



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located several hundred miles ESE of the Windward Islands

- Tropical wave has moved off the coast of Africa
- Moving W at 15-20 mph
- Environmental conditions could support some slow development through early next week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (20%)




