### Disturbance 1 (95W): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Invest 95W is located E of Guam over the weekend
- Rain and Marine impacts could begin for Guam and the Mariana Islands as early as Tuesday local time (ChST)

- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days

### Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located off the coast of southern Mexico
- Some development is possible
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (near 0%); 7-day – Low (30%)

### Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the **northwestern** Gulf of Mexico
- Development of this system **remains unfavorable**
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (10%); 7-day – Low (10%)

### Disturbance 2: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located **several hundred miles E of Mid-Atlantic**
- Slow development is possible over the next couple of days**
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (20%); 7-day – Low (20%)

### Disturbance 3: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located **near the coast of Belize**
- Slow development is possible later this weekend**
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (near 0%); 7-day – Low (20%)

### Disturbance 4: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

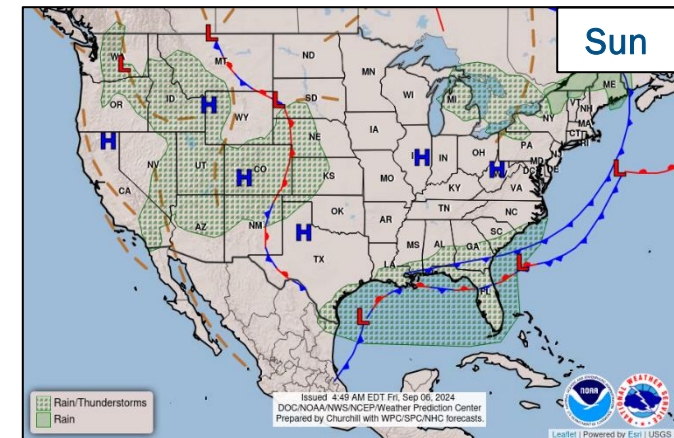
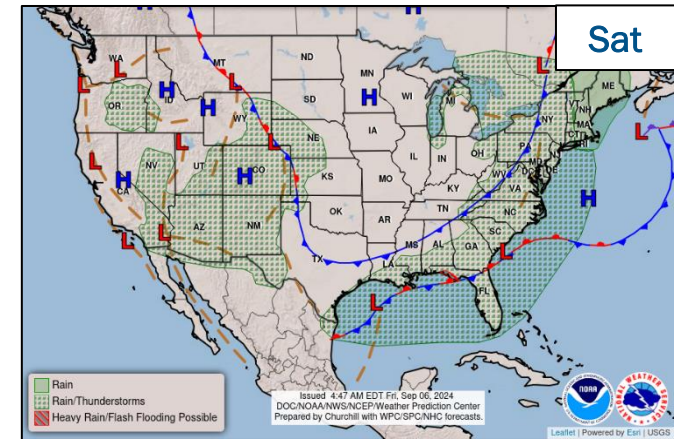
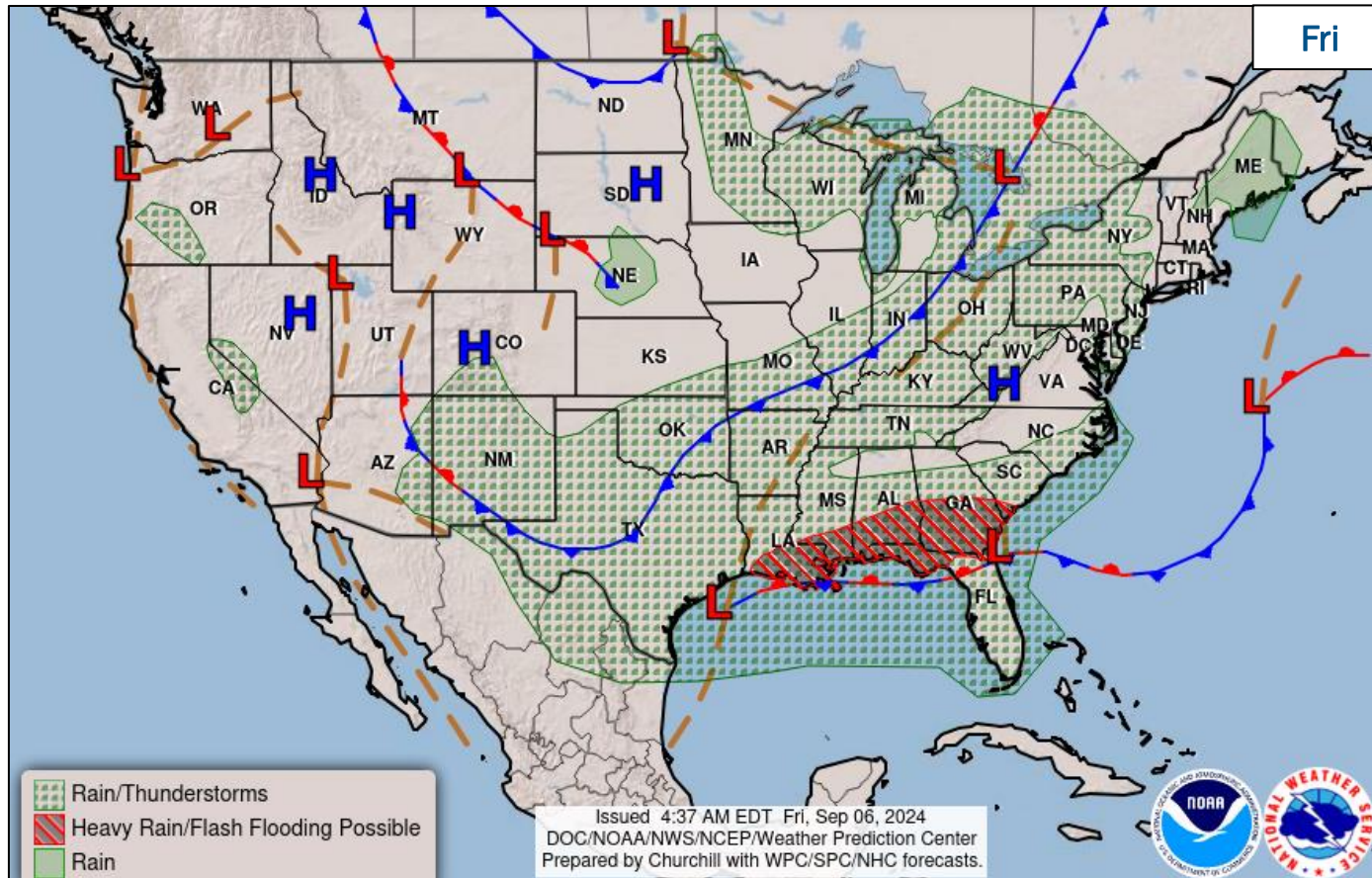
- Located over **the eastern tropical Atlantic**

- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (near 0%); 7-day – Low (10%)



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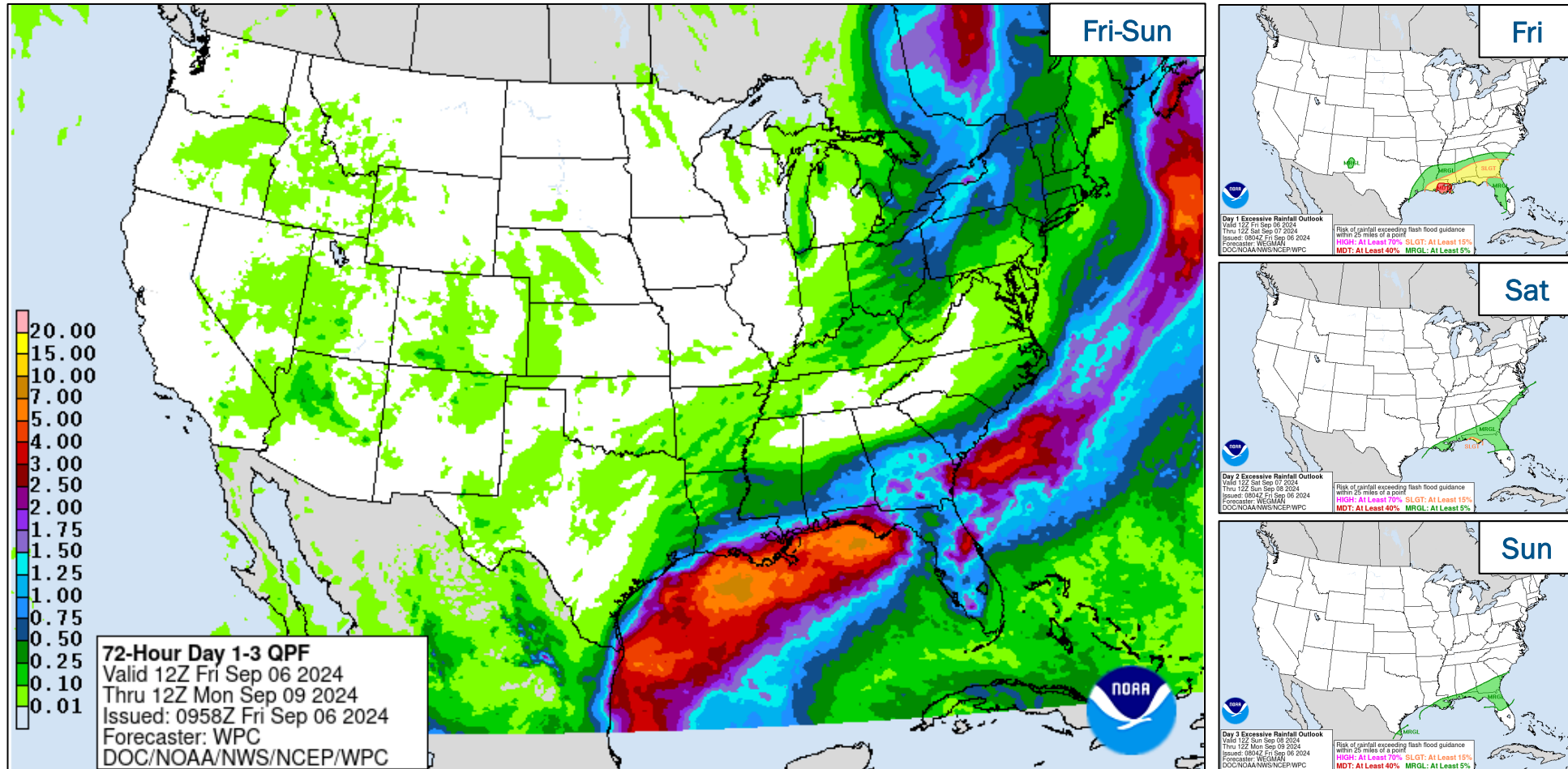
# National Weather Forecast



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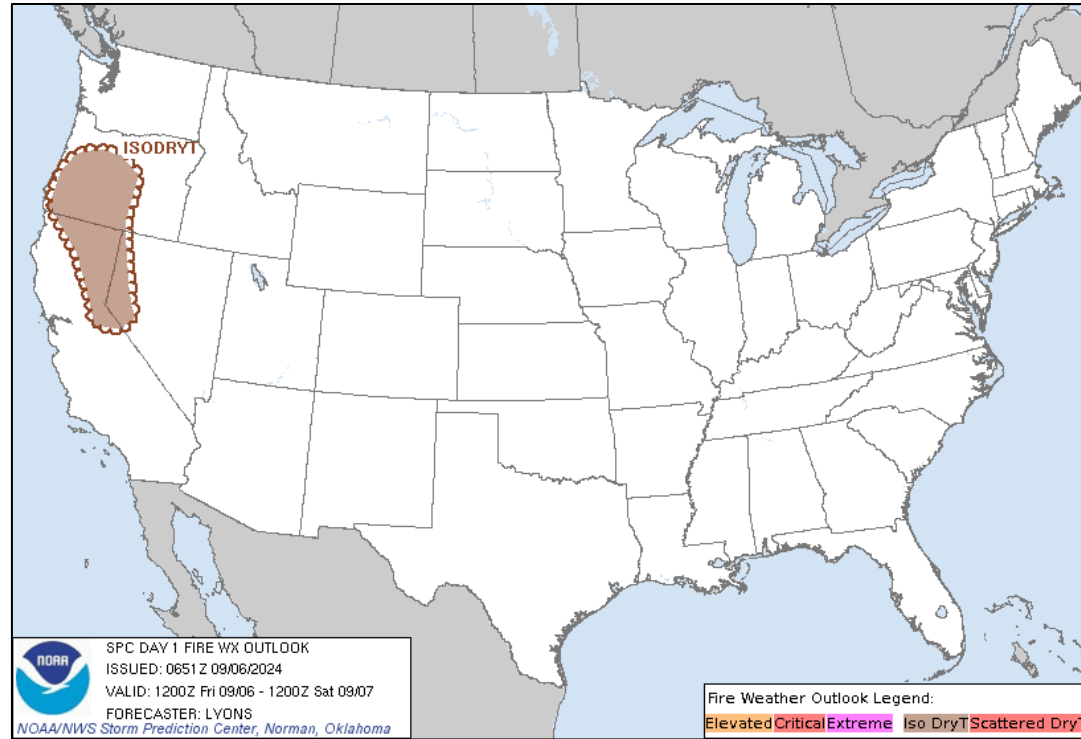
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



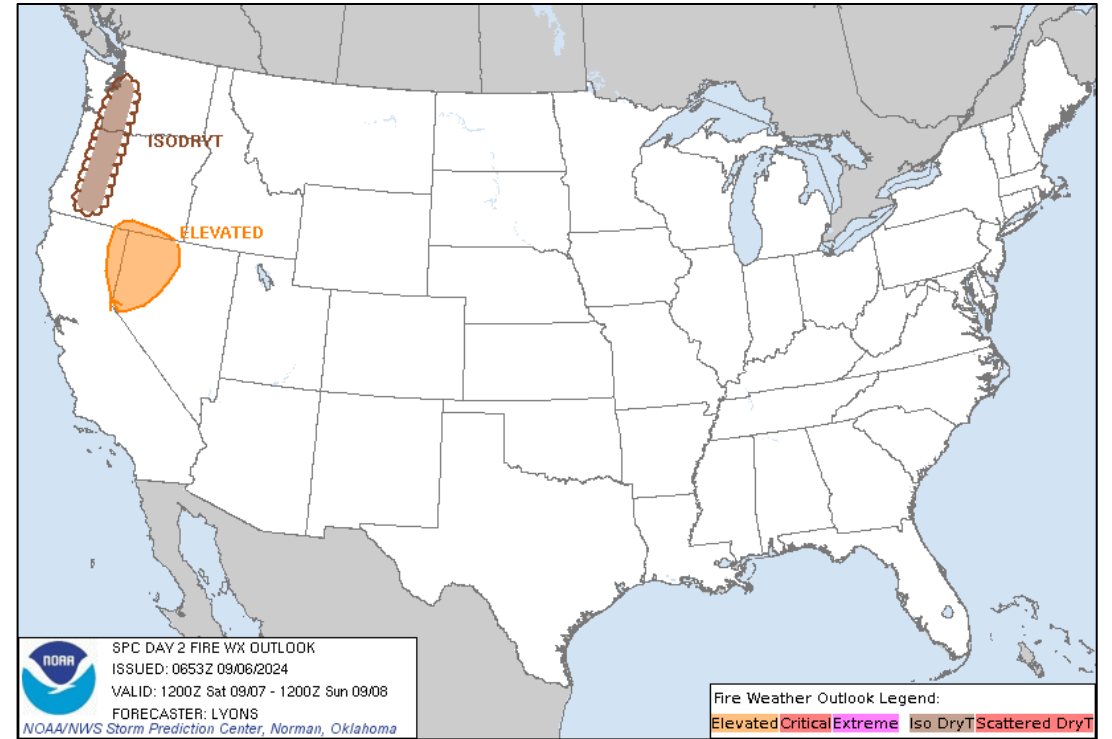
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# Fire Weather Outlook

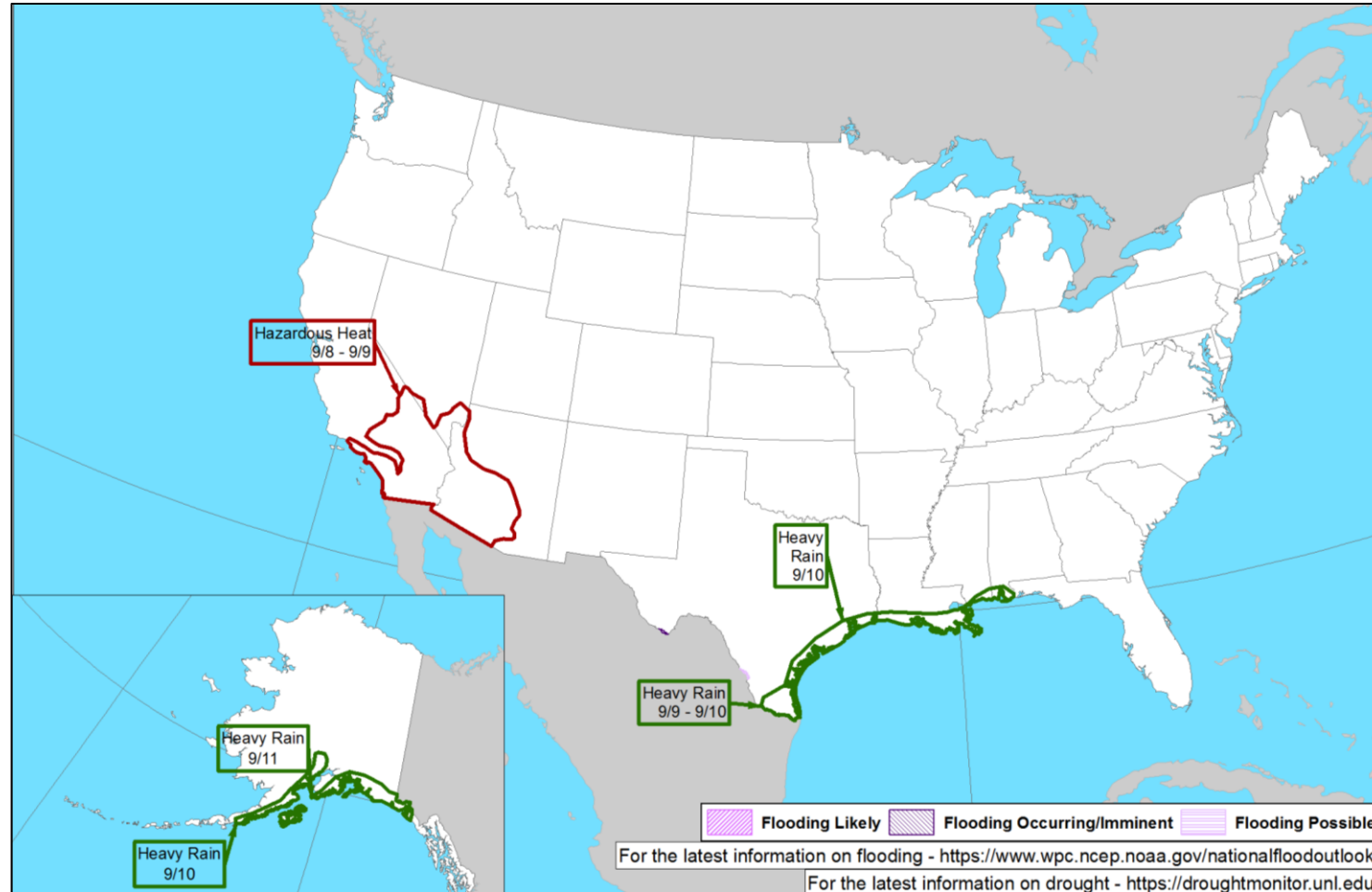

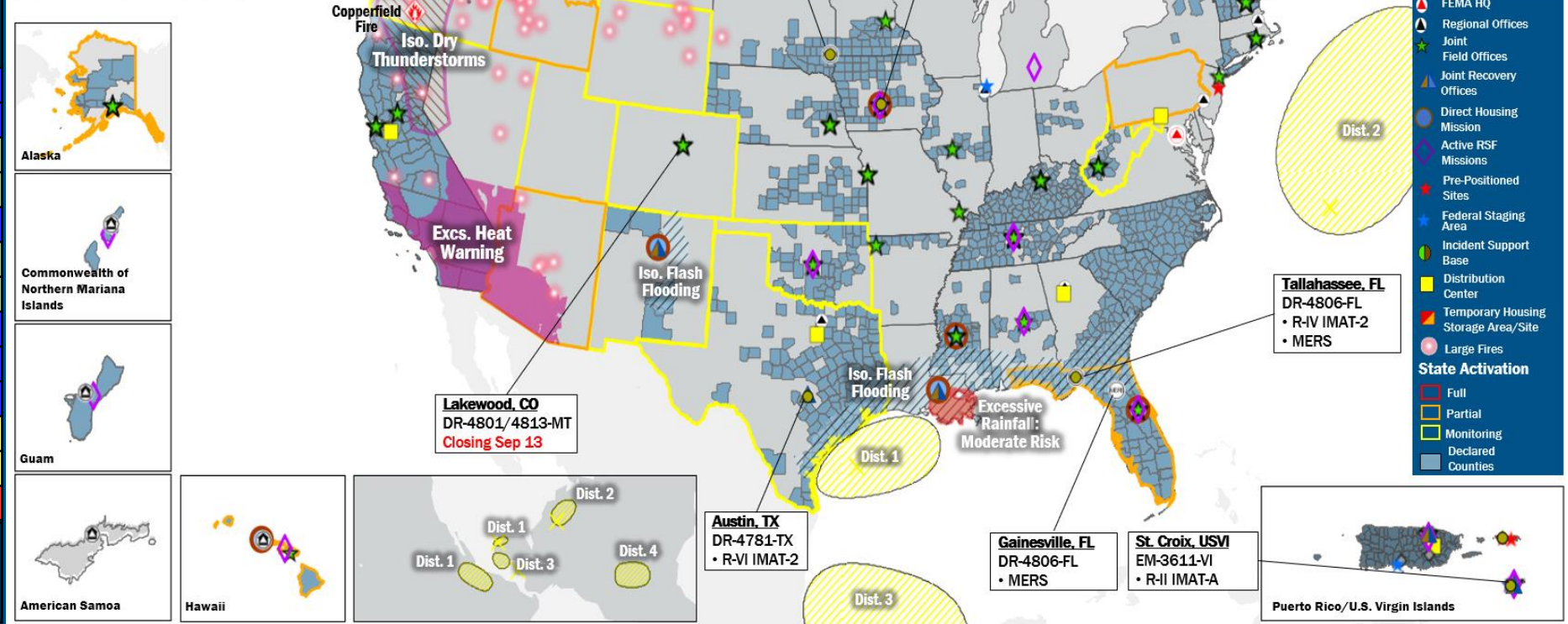

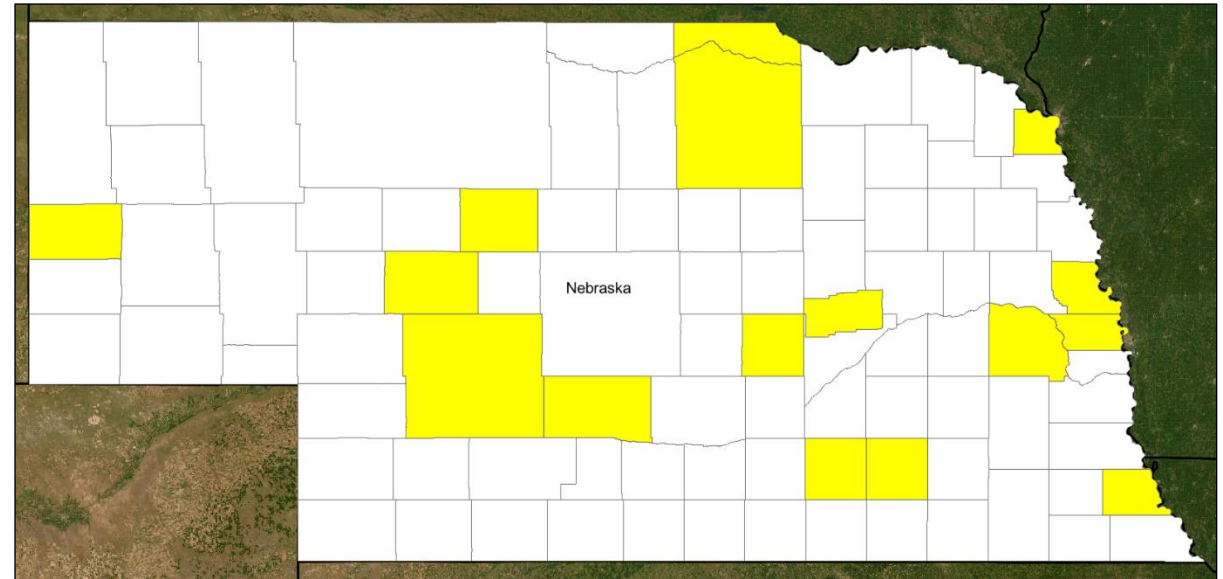
