Severe Weather – Appalachians to the Mid-Atlantic

<u>Situation:</u> The Moderate Risk of Severe Weather that existed for portions of Regions III and IV last night has dissipated. All tornado and severe weather watches and warnings have been cancelled.

Potential Impacts: (EAGLE-I as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

Region III: 124.4k (Region wide)

Significant Power Outages: MD: 66k (2.5%), Baltimore County 24k (6.5%) and Carroll County 23k (33%); PA: 94k (1.5%), York County 23k (12%) and Chester County 21k (8%)

Region IV: 170k (Region wide)

Significant Power Outages: GA: 36k (0.82%); NC: 102k (2.3%), Catawba County 13k (100%) and Wake County 26k (100%); TN: 46.6k (1.64%)






Tropical Outlook - Seven Day

Central Pacific Eastern Pacific





- 705 miles SSE of Honolulu, Hawaii
- Moving W near 23 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 130 mph
- Some slow and gradual weakening forecasted during the next 48 hours
- Hurricane force winds extend 30 miles; tropical storm force winds extend 115 miles
- Swells generated are expected to begin impacting Johnston Island late Wednesday



Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles S of SW Mexico
- Some slow development of this system possible next weekend while it moves generally westward
- Formation chance through 48 hrs. Low (0%); 7 day Med (40%)






National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
