<u>Situation:</u> The 78th Session of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) opened in New York, NY on September 5, 2023, and will continue through September 30, 2023. September 17-23 has been designated an NSSE. There are 193 members of the UNGA, and in-person attendance is projected to return to near pre-COVID levels.




FEMA Headquarters

- Maynard MERS will provide communications and mobile command functions to Region II and other Federal agencies as directed







Atlantic Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK



Hurricane Lee SATELLITE LOOP




Hurricane Lee FORECAST TRACK




Hurricane Lee WIND WATCHES AND WARNINGS




Hurricane Lee PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST




Hurricane Lee 48 HOUR RAINFALL


<u>Current Situation:</u> Hurricane Lee is SSE of Nantucket, MA moving north, with an increase in forward speed expected through Saturday. Tropical Storm Warnings issued from Westport, MA northward to the US/Canadian border. Heavy rain from Lee may produce localized urban and small stream flooding across eastern New England.

State / Local Response: (R1 SLB as of 3:00 p.m. ET, Sep 14)





National Weather Forecast




