



### **Tropical Storm Philippe** (Advisory #8 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,320 miles W of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Moving WNW at 10 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 115 miles from the center
- Little change in strength is forecast during the next 36 hours
- Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)
- Located over the southeastern Gulf of Mexico
- Slow development is expected to occur over the next few days
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)
   <u>Disturbance 2: (AL91)</u> (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)
- Located several hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Additional development forecast; tropical depression likely to form mid-week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (30%); 7-day: High (80%)



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# **Remnants of Ophelia – Southeast/Mid-Atlantic – FINAL**

Current Situation: Remnants of Ophelia were absorbed by a frontal boundary overnight.

Energy: Minimum power outages reported for FEMA Region I, II, and III (DOE Eagle-I as of 6:30 a.m. ET, Sep 18)


Transportation: Region III and IV: USCG: All ports open

- Region III: MD & VA at Monitoring ; DC, DE & PA at Normal Operations



  - The NWC, in coordination with Regions II, III, and IV will continue to monitor; however, no further reporting is anticipated












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# **Fire Weather Outlook**










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# Long Range Outlooks – Sep 30–Oct 4




6-10 Day Temperature Probability
