


Tropical Outlook - Five Day

Eastern Pacific










No new tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central tropical Atlantic Ocean; moving WNW at 10 mph
- Tropical depression could form later this week
- Formation chance 48-hours: Low (30%); 5-days: High (70%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 600 miles E of Bermuda
- Some slow development possible during the next couple of days
- Formation chance 48-hours: Low (10%); 5-days: Low (10%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Could develop over the northwestern Caribbean Sea during the early or middle part of the week
- Formation chance 48-hours: Low (near 0%); 5-days: Low (20%)

Disturbance 4 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Forecast to move off the west coast of Africa in a couple of days
- Some gradual development possible after that time
- Formation chance 48-hours: Low (near 0%); 5-days: Low (20%)




National Weather Forecast







Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall








Long Range Outlooks – Sep 2-6



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




