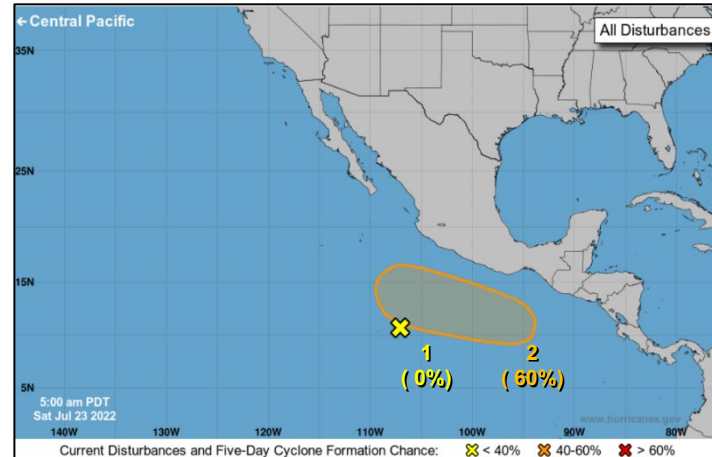
Tropical Outlook – Five Day

Eastern Pacific



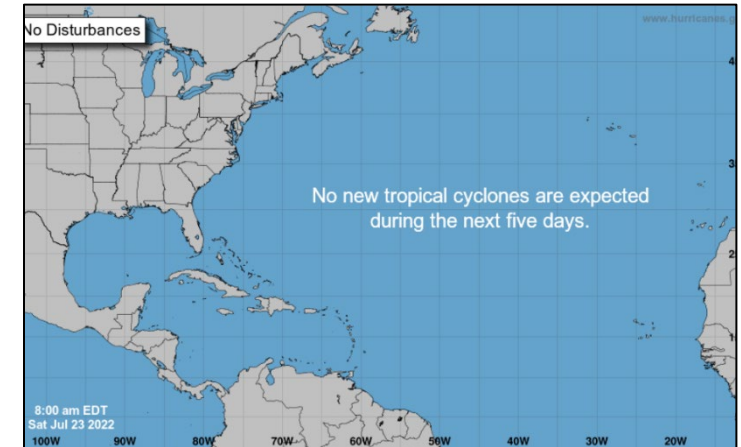
Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SSW of the coast of southwestern Mexico
- Development of this system is unlikely
- Formation chance – 48-hours: Low (near 0%) 5 day: Low (near 0%)

Disturbance 2 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Forecast to form during the next day or two a few hundred miles south of extreme southeastern Mexico
- Tropical depression could form by the middle of next week
- Formation chance: 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Medium (60%)

Atlantic



- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days

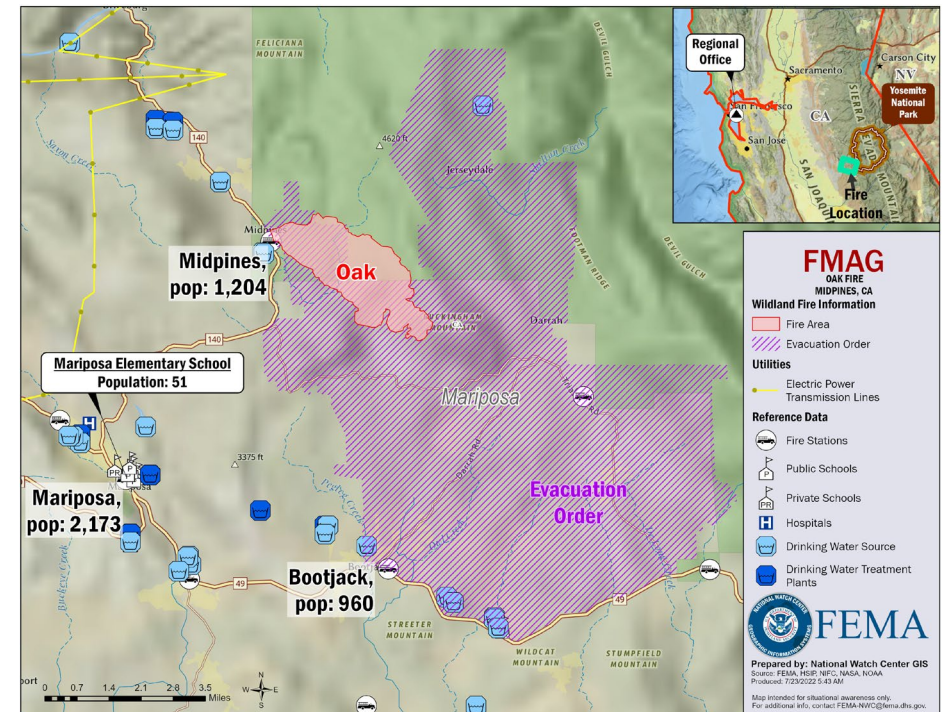

Current Situation:

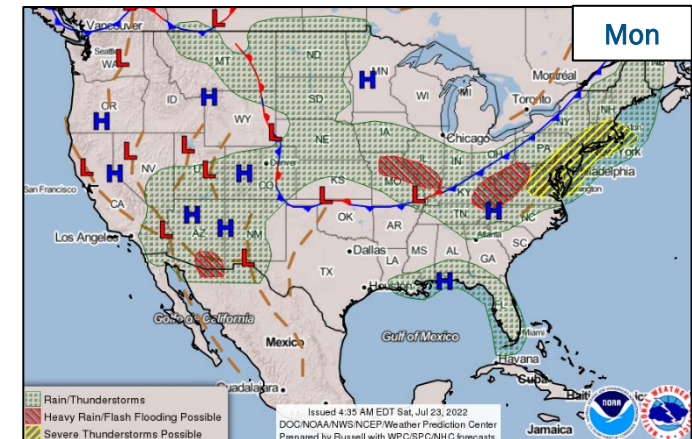
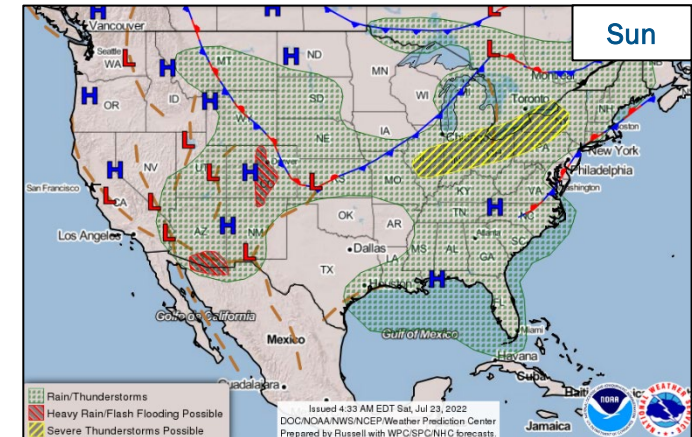
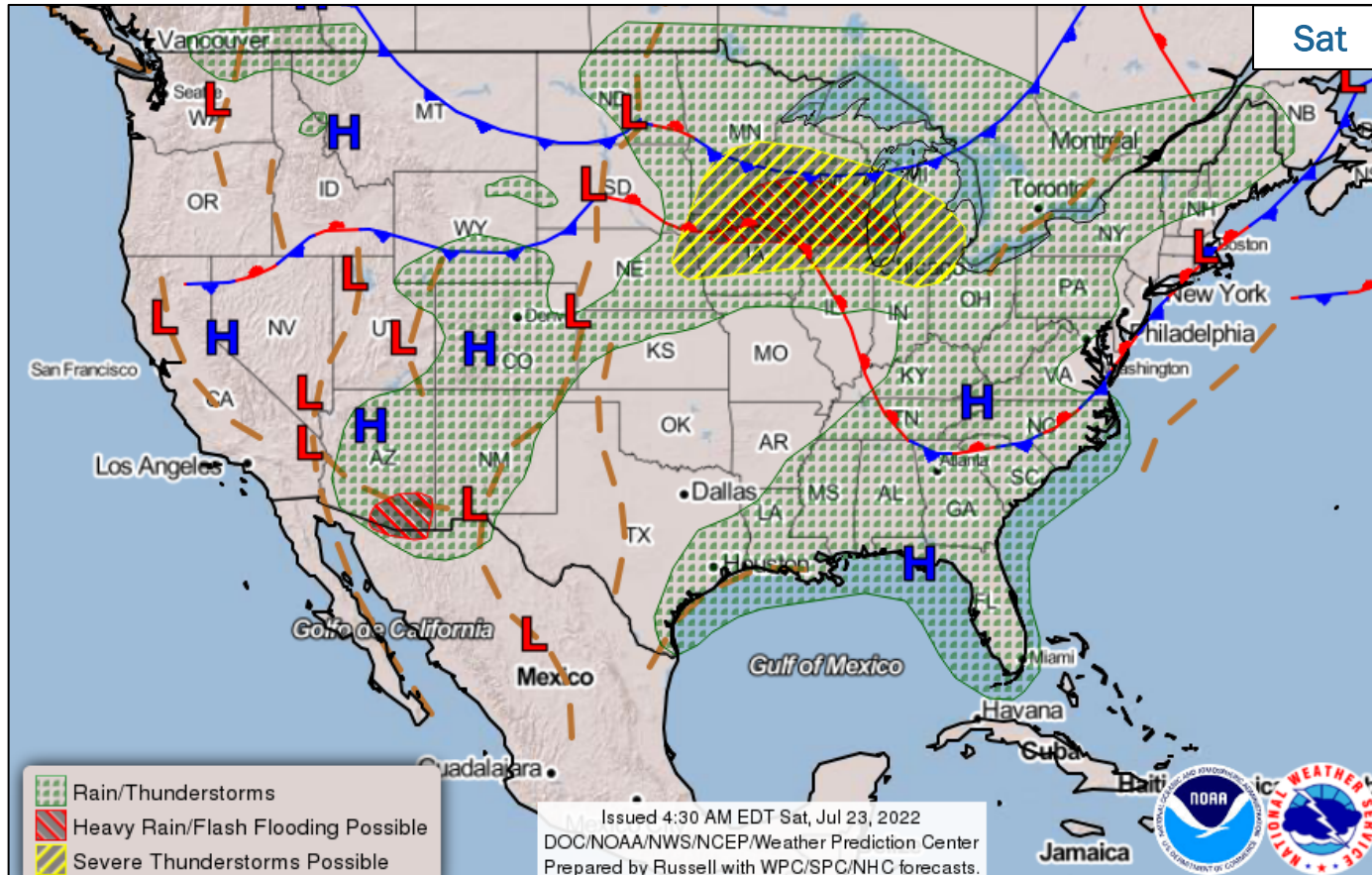
- The fire began July 22 and is burning on state and private land in and around Midpines, CA (combined population 45,039)
- 1,540 homes threatened; 98% are primary homes
- Also threatening community water infrastructure, power transmission and distribution lines, a cell tower, and a fire station
- Mandatory evacuations for 7.500 people
- 1 shelter open with 51 occupants (*ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 6:51 a.m. ET*)

Response:

- CA EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- Region IX TWC and the NWC continue to monitor
- FMAG approved July 23



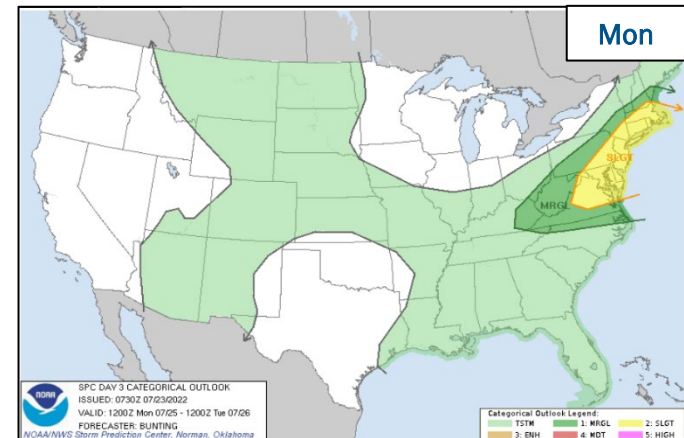
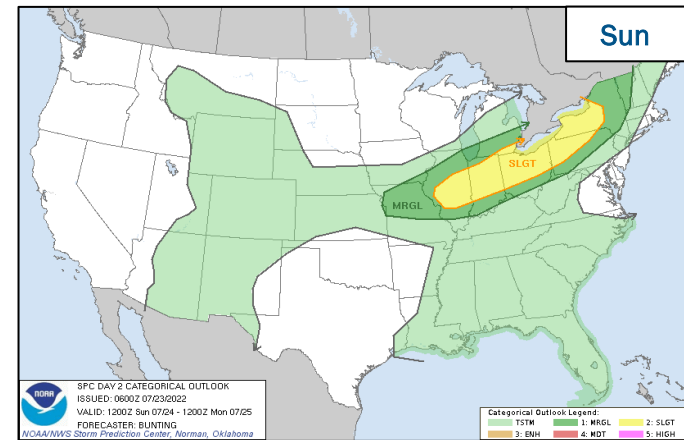
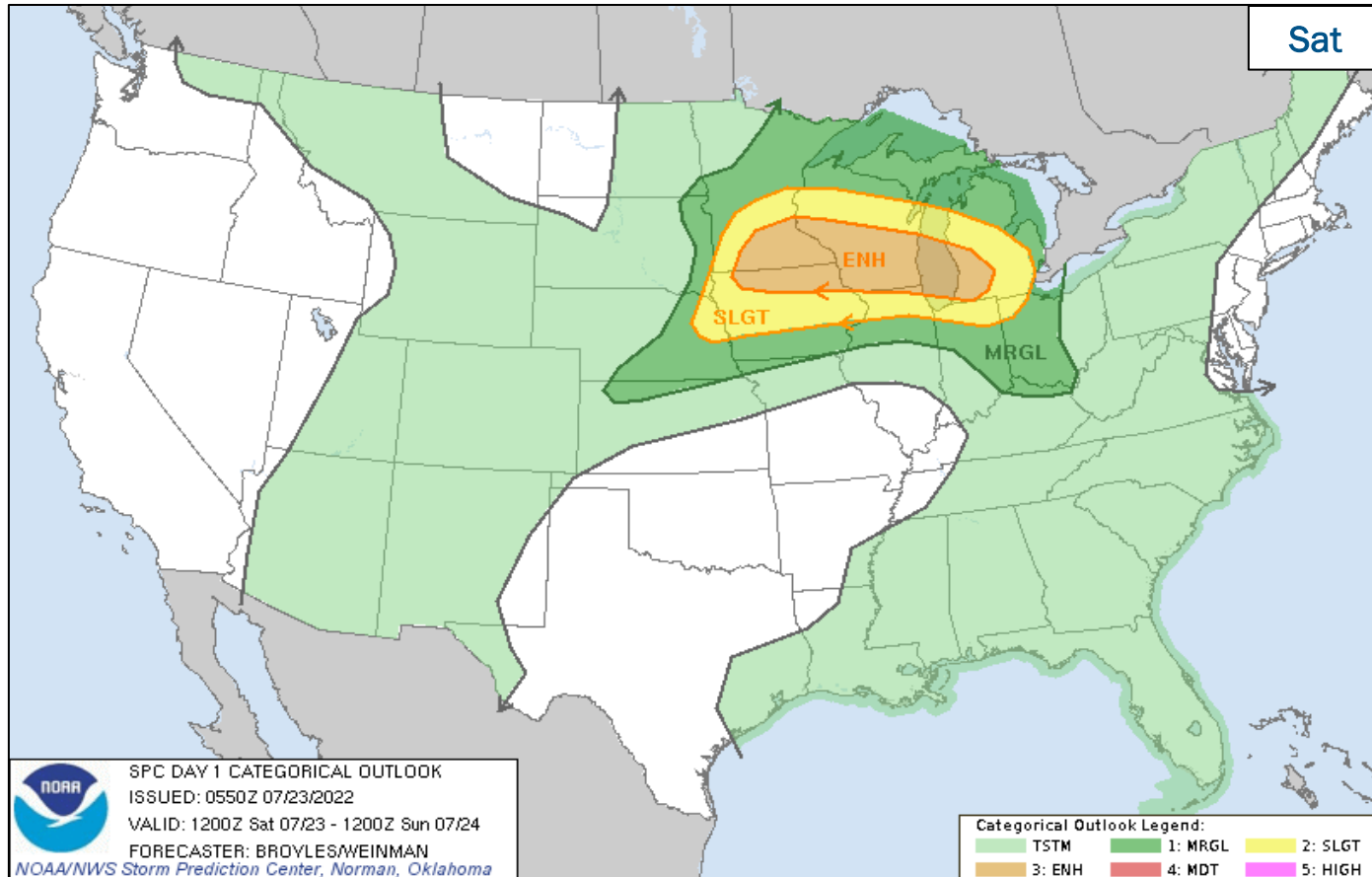

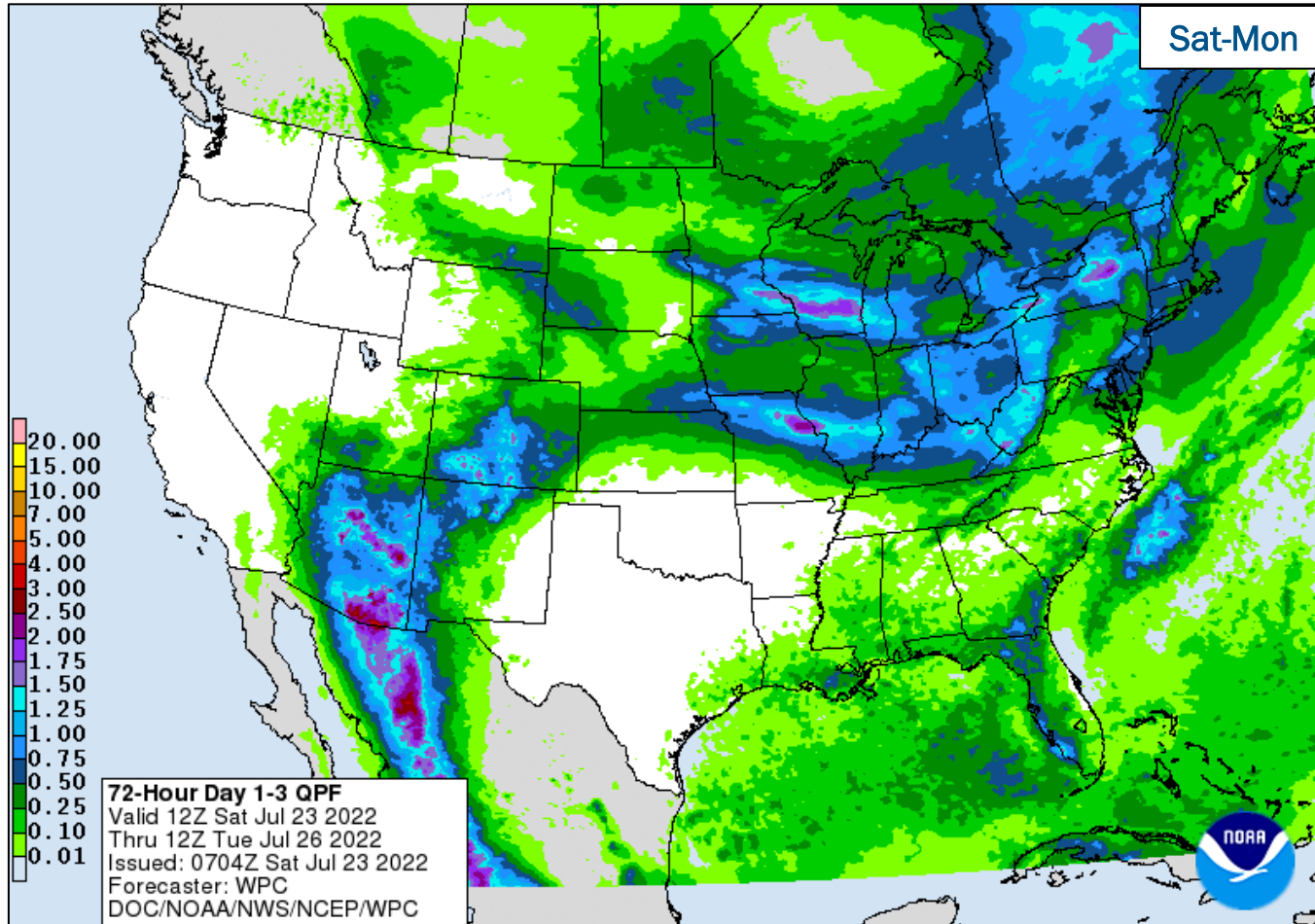
Severe Weather Outlook



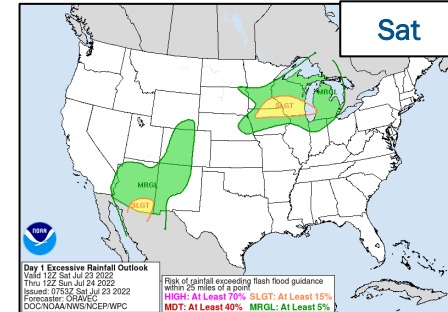

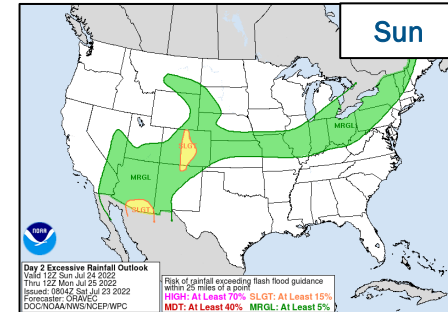
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



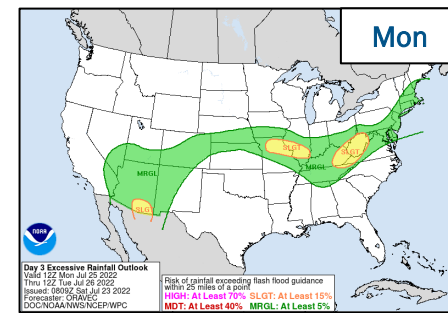

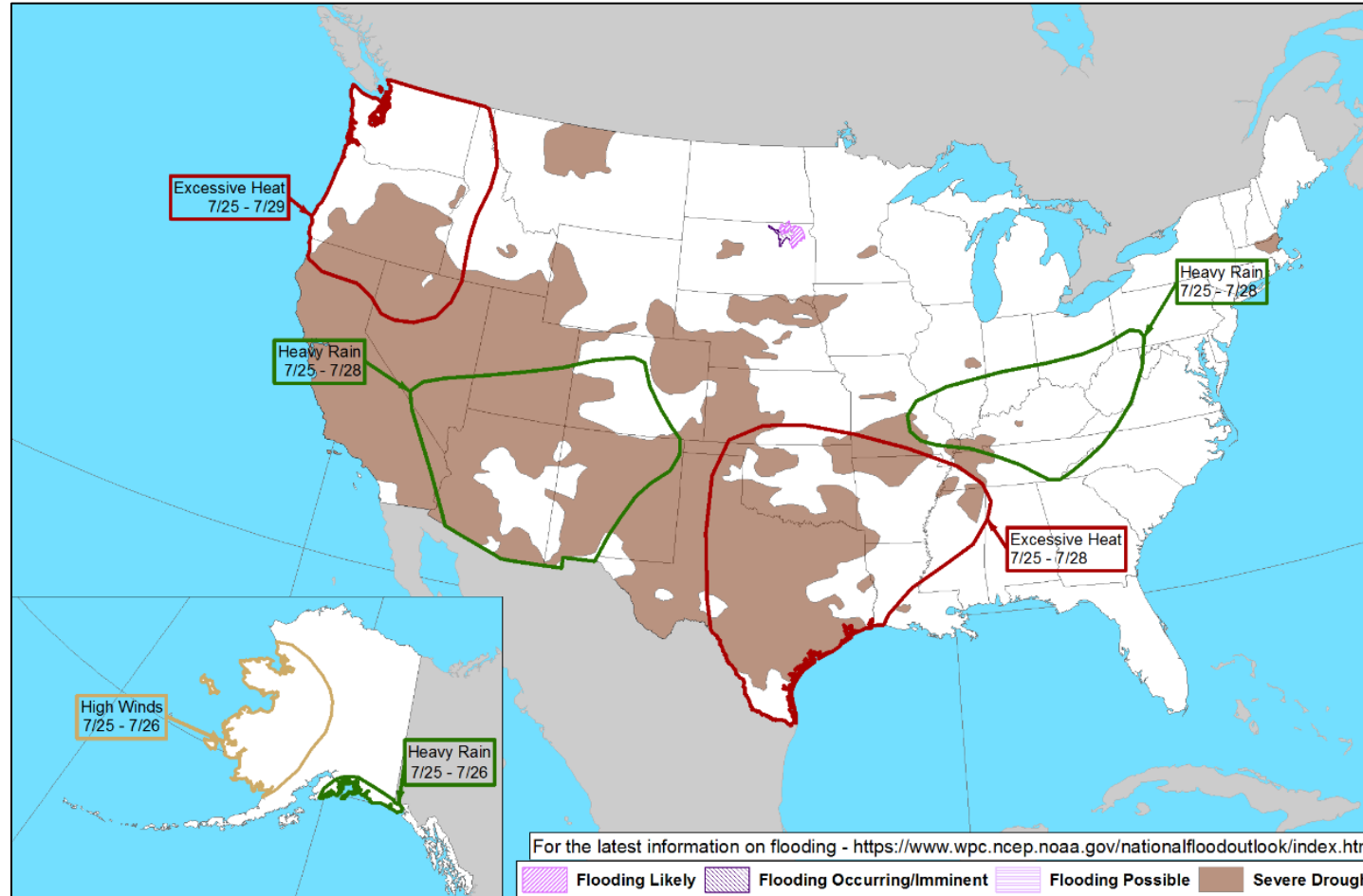

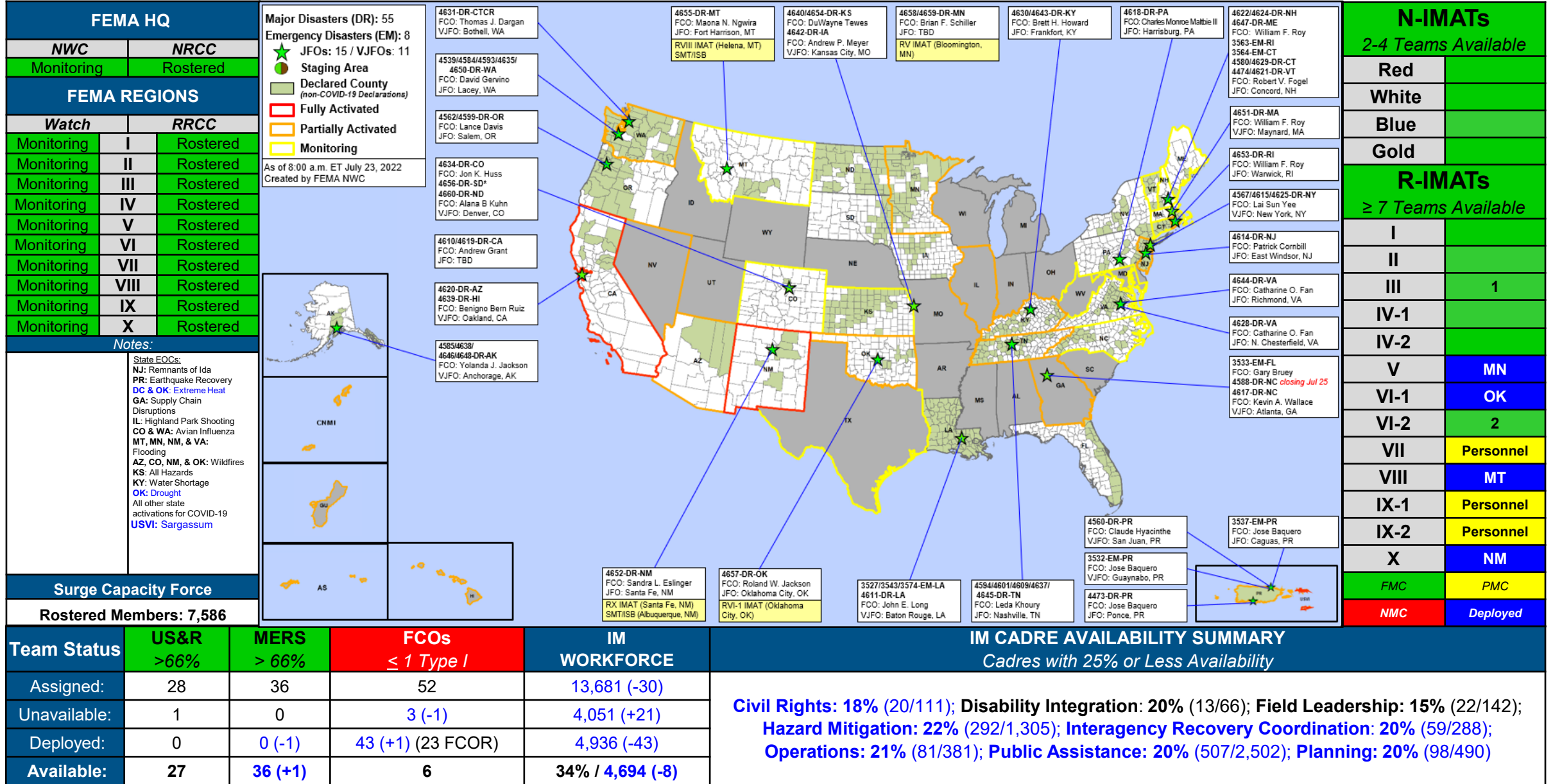
