


Tropical Outlook - Five Day



Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)


- Located over the east Caribbean Sea

- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (20%)


Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)


- Located south of the Cabo Verde Islands

National Weather Forecast










Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall


