



### <u>Disturbance 1: (Remnants of Gordon)</u> (as of 8:00 a.m. *ET*)


- Located over the central subtropical Atlantic as remnants of Gordon

- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (30%); 7day – Med (60%)




- Located in the northwestern Caribbean Sea











### **Severe Weather Outlook**





## **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**








