



Disturbance 1 (95W): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located well east of Guam; just N of Pohnpei
- Tropical Cyclone development is likely, but expected to occur beyond 24 hours

No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days

Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located off the coast of southern Mexico
- Moving NW
- Gradual development is possible in the middle parts of next week
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (near 0%); 7-day Low (30%)

Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located over the Bay of Campeche
- Moving NW
- Tropical depression could form during the early or middle part of next week
- Formation chance: 48-hour Medium (40%); 7-day – Medium (60%)

Disturbance 2: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the eastern and central tropical Atlantic
- Some slow development is possible early next week
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (near 0%); 7-day – Low (30%)












Hazards Outlook - Sep 9-13






Long Range Outlooks - Sep 12-16



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




