

- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (30%);7-day Low (30%)




- Located several hundred miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula

- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (near 0%); 7-day Low (10%)














Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
