






## **Severe Weather Outlook**






# **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**






### **Forecast Snowfall**






### **Ice Accumulation Forecast**






# **Long Range Outlooks – Jan 7-11**



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




