



Atlantic Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK




Post-Tropical Cyclone Lee SATELLITE LOOP



RADAR LOOP




Post-Tropical Cyclone Lee FORECAST TRACK




Post-Tropical Cyclone Lee TROPICAL STORM WARNINGS



Post-Tropical Cyclone Lee **RAINFALL TODAY**






Post-Tropical Cyclone Lee EXCESSIVE RAINFALL OUTLOOK TODAY

<u>Current Situation:</u> Post Tropical Cyclone Lee is moving northward but at a slower forward speed is expected later today, and the center of Lee is forecast to reach western Nova Scotia around midday. Lee is expected to be at or just below hurricane strength when it reaches Nova Scotia later today. Weakening is forecast tonight and Sunday while Lee moves across Atlantic Canada.
