




Atlantic Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK




Hurricane Lee SATELLITE LOOP




Hurricane Lee FORECAST TRACK




Hurricane Lee WIND WATCHES




Hurricane Lee ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS




Hurricane Lee PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST




Hurricane Lee 3 DAY RAINFALL

Hurricane Lee - New England


<u>Current Situation:</u> Hurricane Lee is forecast to approach the coast of New England Friday as a large hurricane. Hurricane conditions are possible in the portions of Downeast Maine beginning Saturday. Rainfall amounts of 1 to 4 inches across New England is expected beginning Friday night through Saturday night producing potential localized urban and small stream flooding.










Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
