### Flooding – Southern Plains to Lower Miss. Valley

#### **Current Situation:**

Heavy rain potential continues through Wednesday. Due to rainfall intensity and duration, flash and river flooding may continue, particularly in urban areas & where localized very heavy rain occurs in a short time. Impact assessments will commence once the storm has moved out of the region.

#### **Lifeline Impacts:**

Food, Water, Sheltering: (FEMA RVI SPOTREP as of Aug 22, 6:18 p.m. ET)

One shelter remains open in Three Rivers, TX with zero occupants

Health and Medical: (FEMA RVI as of Aug 23, 7:20 a.m. ET)

· One fatality reported in Dallas, TX

#### **Transportation:**


Numerous road closures reported due to flooding; detours available

#### State / Local Response:

- TX EOC at Monitoring (Flooding and COVID-19)
  - TX TF-1 swift water rescue boat teams are activated
  - o TX Dept of Public Safety and TX National Guard have helicopters on stand-by
  - o ESF-8: Two Severe Weather Packages on stand-by (El Paso & Rio Grande Valley)
- No requests for FEMA assistance
- State of Emergency declared for Dallas County


#### FEMA / Federal Response:

- Region VI at Enhanced Watch (7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. ET)
- FEMA HQ has identified US&R teams (CO, AZ, and UT) which are available if needed
- Response operations call was conducted with HQ Response, Region VI, National Water Center LNO, and NWC; support assets placed on alert
- NWC will provide updates in the 5:00 p.m. ET National Situation Report







# **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**






### **National Weather Forecast**











# **Tropical Outlook - Five Day**

No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days


### **Eastern Pacific**



#### **Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SW of the southern tip of Baja
   California peninsula
- Additional development possible; tropical depression could form over the next couple days
- Formation chance 48-hour: Med (40%); 5-day: Med (40%)

### **Atlantic**



#### <u>Disturbance 1</u> (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles W of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving W to WNW at 10-15 mph
- Some slow development possible over the next several days
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (10%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Forecast to move off the coast of Africa
- Moving W at 10-15 mph
- Some slow development possible over the next several days
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (20%)


