<u>Situation</u>: Overnight the Space Weather Prediction Center reported a G4 Geomagnetic Storm was observed. G4 conditions were severe over the past 24 hours and are predicted to be strong for the next 24 hours. The area for potential impacts includes all FEMA Regions.

- All FEMA regions continue to monitor for potential impacts, and all RRCCs are rostered
- FEMA National Watch Center will continue to monitor in coordination with our FEMA Regions and federal partners; however, barring significant new developments this is anticipated to be the final report







<u>Tropical Storm Pulasan:</u> (Advisory #3, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 688 miles SE of Kadena Air Base,

- TS Pulasan expected to continue northwestward and track S of Okinawa over the next 24-36 hours

- Gordon could gradually re-intensify and become a tropical storm again later this week.











Severe Weather Outlook










Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall











Percent Registered Based On Forecast




