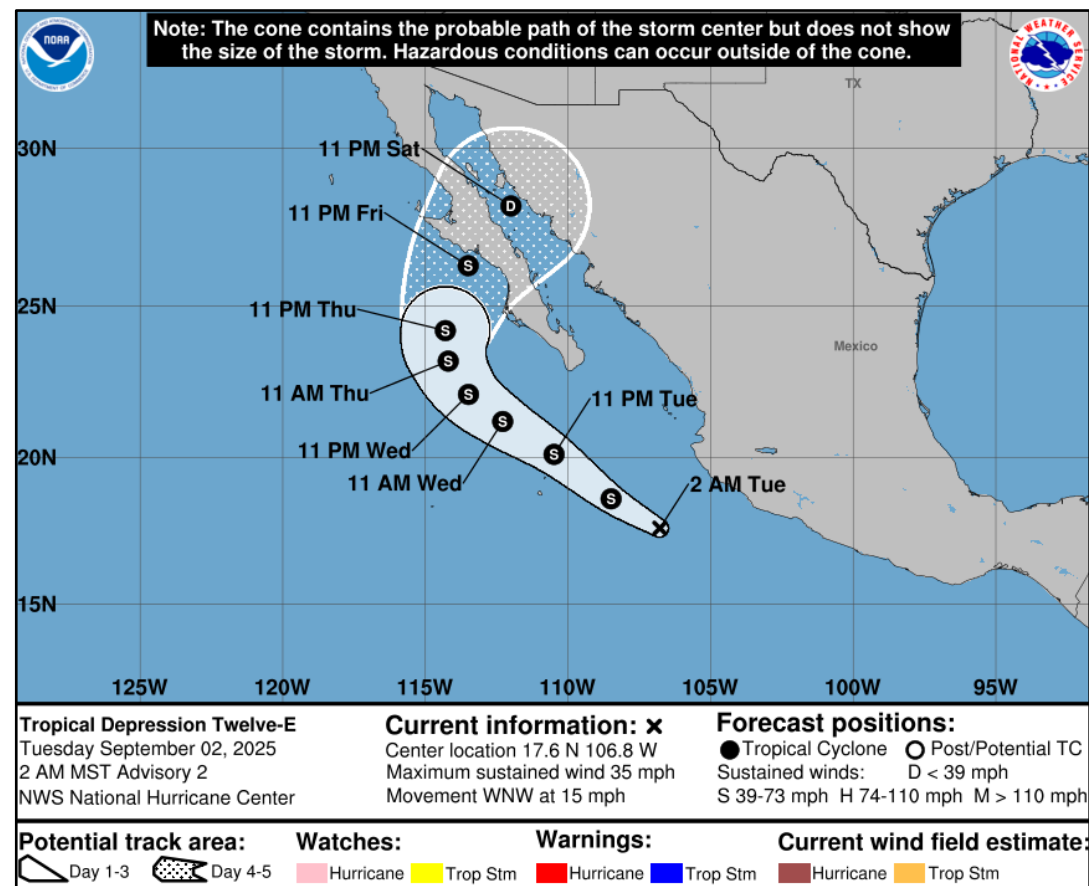


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# Tropical Depression Twelve-E

**Situation:** (Advisory #2, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 190 miles WSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Strengthening is forecast, and will likely become a tropical storm later today

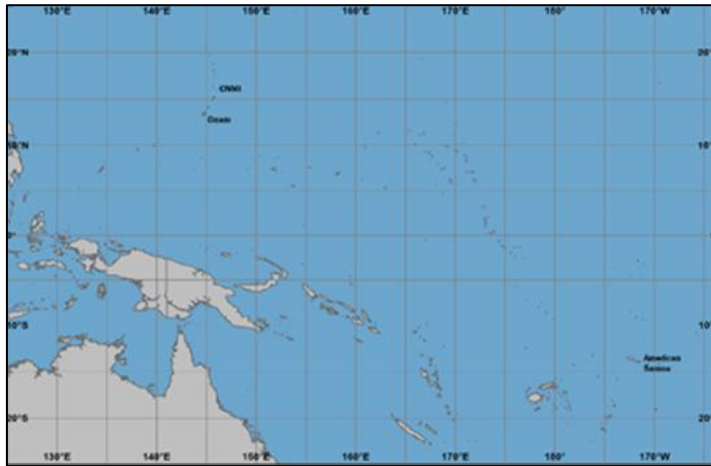


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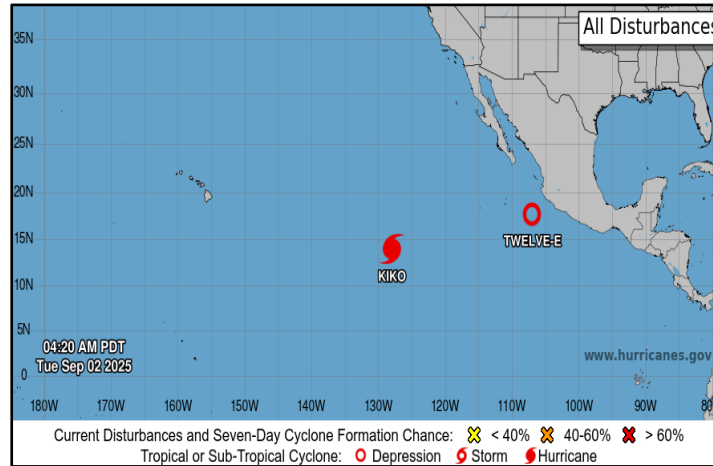
# Tropical Outlook

## Central and Eastern Pacific



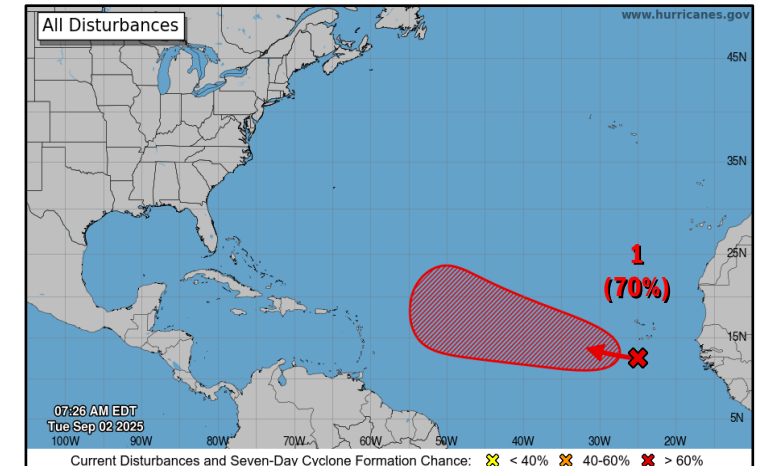
### Hurricane Kiko (CAT 1): (Advisory #9, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located **1,840 miles E of Hilo, Hawaii**
- Moving **W** at **7 mph**
- Maximum sustained winds **75 mph**
- **Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 15 miles from the center**; tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to **60 miles**

### Tropical Depression Twelve-E: (Advisory #2, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located **190 miles W of Manzanillo, Mexico**
- Moving **WNW** at **15 mph**
- Maximum sustained winds **35 mph**
- **Strengthening is forecast, and will likely become a tropical storm later today**

## Atlantic



### Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located **S of the Cabo Verde islands**
- **Expected to move W to NW at 15 mph throughout the week**
- Environmental conditions appear conducive for slow development of this system, and a tropical depression **is likely** form by the **later this week or this weekend**
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (**30%**); 7-day: **High (70%)**

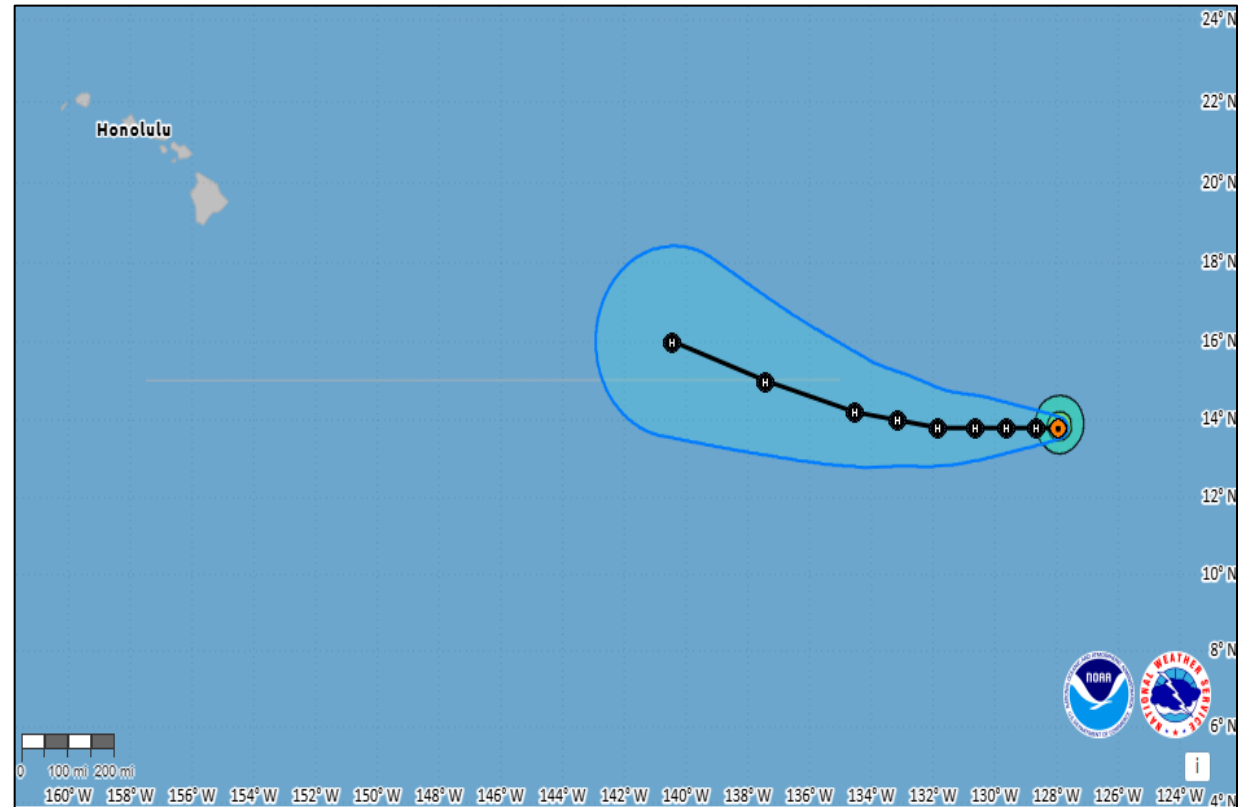


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# Hurricane Kiko (CAT 1)

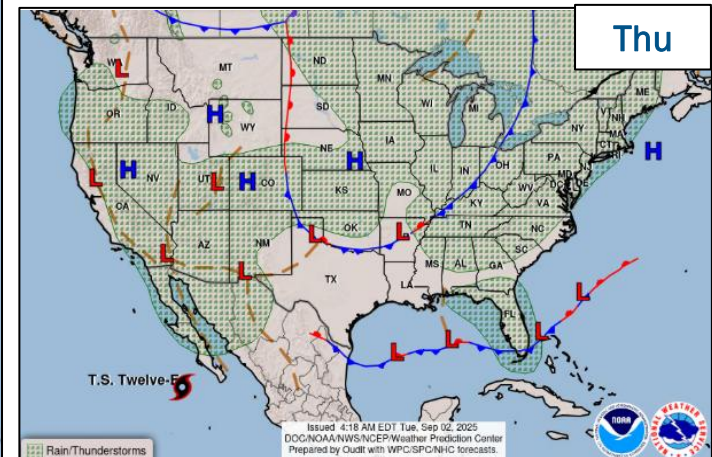
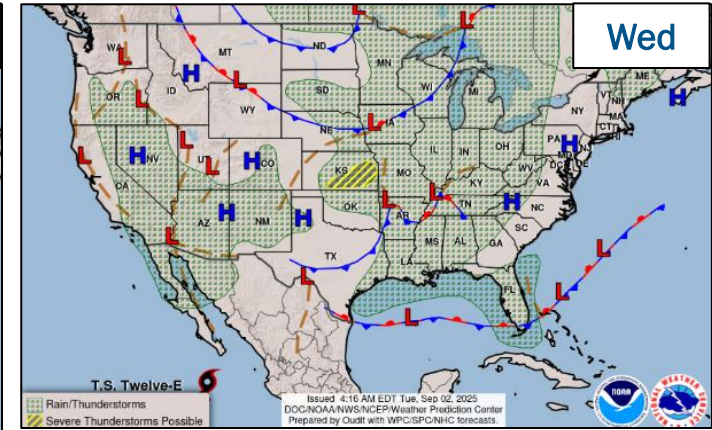
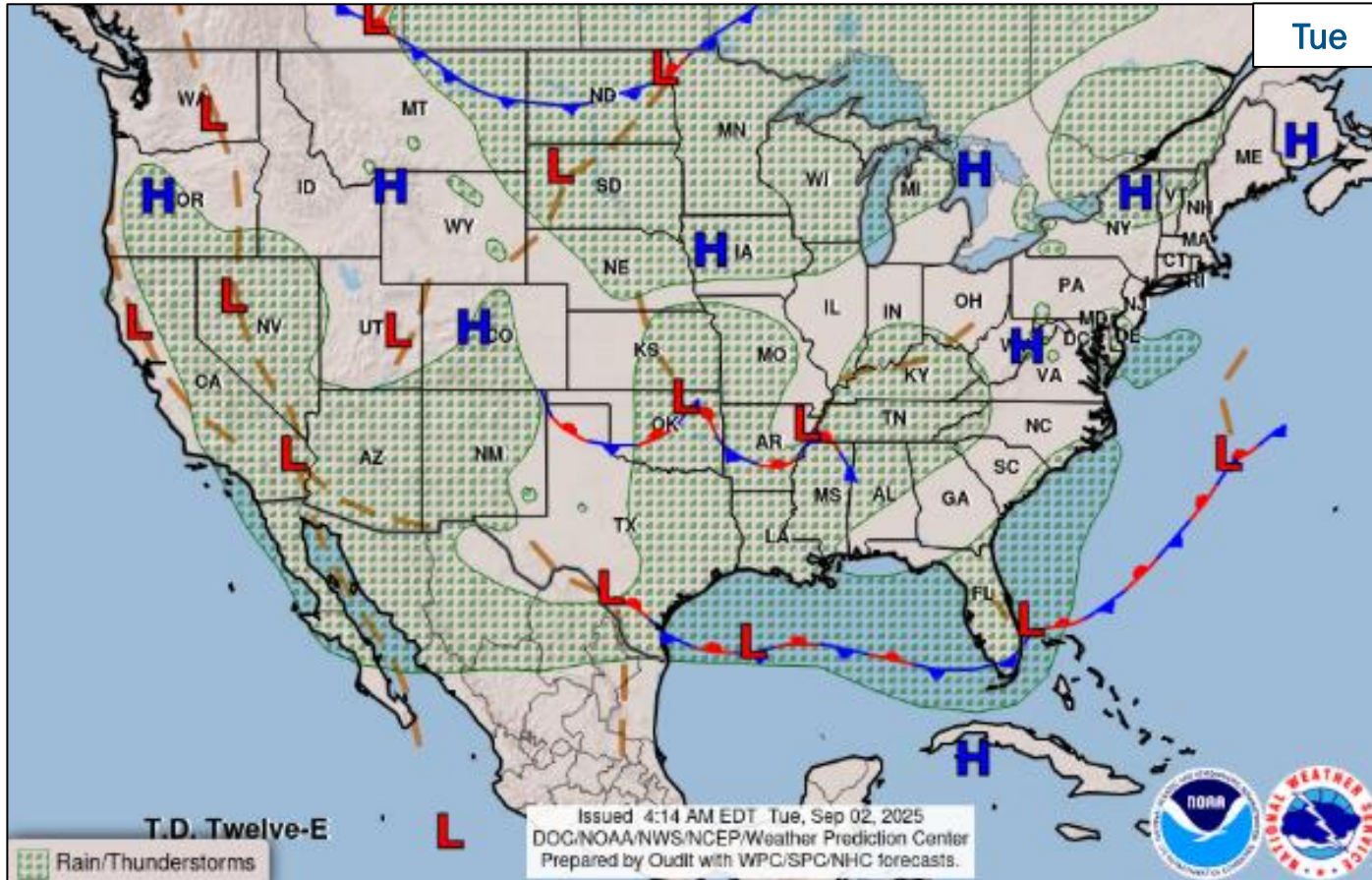
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- Moving **W** at **7 mph**
- Maximum sustained winds **75 mph**
- **Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 15 miles from the center**; tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 60 miles
- **Steady strengthening is forecast during the next couple of days and Kiki is expected to become a hurricane by tonight**



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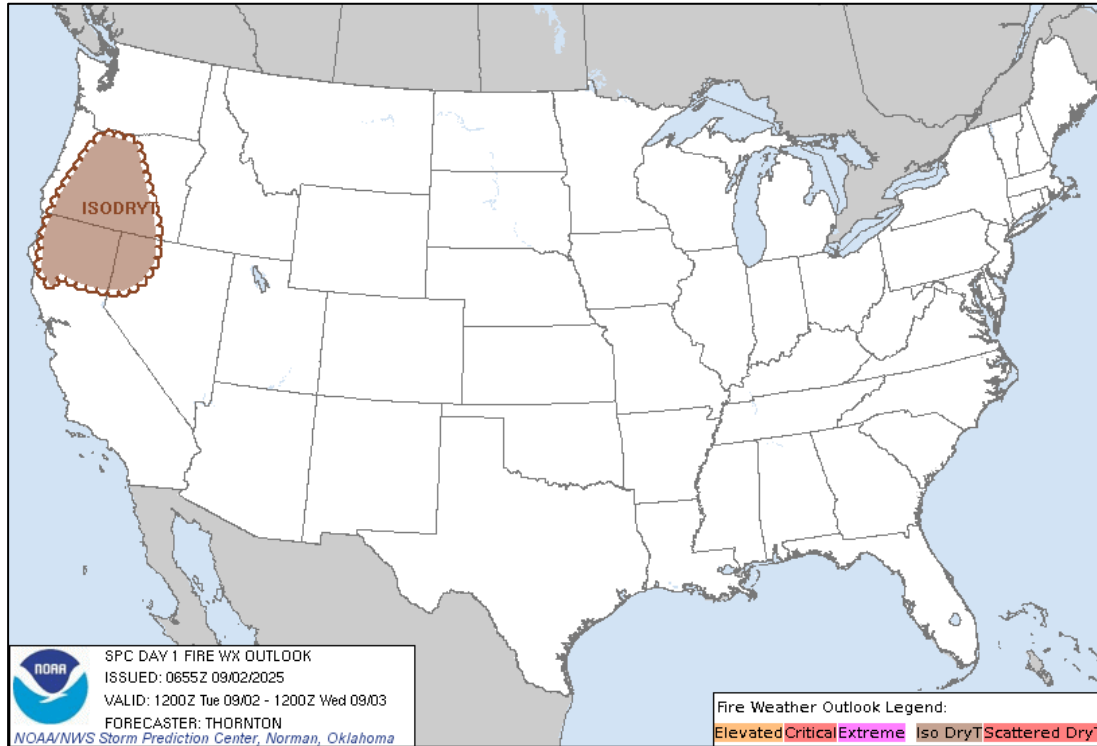

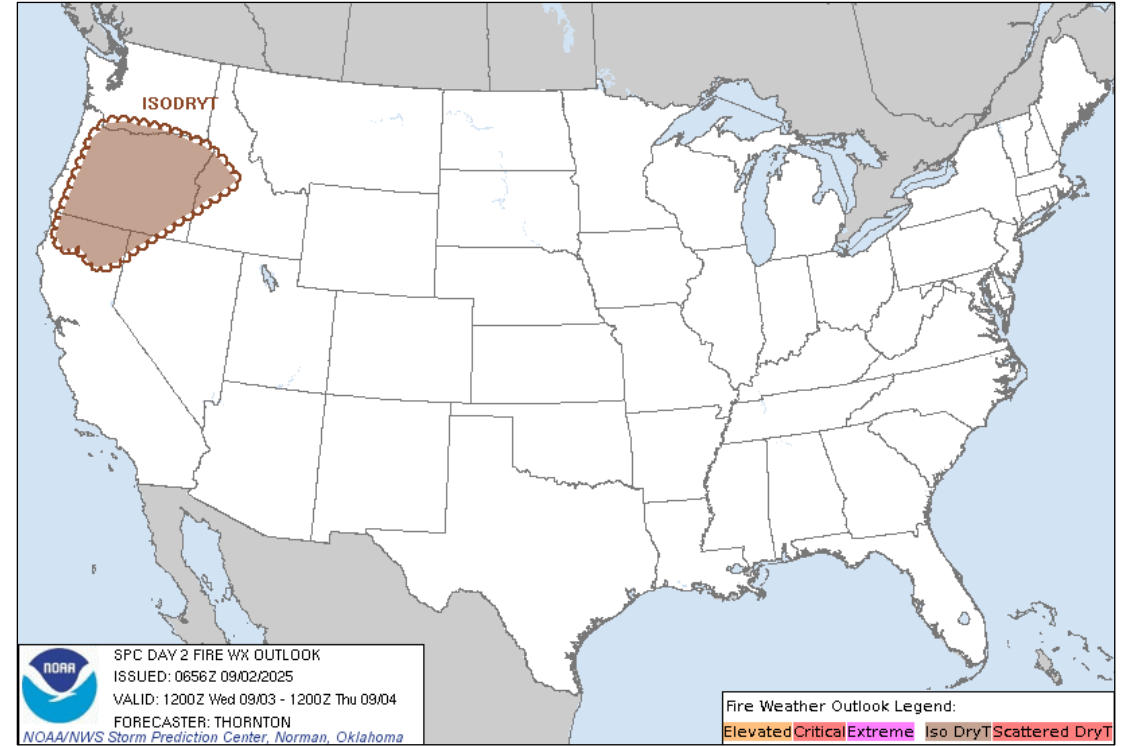
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# Fire Weather Outlook

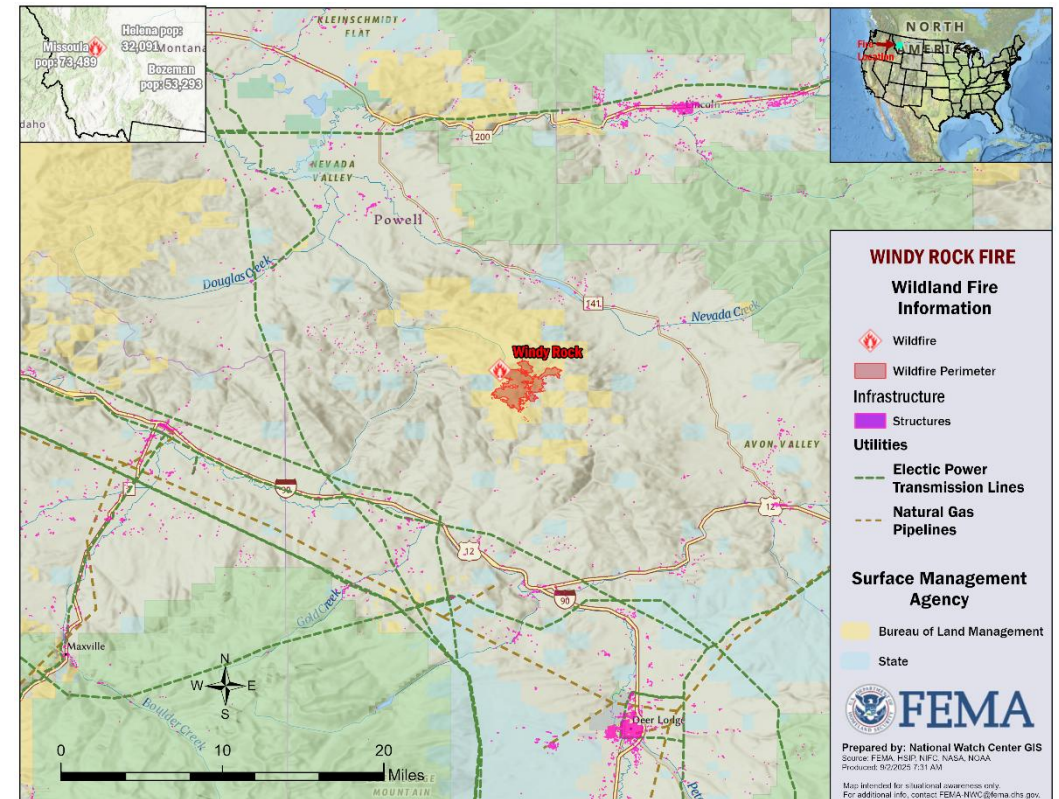

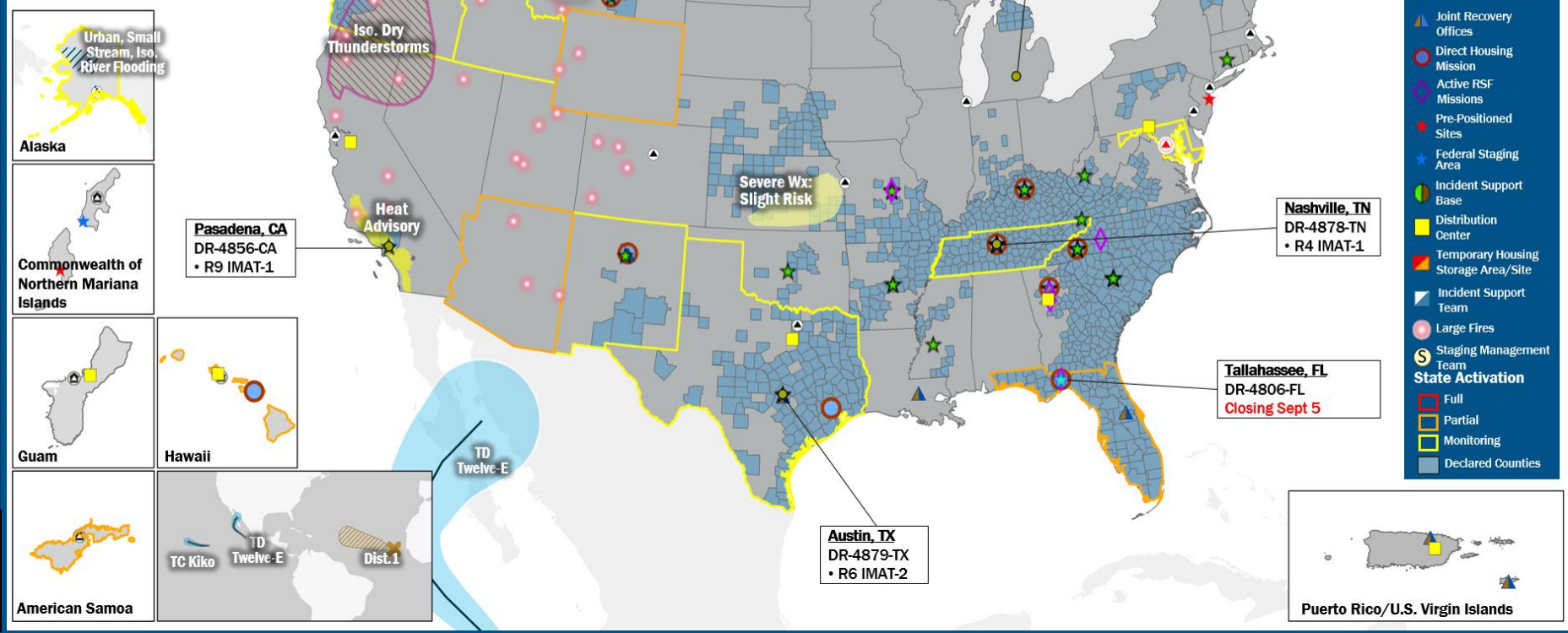
