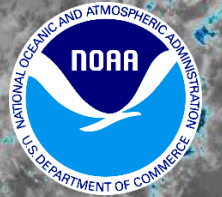

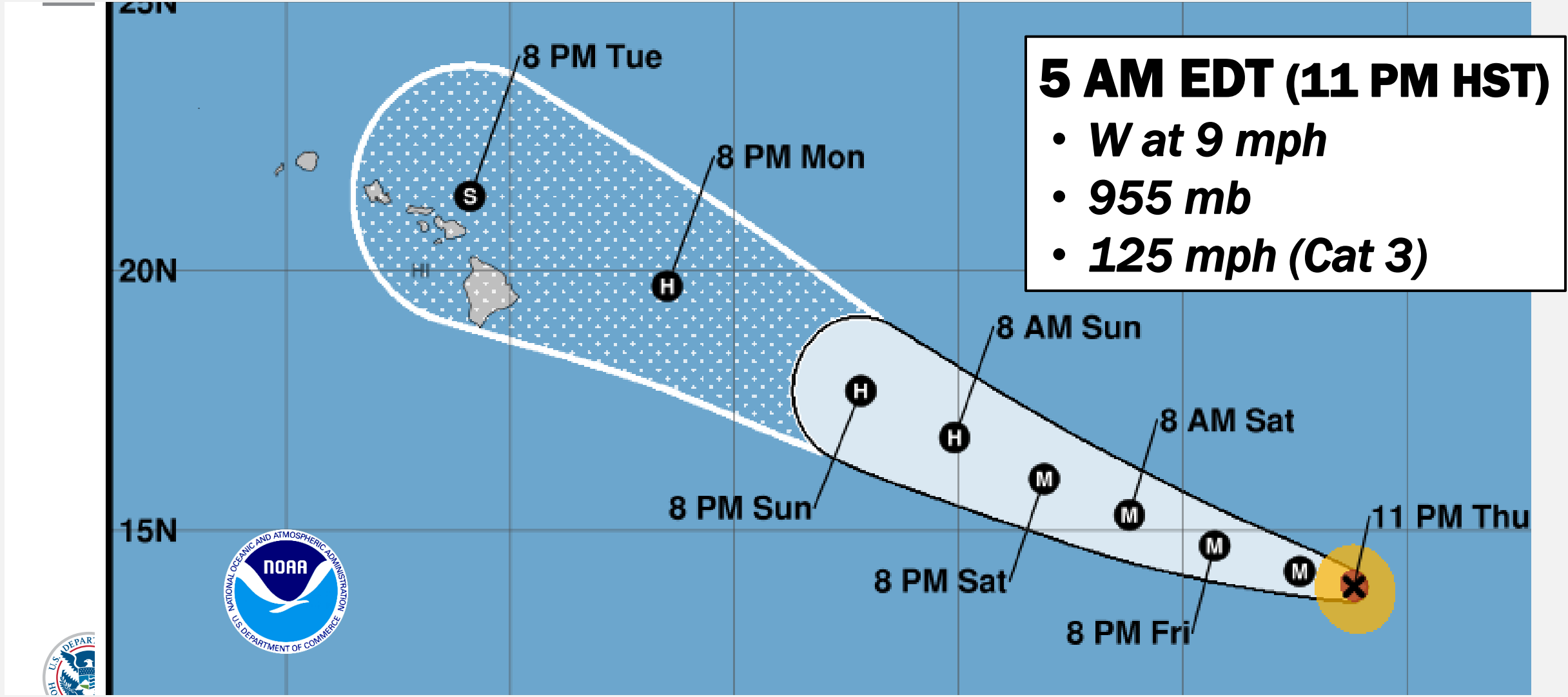

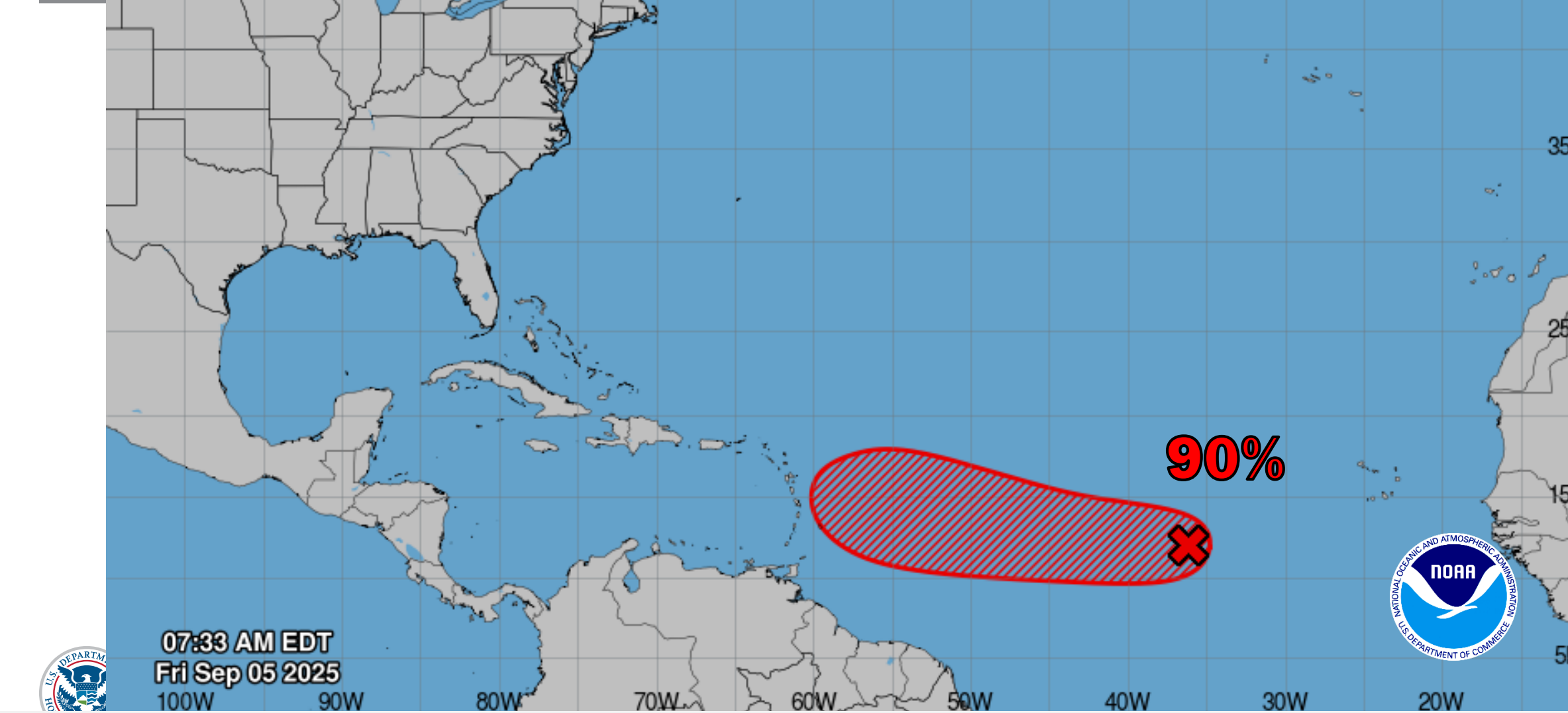
MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF WINDS



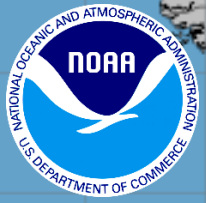
