### Wildfires - Hawaii



<u>Current Situation:</u> FEMA and federal partners continue to support the state of Hawaii in response and recovery efforts from Hawaii Wildfires. Mission priorities remain focused on Search & Rescue, fire containment operations, and damage assessments in the impacted area (Maui County). Federal teams, commodities, and equipment continue to move into the impacted areas to respond and support state and local partners.

#### <u>Lifelines Impacts:</u> (SLB #5 as of 5:00 a.m. ET Aug 15) Safety and Security:

- West Maui schools closed indefinitely
- Central Maui schools: Most opened yesterday for staff, will open this week for students; King Kekaulike HS will remain closed due to damages; repairs in progress

#### Food, Hydration, and Shelter:

- Shelters: Maui County 5 (-1) shelters open with 571 (-136) occupants (3 ARC, 3 independent)
- Central Maui: Free shuttle service for evacuees from central Maui shelters to central Maui shopping area and medical locations

#### Health and Medical:

99 (+6) confirmed fatalities

#### Water Systems:


- Unsafe water advisory still in effect in West Maui
- 4 water wells with intermittent interruptions to power impacting 300 households; USACE scheduled to install 2 generators later this week to provide temporary power

#### Energy:

4,604 customers remain without power in Maui (SLB #5)

#### Communications:

- Maui County:
  - o 19 (-1) cell towers offline
  - Local cell providers deployed 14 assets to improve cellular service in West Maui, improving service to first responders and survivors
  - AT&T deployed 1 cellular asset last night, expected to be online today, to strengthen communications capabilities for responders



#### Transportation:

- 2 Temporary Flight Restrictions(TFR) in effect for Lahaina and Kula
- Safety zone still in place; access authorized on a case-by-case basis as determined by the Captain of the Port in coordination with Maui Police Department

#### State / Local Response:

HI state EOC at Full Activation / Gov declared a SOE


#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located off the coast of southern and southwestern Mexico
- Tropical depression expected to form within the next two days or so
- Formation chance 48-hour: High (80%); 7-day: High (90%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Could form S of the Gulf of Tehuantepec over the weekend
- Some gradual development possible
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (20%)

#### Atlantic



#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a few hundred miles WSW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Development, if any, should be slow to occur
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (10%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Forecast to move off the W coast of Africa tonight or early Wed
- Some slow development possible late this week or over the weekend
- Conditions expected to become unfavorable for development by early next week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (30%)



### **Hurricane Fernanda – Eastern Pacific**

#### Hurricane Fernanda (CAT 2) (Advisory #11 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 815 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 110 mph
- Expected to weaken to a tropical storm on Wednesday and become post-tropical on Thursday
- Hurricane-force winds extend 30 miles, tropical-storm-force winds extend 90 miles






### **Tropical Storm Greg - Central Pacific**


#### Tropical Storm Greg (Advisory #6 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- 910 miles SE of Hilo, HI
- Moving W at 14 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Gradual turn toward the west-northwest is expected over the next couple of days
- Some strengthening is forecast over the next 24 hours
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 45 miles
- Greg will pass well south of the Hawaiian Islands on a high confidence track from Wed through Thu


