




Pacific Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK




Atlantic Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK

Tropical Storm Helene FORECAST TRACK




Tropical Storm Helene MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS

Tropical Storm Helene PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST





Tropical Storm Helene SEVERE WEATHER OUTLOOK THURSDAY


5 DAY RAINFALL








FLASH FLOOD RISK valid through Monday, 8 AM EDT




Considerable and potentially lifethreatening flash and urban flooding is expected across portions of Florida, the Southeast, southern Appalachians, and the Tennessee Valley
