




Eastern Pacific

Hurricane Earl (CAT 2) (Advisory #30, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 380 miles S of Cape Race, NL
- Moving NE at 35 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 105 mph
- Expected to transition into a powerful hurricaneforce extratropical low this afternoon then gradually weaken
- Hurricane force winds extend 90 miles; tropicalstorm-force winds extend 415 miles



- Formation chance 48-hour Low (near 0%); 5-day:Low (30%)




National Weather Forecast








Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall







Severe Weather Outlook





Fire Weather Outlook






