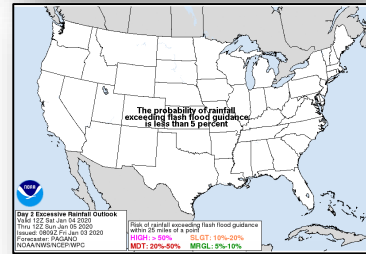
National Weather Forecast



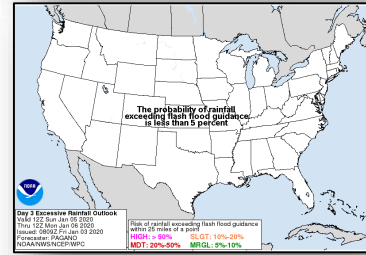
