




# Atlantic Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK



# Hurricane Lee SATELLITE LOOP




# Hurricane Lee FORECAST TRACK



Current Situation: Tropical Cyclone Lee continues to intensify in the Atlantic and could pose a possible threat for portions of the Northeast.


